**FISHER CATS WINNING STREAK SNAPPED IN 6-1 LOSS:** Kyle Johnston held the Somerset Patriots (Yankees Double-A affiliate) scoreless through five impressive innings (4H, 3 BB, 2 K), but the Fisher Cats (Blue Jays Double-A affiliate) took a 6-1 loss to snap a two-game winning streak on Thursday night at Delta Dental Stadium.

**EARLY STREAKS:** Otto Lopez doubled home a run in the bottom of the eighth inning to break up the shutout. Earlier in the game, Lopez beat out an infield single to extend his hit and on-base streaks to a team-best seven games. Gabriel Moreno, who had the day off on Thursday, has a hit in each of the six games he has played for New Hampshire.

**LATE INNING WOES:** In four of the six losses this season, the Fisher Cats bullpen has allowed at least four runs in an inning, including last night. Jon Harris (L, 0-2) suffered his second loss after allowing a solo homer by Thomas Milone on the first pitch of the top of the sixth inning. Milone's second home run of the series broke the 0-0 tie. Harris, a Blue Jays first round draft pick in 2015 (Missouri State) has allowed home runs in each of his three outings. His 46 homers allowed in a Fisher Cats uniform is a franchise record. Emerson Jiminez matched a Fisher Cats record last night when he threw four wild pitches in the eighth.

**COMING UP:** The fourth game of the only series with Somerset is at 6:35 p.m. tomorrow night. It will be Game Show Night at the ballpark- so c'mon down! New Hampshire will also be home next week, playing six games with the Portland Sea Dogs (Boston Red Sox Double-A affiliate).

**ROSTER MOVES:** Announced May 12: Catcher Rodrigo Vigil (pronounced vee-HEEL) has been activated on the New Hampshire roster. The 28-year old is a veteran of 473 minor league games, all in the Marlins organization.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** May 14, 2018 – Jon Harris earned the win as the Fisher Cats opened a series in Hartford with a 10-5 win. Vladimir Guerrero Jr. hit his sixth homer of the season in the first inning, and Juan Kelly added a grand slam in the eighth.

**FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays finished off another sweep of Atlanta with an 8-4 win yesterday afternoon. Cavan Biggio had a pair of doubles and two RBI. Bo Bichette drove in three with a single and double. Toronto is back in Dunedin, Fla. Tonight to open a home stand with the Phillies, Red Sox, and Rays....Triple-A Buffalo beat Rochester last night 3-1. Forrest Wall had three hits, Tayler Saucedo earned the win relief...Adv. A Vancouver topped Spokane 3-2....and Bradenton stopped Dunedin 4-1.

**ON THE HILL:** RHP Maximo Castillo makes his 2<sup>nd</sup> Fisher Cats start. The 22-year old has been in the Blue Jays system since 2015, reaching Double-A for the first time this season. On debut last Saturday in Portland, Castillo allowed five runs (three earned) on seven hits over three innings in a 5-1 loss.

Somerset starter tonight is Glenn Otto, a 25-year old the Yankees selected in the fifth round of the 2017 draft (Rice University). This is his second Double-A start. Allowed only two hits over six scoreless innings last Saturday against Harrisburg. Walked one and struck out six. Otto appeared in 14 games, 12 starts, for Adv. A Tampa in 2019, going 3-3, with a 3.20 ERA. He had 68 strikeouts in 56.1 IP.
