### History vs. Dayton

**Today:** Yesterday's series opener between the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, and the Dayton Dragons, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, was postponed due to un-baseball-like conditions, and so today – on Day 8 of a 12-game, 13-day homestand – the Nuts officially open up a six-game series with the Dragons. Lansing is coming off winning four of six games against Quad Cities to start the homestand. Today is also a Grand Slam School Day on a Dog Days of Summer, with dogs welcome to the ballpark.

**Welcome Back:** Remember lefty **Brady Basso**? The southpaw from Oklahoma State returns from Tommy John surgery for his first MiLB appearance since June 2021 and is expected to throw two innings, followed by A's 2022 5th-rounder **Jack Perkins** (Indiana), taking on Reds 2021 8th-rounder **Hunter Parks** (Florence Darlington Tech) for Dayton in his fourth start.

**Last Games, Sunday - Copa de la Diversión Double Dip:**

**Game 1: River Bandits 6, Locos 2.** Aided by two Lansing errors, Quad Cities rallied for four runs in the fourth inning, breaking a 1-1 tie and winning its second straight game.

**Game 2: Locos 6, River Bandits 4.** Down 3-0 in the 3rd, Cayden Wallace's grand slam gave the Bandits the lead... only to see Lansing tie the game on an Eric Cerantola wild pitch and take the lead for good on a **Jonny Butler** two-out, two-run triple in a three-run fifth inning.

### LUG•NOTES

**Sometimes You Win, Sometimes You Lose, and Sometimes...:** Tomorrow the Lugnuts will play their fourth doubleheader of the season, with one more still to come on May 17 vs. Lake County. The Nuts have had two additional games halted early by rain.

**Streiking:** OF **Caeden Trenkle** went 0-for-1 with two walks in Sunday's Game 2 and has now reached base in all 17 games he has played.

**Hail and Farewell:** OF **Lazaro Armenteros** became the first Lugnut this year to reach Double-A, promoted yesterday to the Midland RockHounds and promptly debuting with three walks drawn in four plate appearances. Armenteros leads the Midwest League in home runs (6) and slugging percentage (.723), topping Dayton's Blake Dunn, and ranks second to Dunn in OPS (1.127 to 1.240).

**Other Nuts Among the Leaders:** **Jonny Butler** is first in triples (4), **Jack Winkler** is tied for second in doubles (7), and **Caeden Trenkle** is tied for fourth in runs scored (14).

**Two's a Charm:** The Lugnuts lead the league with 22 double plays turned, including at least one double play in 14 of their 20 games.

**A Worthy Birthday Present:** 2022 Nuts outfielder **Denzel Clarke** began the season on Midland's Injured List, but returned last week to collect to go 8-for-16 with three doubles, four homers, three walks, and both nine runs and nine RBIs in four games. He was rewarded for his achievements with the Texas League's Player of the Week award, presented to him on Monday, his 23rd birthday. Clarke followed up with a 2-for-3 showing last night, collecting a single, double, walk and HBP against Frisco. In five games, he has reached base 15 times and is slashing .526 / .625 / 1.368.

**Miller's Time:** 2022 Lansing right-hander **Mason Miller**, who worked three hitless innings with seven strikeouts against the Dayton Dragons last September 10, fired seven hitless innings with six strikeouts for the Oakland Athletics last night against Seattle, walking four and departing due to pitch count (100 pitches). Unfortunately, AJ Pollock homered off of Richard Lovelady one out into the eighth and the Mariners went on to defeat the A's, 2-1.

**First-Round Pedigrees:** The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2017:** Peoria set a Midwest League single game record by hitting six Lugnuts with pitches, matching the most single-game HBPs for one team in MLB history to boot (1913, NY Yankees vs. Washington Senators). The Lugnuts scored seven second-inning runs and beat the Chiefs 9-7 at Cooley Law School Stadium. Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. hit his fourth home run of the year, a two-run shot below the video board that capped the second-inning rally.

**2018:** Rainy controversy! The Lugnuts entered the sixth inning trailing the Kane County Cougars, 5-3, before loading the bases and creeping within one run on a Chavez Young sacrifice fly – that also brought rain. Umpiring crew Steven Jaschinski and Kyle Nichol called for the tarp, but were talked out of it, keeping the game going through the rain, and the Lugnuts took advantage with a Kevin Vicuña two-run single for a 6-5 lead. As soon as the inning ended, the game went into a 29-minute rain delay. When the game resumed, the score remained the same: A 6-5 Lugnuts win at Cooley Law School Stadium..

**Personal:** Brady's last name is pronounced "bass-o," with "bass" like the fish rather than the instrument... got married during the 2020-2021 offseason, spending 2020 hiatus planning his wedding in addition to preparing for the 2021 season... returning from Tommy John, making first appearance today since June 15, 2021, a home relief outing against Great Lakes... 688 days between MiLB appearances.

**History Against Dayton:** Started May 12, 2021, at Dayton, and fired three scoreless innings with five strikeouts, allowing two hits, striking out five... allowed leadoff single to Brian Rey in 1st inning and then picked him off, striking out Michael Siani and Quin Cotton to end the inning... gave up a two-out single to Victor Ruiz in the 2nd inning but retired Miguel Hernandez on a flyout to strand the runner at first... caused his own troubles in the 3rd inning, following a strikeout of Bren Spillane, allowed Jacob Hurtubise to reach on his own fielding error; after a passed ball by Drew Millas moved Hurtubise to second, committed a throwing error on a pickoff to advance Hurtubise to third; struck out Brian Rey and dispatched Michael Siani with a groundout to strand Hurtubise at third and end the inning and his outing... received no-decision in Lugnuts' 7-2 victory... it was his second start of four consecutive starts, followed by three straight relief appearances before he was shut down.

**Raising Expectations:** An MLB.com from Athletics MiLB camp by Jonathan Mayo on April 28, 2021, carried a bit of surprising news on a couple of breakout pitchers, specifically, as Mayo wrote, "Brady Basso's role is changing. A lefty who signed for just \$75,000 as a 16th-round pick in the 2019 Draft out of Oklahoma State, Basso pitched almost exclusively in relief in college and threw well in that role in the Rookie-level Arizona League in 2019. Now that he's up to 95-96 mph with his fastball to go along with a curve that flashes plus and a work-in-progress changeup, he's going to get the chance to start." Melissa Lockard, writing for The Athletic on May 2, 2021, included Basso in her Lugnuts preview, writing, "Left-hander Brady Basso (2019, 16th round) opened a lot of eyes this spring with his fastball sitting at 95-97 mph."

**Pro Debut:** Brady pitched for Athletics Gold in the AZL after signing: 15 G, 1 GS, 1.64 ERA, 25 2/3 IP, 0 HR, 8 BB, 38 K... limited right-handed hitters to .194/.257/.313 in 74 PA, while lefties hit .250/.344/.286 in 32 PA... opposing base stealers were nabbed twice out of three attempts... made first professional start on 8/16/19, tossing three innings with 4 K's.

**Draft Day:** Basso was selected 494th overall in the 16th round of the 2019 draft from Oklahoma State... scout: Chris Reilly... signed for \$75,000... in the same round, two all-name players were drafted: the Tigers selected Kona Quiggle and the Blue Jays took Jackxarel Lebron... one of eight OSU Cowboys to be drafted in 2019... joins 2022 ninth-rounder Caeden Trenkle as Oklahoma State Cowboys on the current Lugnuts roster.

**College Days:** Brady was primarily a reliever at Oklahoma State (12 G, 2 GS as freshman; 18 G, 5 GS as sophomore; 14 G, 0 GS as a junior)... after a rough sophomore season (8.27 ERA), rebounded as a junior (1.64 ERA, 11.0 IP, 6 H, 16 K)... majored in finance in Stillwater with the intention of becoming a financial advisor after his playing career ends.

**Let Your Babies Grow Up to be Cowboys:** Oklahoma State players in MLB have included Allie Reynolds, Robin Ventura, Jeromy Burnitz, Pete Incaviglia, Mickey Tettleton, Mike Henneman, Doug Dascenzo, Andrew Heaney, Matt Hague and Jordy Mercer.

**Baseball Runs in the Family:** Brady's father, Mike, played in the minors for nine seasons in the San Diego Padres system, 1986-1994, rising as high as Triple-A... after retiring as a player, immediately began managing in 1995 at age 30, and managed in the Padres' org. from 1995-2000... joined the Toronto Blue Jays and managed in the Jays system in 2003-2006 and 2009... spent the next decade as an MLB scout before being let go by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2020.

**Hometown:** Hails from Pearland ("PAIR-land"), Texas, south of Houston... during senior year at Pearland H.S., posted 0.48 ERA, with 101 strikeouts in 57 innings... named All-District in football, averaging 29.9 yards per catch as a receiver with one primary route: go deep... also from Pearland H.S.: Kirk Dressendorfer, Clay Hensley and Robbie Weinhardt; Megan Thee Stallion spent her teen years living in Pearland.

**Study Skills:** Posted a 4.42 GPA in high school, graduating fifth in his class... graduated in three years from the University of Louisville, earning double major in finance and marketing, before pursuing business management in grad school at Indiana.
