TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game road series against the Chattanooga Look outs at AT&T Field. This is one of two trips the M-Braves will make to Chattanooga this season.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves evened their record with a 5-2 win over the Lookouts in the first road game of the season. Great pitching and timely hitting earned the win.

- Four M-Braves pitchers combined to allow two-runs over nine innings. In his 2023 and Double-A debut, LHP Luis De Avila went four innings and allowed a run off two hits and three walks with five strikeouts. LHP Hayden Deal earned the win, allowing a run off a solo homer over two innings. RHP Alec Barger added two scoreless frames, and RHP Domingo Gonzalez worked out of a bases loaded jam to pick up the M-Braves first save of the season.
- The M-Braves took an early lead off a sacrifice fly from Luke Waddell in the first and added on two in the third to lead 3-0 after three innings. Waddell went 1-for-2 with two RBI and two walks. After the Lookouts pulled within one, Cade Bunnell came through with a two-out, two-run double in the seventh to push the lead back out to 5-2. Bunnell went 2-for-4 with two doubles and two RBI.
- THE RETURN OF THE SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer, the M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, returns for a third season. Lugbauer entered the season with a club record 46 home runs over two seasons. He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record
- The first baseman currently ranks as Atlanta's No. 29 prospect in Baseball America. He added to his own club record with his 47th career M-Braves home run on Saturday, April 8 vs Biloxi.
- MILLI ROCK: The versatile OF/IF Cody Milligan is out to a four-game hit streak to start the 2023 season. He currently has six hits with a league-leading four doubles. Milligan played in 68 games for the M-Braves last season, slashing .271/.345/.326 with a home run, 10 doubles, and 21 RBI.
- THE GORDON MOBILE: RHP Tanner Gordon went five scoreless innings in his 2023 debut on Saturday, picking up a win. He gave up three hits and a walk with three strikeouts. Gordon made 21 starts for the M-Braves last season. In his final six starts, he posted a 4-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (11 ER/33.0 IP).
- SIZZLIN' BULLPEN: The M-Braves bullpen has posted 20 innings in the first four games, allowing
- RHP Kyle Wilcox posted two shutout innings in two appearances, touching 100 miles per hour
- on his fastball. Wilcox is in his second year with the Atlanta organization.
  RHP Victor Vodnik tossed two shutout innings in two appearances. Vodnik made 24 appearances in Triple-A last season and received a NRI to Atlanta's spring training. He is currently Atlanta's No. 11 prospect on MLB Pipeline.
- In his Double-A debut, RHP Jose Montilla went three innings, allowing an unearned run with
- three strikeouts. Montilla spent time with Single-A Augusta and High-A Rome last season. LHP **Hayden Deal** pitched two scoreless innings on Friday and picked up his first win with two innings on Tuesday. Deal made 31 appearances, four starts, in a long relief role for the M-Braves last season.
- RHP **Alec Barger** has three shutout innings over two relief appearances in his first Double-A season. Barger made 38 appearances for High-A Rome last season.
- M-BRAVES FEATURE 16 RETURNERS FROM LAST SEASON: The M-Braves Opening Day squad includes six Top-30 MLB Pipeline prospects and 16 players who made at least one appearance with the M-Braves last season.
- The Top-30 prospects include RHP Victor Vodnik (No. 11), INF Cal Conley (No. 13), RHP Roddery Muñoz (No. 21), RHP Alan Rangel (No. 26), RHP Tanner Gordon (No. 28), and LHP Luis
- Returning M-Brayes position players include C Hendrik Clementina, C Javier Valdes, INF Cade Bunnell, INF Drew Lugbauer, INF Luke Waddell, OF Cody Milligan, OF Jacob Pearson, and OF Landon Stephens
- Returning M-Braves pitchers include LHP **Hayden Deal**, RHP Tanner Gordon, RHP **Coleman Huntley III**, RHP Roddery Muñoz, RHP Alan Rangel, RHP **Trey Riley**, RHP Victor Vodnik, and RHP Kyle Wilcox.

2023 SCHEDULE: The 2023 schedule features 138 games, including 69 home games. The M-Braves will take on division rivals Montgomery and Pensacola 30 times each while taking on division rival Biloxi 27 times. From the North Division, the M-Braves will take on Chattanooga 15 times and Birmingham, Rocket City, and Tennessee 12 times each (6 home, 6 road). All 2023 series will be six games in length, except for the first series against Biloxi and a threegame series against Chattanooga from July 14-16 after the All-Star Break.


