FROM THE CROW'S NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Marauders jumped out to a 3-0 lead after two innings Thursday night, but a six-run Lakeland rally in the third proved insurmountable for Bradenton, whose win streak ended at four games... **Jacob Gonzalez** went 3-for-4 with two RBI and is now batting .556 in five games... **Valentin Linarez** surrendered six runs on five hits and two walks as the first pitcher behind Pirates rehabber **Luis Oviedo**, who threw 30 pitches (nine strikes) but did not allow a run in 1.1 innings... **Wyatt Hendrie** hit his first home run of the season in the second inning, a solo shot to left... **Denny Roman** tossed three innings of scoreless to keep the game close for the Marauders from the fifth through the seventh.

ANOTHER TUNE-UP: Left-hander **Sam Howard** is making a rehab start tonight for Bradenton... The four-year major league veteran was placed on the 10-Day IL on April 4 with a mid-back muscle sprain.

THE OPPONENT: The Flying Tigers' roster currently features seven players in *Baseball America's* pre-season top 30 prospect rankings for the organization: OF Roberto Campos (#8), INF Isaac Pacheco (#10), INF Cristian Santana (#11), INF Manuel Sequera (#12), RHP Tyler Mattison (#19), RHP Alex Faedo (#21), and OF Jose de la Cruz (#23). In 2021, Lakeland finished fifth in the West Division with a 55-63 record, but went 9-3 against the Marauders.

TOP PROSPECTS: The Marauders roster currently includes one prospect in *Baseball America's* pre-season Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: outfielder **Rodolfo Nolasco** (#21). *Baseball America* lists the Pirates' farm system as the third-best in baseball, thanks to a wealth of talent headed by former Marauder Oneil Cruz (*BA's* #14 overall prospect), catcher Henry Davis, and right-hander Quinn Priester.

FIELD STAFF: Manager **Jonathan Johnston**, 2021 Low-A Southeast Manager of the Year, is in his second season at the helm for the Marauders and heads a new staff... Former major leaguer **Yorman Bazardo** is the club's new pitching coach after spending 2021 as a pitching coach for the FCL Pirates... Former Pirate **Mendy López** joins as hitting coach after serving as the Pirates' Latin American Field Coordinator in 2021... **Casey Harms** is the Marauders' Integrated Baseball Performance Coach after a collegiate coaching career in the Northwoods League (Waterloo Bucks, 2019-20) and at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018)... **Gustavo Omaña** is the Marauders' Development Coach after serving on staff at Triple-A Indianapolis in 2021.

WHAT'S IN A NAME? In March, Minor League Baseball announced the return of historic names to each of its leagues as they were known prior to 2021. Thus, the now-former Low-A Southeast is known once again as the Florida State League, a moniker first used in 1919. Professional baseball in Bradenton dates back to that same season; the Bradenton Growers were charter members of the FSL when it began operations in 1919.

THE MORE, THE MERRIER: The Florida State League will play a 132-game schedule this season after playing a slightly shortened 120-game campaign in 2021. The Marauders will play 102 of their 132 games against West Division foes, including 21 games against Dunedin, the largest season series of the year for Bradenton. All but two teams—Daytona and St. Lucie—will visit LECOM Park this season, and the Marauders will travel to each city in the league in 2022 except for Port St. Lucie.

HITTING TRIPLE DIGITS: The 2022 season marks the 100th year of operation for LECOM Park, known as City Park upon opening in 1923. It has served as a spring training home for six different MLB franchises, including the Pirates since 1969. Baseball hall-of-famers who once called the historic park their spring home include Henry Aaron, Roberto Clemente, Dizzy Dean, Rogers Hornsby, Reggie Jackson, and more.

2022: *Pitching on major league rehab assignment (placed on 10-day IL on April 4 with a mid-back muscle sprain)...*

2021: Set career highs in wins, appearances, innings pitched and strikeouts (60)...Allowed 14.3% of his inherited runners to score (4-of-28); the fifth-best mark in the N.L.
