YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the RubberDucks, 8-7. Akron scored five runs in the third to take a 5-0 lead, including a three-run homer by Wuilfredo Antunez. In the bottom of the third, **Ty Hanchey** hit a two-run homer to close the score to 5-2. Akron added two runs in the top of the sixth for a 7-2 lead. In the bottom of the sixth, **Charlie Szykowny** brought in a run with a sacrifice fly and **Jack Payton** hit a two-run single to close the score to 7-5. **Bo Davidson** tied the game with a two-run homer in the bottom of the seventh and **Sabin Ceballos** gave the Flying Squirrels an 8-7 lead with a solo homer, his third of the series.

POSTSEASON BOUND: The June 12 win clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division title for the Flying Squirrels, locking in a postseason berth. The Flying Squirrels will play the second-half division champion in the Division Series. Game 1 will be at the home of the second-half champion on Tues., Sept. 15. Game 2 and, if necessary, Game 3 will be at CarMax Park on Thurs., Sept. 17 and Sat., Sept. 18. If Richmond advances to the EL Championship Series, Game 1 will be at CarMax Park on Sun., Sept. 20. This year marks the fifth postseason appearance in franchise history and the first since 2023.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This is the third series between these two teams this year and the RubberDucks' second trip to Richmond. The Flying Squirrels are looking to improve to 22 games over .500 for the first time since 2014. The Flying Squirrels are looking to win five-or-more games in a six-game series for the fourth time this season and for the second time against Akron.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 10-game win streak from April 4-15 was the longest in franchise history, surpassing an eight-game win streak from May 5-13, 2021, also beginning with the second game of the season. The 47-26 start is the best in team history through 74 games, passing a 42-31 start in 2014. Richmond has won seven series, split five and lost one so far this year. After opening the season with a 27-7 record through May 13, the Flying Squirrels are 20-19 in their last 39 games since.

RELENTLESS: In their 47 wins this year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in 23 of them. In 16 of the wins, Richmond has taken the lead in the eighth inning or later. The Flying Squirrels have nine walk-off wins at CarMax Park this season, including at least one in each home series. **Drew Cavanaugh**, **Parks Harber**, **Dayson Croes** and **Diego Velasquez** each have two walk-off winners this year. Richmond has three wins after trailing by five-or-more runs this season, including two against Akron.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS won the Southwest Division first-half title by seven games over second-place Erie. Richmond leads all 30 Double-A teams in doubles (147) and triples (21) and are second in batting average (.271) and second in hits (663). Over the last 12 games since June 14, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .156 (15-for-96) with runners in scoring position. The Richmond pitching staff has thrown seven shutouts this season, which leads the Eastern League and ranks tied for second in Double-A.

THE RUBBERDUCKS finished the Eastern League's first half in third place in the Southwest Division, eight games behind Richmond and one game behind Erie. Akron is 2-8 since June 18. The Akron roster features five players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects list, including OF Jaison Chourio (No. 9), C Jacob Cozart (No. 14), OF Alfonso Rosario (No. 24), LHP Josh Hartle (No. 25) and LHP Rafe Schlesinger (No. 29). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list features seven Akron players, including Chourio (No. 9), Rosario (No. 13), Cozart (No. 17), RHP Justin Campbell (No. 21), Hartle (No. 25), Schlesinger (No. 26) and INF Luke Hill (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Charlie McDaniel** makes his fifth Double-A start and his second against the RubberDucks this series. He started the series opener on Tuesday and picked up a win after throwing seven scoreless innings, allowing three hits with no walks and seven strikeouts. After allowing six runs over three innings in his Double-A debut on June 5 against Erie, McDaniel has gone 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (3 ER/18.0 IP) in last three starts since June 11. He went 3-1 with a 3.99 ERA in nine starts with High-A Eugene before being promoted to Double-A on June 2. With the Emeralds, McDaniel was the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 1-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER/16.1 IP) in four starts. He pitched his first professional season in 2025 and split the season between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, going 8-6 with a 3.68 ERA in 23 outings (12 starts). McDaniel signed with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent out of Presbyterian College in 2024 after being named First-Team All-Big South in his senior season. *For more on McDaniel, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Dylan DeLucia makes his 14th start of the season and the fifth of his career against the Flying Squirrels. He started the first game of the series on Tuesday and allowed one run over four innings in a loss. In his four starts against Richmond, he is 0-2 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER/18.0 IP). Today marks his fourth start against Richmond this season. On May 6, he threw four scoreless innings at CarMax Park. On May 30 in Akron, he allowed one unearned run over four innings. DeLucia split last season between High-A Lake County and Double-A Akron, going 7-7 with a 3.57 ERA in 24 outings (22 starts). DeLucia was selected by the Guardians in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Ole Miss, where he was named the Most Outstanding Player of the College World Series. This spring, he pitched for Team Italy in the World Baseball Classic, posting a 2.35 ERA (2 ER/7.2 IP) in two appearances.

IT'S BO TIME! **Bo Davidson** is batting .353 (6-for-17) with two homers, four RBIs, five runs scored and six walks in the five four games of this week's series against Akron after going 0-for-12 in the final three games of last week's road series against the Baysox. In his last 22 games since June 2, Davidson is batting .322 (28-for-87) with 10 homers, two doubles and 22 RBIs, adding 12 walks. From June 4-7, he homered in four consecutive games, a new Flying Squirrels franchise record. From June 2-June 7, he picked up at least one RBI in six consecutive games, one shy of the franchise record. His 10 homers in June are the most in a calendar month in franchise history, passing eight by Jarrett Parker (May 2013) and Sean Roby (April 2022). He is the 11th player in Flying Squirrels franchise history to reach 16 homers in a season, which leads the Giants minor leagues this year. Davidson has 24 career homers with Richmond since being promoted to Double-A last July, which ranks 10th in franchise history.

SECOND-HALF SABIN: In the first five games of the Eastern League's second half, **Sabin Ceballos** is batting .350 (7-for-20) with three homers, a double, six RBIs and two walks. He homered and drove in four runs on Tuesday, added a solo homer on Friday and hit a go-ahead homer in the seventh on Saturday. In the first half, Ceballos batted .223 (46-for-206) with seven homers, 11 doubles and 22 RBIs in 59 games. In the first half in 2025, Ceballos hit .184 (36-for-196) with one homer and 18 RBIs in 48 games but batted .290 (47-for-162) with five homers and 29 RBIs in the second half. In his first full professional season in 2024, Ceballos hit .267 (58-for-217) with a homer and 16 RBIs in the first-half with High-A Rome before batting .270 (63-for-233) with nine homers and 44 RBIs in the second half with Rome and High-A Eugene after being traded to the Giants.

SIO LATER: **Jean Carlos Sio** has five homers and 13 RBIs in his last 13 starts since June 10. He began the stretch with his first Double-A homer on June 10 at CarMax Park against Harrisburg, a solo shot. The following game on June 11, he went 2-for-5 with a solo homer and a two-run triple. In the division-clinching win on June 12, he drove a two-run single in the first inning. On June 14, he hit a game-tying, two-run homer in a comeback win. On June 17, Sio drove a two-run, go-ahead homer in the eighth in Bowie. He hit a solo homer on June 19 in Bowie.

JACK ATTACK: In his last 17 games since June 5, **Jack Payton** is batting .400 (24-for-60) with a homer, four doubles, a triple, 10 RBIs, six walks and 10 runs scored. He has eight multi-hit performances in his last 15 games dating back to June 9, including six two-hit games and two three-hit games. He drove a two-run double on Tuesday night in a 3-0 win, added an RBI single Wednesday night, had an RBI double in Thursday's 10th-inning rally and hit a two-run single to help fuel Saturday's five-run comeback.

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 307 wins in his career, which is a franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23, 2025. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Of Richmond managers since 1954, Pelfrey is second in wins behind Eddie Haas (1968, 1981-84), who had 351 wins.

PACKING THE HOUSE: In 2025, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in total (446,679) and average (6,768) attendance for the fourth consecutive season. The average attendance was the highest in the franchise's history. April 7's inaugural game at CarMax Park had been sold out for more than a month, marking the 16th consecutive home-opener to sell out for the Flying Squirrels. This season, the Flying Squirrels rank fourth among the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance (6,986).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Bo Davidson** is fourth in homers (16) and fourth in RBIs (48). **Jonah Cox** is first in triples (5) and third in stolen bases (27). **Charlie Szykowny** is tied for fourth in doubles (17) and 10th in extra-base hits (29). **Tyler Vogel** is first in saves (10) and tied for fourth in wins (6). **Mitch White** is tied for sixth in saves (5). **Trystan Vrieling** is first in shutouts (1) and tied for first in complete games (1). **Cesar Perdomo** is first in WHIP (1.07), second in strikeouts (83), second in BAA (.211), sixth in ERA (3.88) and tied for eighth in innings pitched (67.1).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features four players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bo Davidson** (No. 3), **Parks Harber** (No. 16), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 24) and RHP **Yunior Marte** (No. 29). **Adrian Sugastey** is rated by Baseball America as the top defensive catcher in the Giants organization. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Davidson (No. 6), Harber (No. 13) and INF **Maui Ahuna** (No. 18) and Marte (No. 25).

ROAD TO THE SHOW: 2025-26 Flying Squirrels catcher **Drew Cavanaugh** was called up by the San Francisco Giants on Friday and made his MLB that night, going 1-for-3 with a single and a walk. He became the 122nd Flying Squirrels alum to reach the majors and the second from this year's Richmond team, joining **Jonah Cox**. Cavanaugh is the sixth Flying Squirrels alum to debut in the majors this year, joining **William Kempner** (2023, Miami Marlins), **Victor Bericoto** (2023-25, Giants), **Bryan Torres** (2021, St. Louis Cardinals), **Tanner Andrews** (2022, Toronto Blue Jays) and Cox (2026, Giants).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1967: The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 5-2, at Parker Field. Jim Beachamp hit a pair of two-run homers for the R-Braves. A solo homer by Bobby Cox drove in the other run. It was the team's ninth consecutive win, tying the 1959 Virginians for the longest win streak by a Richmond team in the International League. **1973:** The Richmond Braves beat the Peninsula Whips, 4-3, at Parker Field. The start of the game was delayed 35 minutes because the Whips' bus broke down on the way to the ballpark. Larvell Blanks tied the game, 3-3, with a two-run homer in the eighth. In the bottom of the 10th inning, John Fuller hit a single to center and Larry Jaster beat a throw home to score the winning run. **2019:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Hartford Yard Goats, 3-2, at The Diamond. Johneshwy Fargas went 4-for-4, adding RBI hits in the third and sixth innings. Bryce Johnson added two hits and scored twice. Alfred Gutierrez struck out six over six innings. Melvin Adon closed his 10th save of the season.
