#### PITCHING DOMINATES, FIRES TWO-HITTER

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp took a no-hitter into the ninth inning on Tuesday en route to a 4-1 victory over the Charlotte Knights. Otto López led off the bottom of the first inning with a home run and the Jumbo Shrimp added two runs in the second on Troy Johnston's double. Patrick Monteverde struck out six in 5.0 no-hit innings. Mychal Givens pitched 2.0 perfect innings and Calvin Faucher did the same in the eighth. With one out in the ninth, Rafael Ortega homered to break the no-hit bid.

#### **GRAY'S ANATOMY**

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Tristan Gray**, who played 331 games with the Durham Bulls from 2021-23, has been on a tear since returning to the Bull City. The Missouri City, Texas native homered in five consecutive games from April 2-6, the longest such streak for a Jacksonville hitter since **Peter O'Brien** went yard in six straight games from June 6-11, 2018. Over the last seven games, six of which came against Durham, Gray went a combined 9-for-28 (.321) with a double, five home runs, eight RBIs, two walks and seven runs scored. During his career with the Bulls, Gray batted .233/.300/.474/.774 with 59 doubles, five triples, 71 home runs. 220 RBIs and 179 runs scored.

#### THE CHICKS DIG IT

It took into the club's second series of the year to hit their first home run, but Jacksonville has launched nine bombs over their last seven games. In 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp finished in the bottom of the IL in home runs (T-15, 160). Historically, Jacksonville has clobbered more home runs on the road since rejoining Triple-A prior to the 2021 campaign (82 vs 78 in '23, 109 vs 74 in '22 and 81 vs 55 in '21).

#### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Outside of a 10-0 loss to Gwinnett on March 31 and a 6-2 defeat to Durham on Saturday, all eight of Jacksonville's contests in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 6-2 in those affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

#### SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through nine games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 34 runs, in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 16-for-90 (.178/.318/.322/.640, ranking 30th, 28th, 27th and 27th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 75 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

#### TROY MEETS WORLD

Jumbo Shrimp first baseman **Troy Johnston** is coming off an extraordinary season that saw him earn Marlins Minor League Player of the Year. Johnston finished the season leading all of Minor League Baseball in RBIs (116) while ranking fourth in extra-base hits (67), ninth in hits (157), tied for 10th in runs (102), 13th in OPS (.948), tied for 15th in doubles (36) and 17th in slugging percentage (.549). Over 134 games between Jacksonville and Double-Pensacola, Johnston slashed .307/.399/.549/.948 with 26 home runs and 24 stolen bases, becoming the first Marlins minor leaguer since 2008 to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals.

#### **BACK TO WINNING PLEASE?**

Thanks to a 75-55 (.577) record in 2021 and an 80-69 (.537) mark in 2022, Jacksonville collected back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 2013-14. In 2023, though, the Jumbo Shrimp finished just 70-79 (.470) to snap their run of winning records. Jacksonville finished the first half of the season with the International League's worst record at 32-42 (negative-51 run differential) before rebounding with a 38-37 (.507) in the season's second half (negative-23 run differential).

#### **SHRIMP BITES**

Of the 21 innings Jacksonville in which has scored in this season, 11 have been multi-run frames... The Jumbo Shrimp have won five of their last seven games, outscoring opponents by a narrow 32-27 margin... Edward Cabrera will make his third rehab start on Wednesday. Thus far, he has posted a 1.29 ERA.

#### ABOUT EDWARD

-Cabrera made his major league debut for the Marlins on August 25, 2021 against the Washington Nationals from loanDepot park. He yielded three runs on four hits in 6.1 innings.

-Once ranked as the No. 2 prospect in the Marlins' organization by MLB.com, Cabrera signed with Miamii for \$100,000 on July 2, 2015 as an international free agent. He was also a consensus Top-100 prospect in 2022, ranked 33rd by Keith Law of The Athletic, 34th by MLB Pipeline and No. 69 by both Baseball Prospectus and Baseball America.

-The Marlins were fairly aggressive with Cabrera in the minor leagues, starting his professional career in the Gulf Coast League. After just 82.2 innings in 24 games, including 13 starts, with the GCL Marlins and Short Season Class A Batavia, Cabrera found himself in full season ball with Low-A Greensboro in 2018 at the age of 19.

### 2024 SEASON

-Assisgned to Jacksonville on March 30 on a rehab assignment.

#### 2023 SEASON

-Posted a  $2.91\,\mathrm{ERA}$  in seven home MLB starts, going 5-0 while going 0-6 in 10 road starts with a  $6.28\,\mathrm{ERA}.$ 

-Named the International League Pitcher of the Week for the week of August 7-13 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings of one-hit ball with 10 strikeouts on August 12 against Norfolk.

#### 2022 SEASON

-In 14 starts with Miami, posted a 1.49 ERA in seven road starts versus a 4.58 ERA in seven starts at home.

#### 2021 SEASON

-Cabrera made two rehab starts with Low-A Jupiter on June 6 and June 12, throwing 6.0 scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts and no walks. His rehab assignment ended on June 15, when he was assigned to Double-A Pensacola. After five starts with the Blue Wahoos, he was promoted to Jacksonville on July 15.

#### 2020 SEASON

-Cabrera was a member of the Marlins' Alternate Training Site.

#### 2019 SEASON

-Cabrera was assigned to Jacksonville on June 23 from High-A Jupiter. At the time of his promotion, the right-hander ranked second in the Florida State League out of 60 pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched in FIP (2.28), third in strikeout percentage (32.2 percent), fourth in K-BB% (24.3 percent), fifth in xFIP (2.64) and nint in ERA (2.02). He also tallied the circuit's sixth-highest swinging strike percentage (14.5 percent).

-The Santiago, Dominican Republic native surrendered four runs to the first five batters he faced on the season on April 5 at Palm Beach. However, he did not cede another tally until the sixth inning of his start on May 23, a span of 28 consecutive scoreless innings.
