SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

THE NEW KID MAKING AN IMPACT: Brewers' 2023 first-round draft pick, INF Brock Wilken, made his Double-A debut on Tuesday after 41 games between High-A Wisconsin and the Rookie-level ACL Brewers... In his first two games, Wilken has hit two home runs, including a 100 MPH, 393-foot solo home run on Wednesday night... Wilken, who set the Wake Forest single-season record with 31 home runs this year, smashed a grand slam to left for his first Double-A hit on

📚 In 109 games between Wake Forest and the Brewers' minor league affiliates, Wilken has 36 home runs, 109 RBI and a .327 average... Wilken has also walked 101 times compared to 98 strikeouts in 2023.

HE GETS ON BASE: C/1B Wes Clarke enters today with a 28-game on-base streak, the second-longest in franchise history (since 2015) and the fifth-longest this year in the Southern League... During the streak, Clarke owns a .295/.481/.579 slash line, and has walked in 24% of plate appearances... Clarke has drawn a walk in 21 of the 28 games during the streak.

FOUR FOR THE PLAYOFFS: The Shuckers need to win three of their final four games in the season against the Montgomery Biscuits to qualify for the playoffs... If the Shuckers win three more games, they'll reach the playoffs for the first time since 2019, when they reached the Southern League Championship Series for the second straight year... The Shuckers would host game one of the Southern League Division Series against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at MGM Park on Tuesday, September 19.

ONE MORE TIME: RHP Carlos Rodriguez made his final start of the regular season on Wednesday, going 6.1 innings... Rodriguez finishes his regular season with 25 starts, 123.2 innings, 152 strikeouts and a 2.77 ERA... Rodriguez ends the season in the top-five in franchise history (since 2015) in ERA (5th, 2.77), strikeouts (3rd, 152)... He currently leads Double-A in ERA by 0.20 over RHP Patrick Monteverde (PNS) and opponents' average by five points over RHP Mick Abel (REA).

POST ALL-STAR BREAK POWER: C/1B Wes Clarke smashed his 25th home run of the year on Tuesday, the most by any Shuckers player since OF Corey Ray set the franchise record with 27 in 2018... His 25 home runs are the second-most by a player in franchise history and tied for the third-most out of all Double-A hitters.

Since the All-Star Break. Clarke has hit 16 home runs, the most out of any hitter in Double-A and tied for the 10thmost by any hitter in Minor League or Major League Baseball over that span.

TODAY'S STARTER // LHP AARON ASHBY (MLB REHAB): LHP Aaron Ashby continues his rehab assignment from the Brewers' 60-Day Injured List with the Shuckers after making three starts with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers in High-A... Ashby combined to throw 70 pitches over his three starts, topping out at 33 on September 6 against the Cedar Rapids Kernels... In his big-league career, Ashby has made 23 starts and 40 appearances... Today marks his first start as a member of the Biloxi Shuckers after skipping the level after the canceled 2020 season.
