**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 4-3. **Charlie Szykowny** opened the scoring with a solo homer in the top of the fourth. In the fifth, the Baysox took a 2-1 lead on a pair of sac flies. With two outs in the top of the eighth, **Lisbel Diaz** hit a three-run homer, his first at Double-A, to move Richmond ahead, 4-2. The Baysox scored a run in the bottom of the eighth to close the score to 4-3. **Tyler Vogel** closed out his league-leading 15th save of the year with a 1-2-3 ninth. **Miguel Mendez** made his Flying Squirrels debut and struck out five over 2.2 scoreless innings. **Jack Choate** threw two scoreless innings.

**POSTSEASON BOUND:** The June 12 win clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division title for the Flying Squirrels, locking in a postseason berth. The Flying Squirrels will play the second-half division champion in the Division Series. Game 1 will be at the home of the second-half champion on Tues., Sept. 15. Game 2 and, if necessary, Game 3 will be at CarMax Park on Thurs., Sept. 17 and Sat., Sept. 18. If Richmond advances to the EL Championship Series, Game 1 will be at CarMax Park on Sun., Sept. 20. This year marks the fifth postseason appearance in franchise history and the first since 2023.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the fifth of a six-game series and the 11th of a 12-game road trip. This is the second of three series between these two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels lost four-of-six in Bowie from June 16-21, their first of three series losses this season. The Baysox will come to Richmond for a six-game series to conclude the regular season from Sept. 8-13. Richmond is looking for a win to secure its first series win since June 23-28 against Akron and first on the road since April 14-19 at Hartford. The Flying Squirrels are also eyeing their first four-game win streak since May 5-8 against Akron. They have seven three-game win streaks since then.

**RECORD YEAR:** The Flying Squirrels' 10-game win streak from April 4-15 was the longest in franchise history, surpassing an eight-game win streak from May 5-13, 2021, also beginning with the second game of the season. The 69-47 record is the best in team history through 116 games, ahead of a 67-49 record in 2014. Richmond has won seven series, split 10 and lost three so far this year. After opening the season with a 27-7 record through May 13, the Flying Squirrels are 42-40 in their last 82 games since.

**RELENTLESS:** In their 69 wins this year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in 35 of them. In 23 of the wins, Richmond has taken the lead in the eighth inning or later. The Flying Squirrels have 11 walk-off wins at CarMax Park this season, including at least one in all but one home series. **Diego Velasquez** has three walk-off hits this year, all in 10th innings. **Drew Cavanaugh**, **Parks Harber** and **Dayson Croes** each have two walk-off winners this year. Richmond has four wins after trailing by five-or-more runs this season. The Flying Squirrels are batting .284 in the ninth inning this year, which leads the EL and is sixth in MiLB. The Flying Squirrels have won 27 one-run decisions this year, the most in the EL.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** won the Southwest Division first-half title by seven games over second-place Erie. For the year, Richmond is tied for first among all 30 Double-A teams in batting average (.269), tied for first in sacrifice flies (47), third in doubles (210), third in hits (1027) and fourth in triples (29). The team has combined for 112 homers this year, surpassing 12 of the franchise's previous 15 season totals. On Aug. 18 at Chesapeake, the Flying Squirrels set new single-season record for stolen bases, passing 168 in 2014. The Flying Squirrels are on pace to set offensive single-season franchise records for batting average, runs, total bases, doubles, RBIs, OBP, SLG, OPS and sacrifice flies. Richmond's No. 9 batters have combined to hit .315 this year, which leads the minors. The Flying Squirrels have scored 10-or-more runs 12 times this year, passing 2023 (11) for the most in a season in franchise history. The Richmond pitching staff has thrown 10 shutouts this season, which is tied for first in the Eastern League, tied for second in Double-A and tied for third in MiLB.

**THE BAYSOX** are tied for second place in the Southwest Division second-half standings, 6.5 games behind first-place Erie. They went 3-2 in last week's road series at Reading with Sunday's series finale being canceled. The Chesapeake roster features eight players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list, including RHP Antony Eyanson (No. 1), LHP Joseph Dzierwa (No. 3), LHP Caden Hunter (No. 4), RHP JT Quinn (No. 13), SS Wehiwa Aloy (No. 15), LHP Sebastian Gongora (No. 24), 2B/OF Aron Estrada (No. 25) and RHP Brock Moore (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list features six Baysox players, including Eyanson (No. 2), Dzierwa (No. 3), Hunter (No. 4), Aloy (No. 8), Estrada (No. 13) and Quinn (No. 14).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Charlie McDaniel** makes his 13th Double-A start and his second against the Baysox. He last pitched last Friday in Harrisburg in a no-decision and a Double-A-high 10 hits and tied his Double-A high with five runs allowed over 6.1 innings. He faced the Baysox in Bowie on June 17 in his third Double-A start and allowed two runs (one earned) over five innings in a no-decision. McDaniel went 3-1 with a 3.99 ERA in nine starts with High-A Eugene before being promoted to Double-A on June 2. He was the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 1-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER/16.1 IP) in four starts. He pitched his first professional season in 2025 and split the season between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, going 8-6 with a 3.68 ERA in 23 outings (12 starts). McDaniel signed with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent out of Presbyterian College in 2024 after being named First-Team All-Big South in his senior season. **For more on McDaniel, see page two.**

**FOR CHESAPEAKE:** Right-hander JT Quinn makes his second Double-A start. He made his Double-A debut last Saturday at Reading and allowed one run over four innings. Quinn was selected by the Orioles with the 69th pick in the 2025 MLB Draft out of the University of Georgia, where he pitched one season after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Ole Miss. He made his professional debut with High-A Frederick this spring and went 4-3 with a 3.75 ERA in 21 outings (20 starts) before being promoted to Chesapeake on August 11. Quinn is rated by Baseball America as the No. 13 Orioles prospect and No. 14 by MLB.com.

**KILEN IT:** In his first 30 Double-A games, **Gavin Kilen** is batting .319 (37-for-116) with a homer, 10 doubles, three triples and 16 RBIs. For the season, he is tied for second among all MiLB hitters with 37 doubles. He is third among all Giants minor league hitters with 81 RBIs this year. After playing in the All-Star Futures Game in Philadelphia, Kilen was promoted to Double-A on July 17. He has at least one hit in 24 of his 30 games in the Eastern League. Kilen was selected by the Giants last year out of the University of Tennessee with the 13th overall pick in the MLB Draft. He is tied for the third-highest pick in the MLB Draft in Flying Squirrels franchise history with Patrick Bailey (2020) and trailing only Joey Bart (2, 2018) and Hunter Bishop (10, 2019). On August 13, he became the sixth player in Flying Squirrels franchise history to triple twice in the same game. On Wednesday, he tied his career high with four hits and drove in the go-ahead run in the ninth.

**SABIN SURGING:** **Sabin Ceballos** had his third two-homer game of the season on Wednesday night. He has seven walks over his last five games dating back to August 14. Ceballos has 62 walks this season, tied for fourth-most in a season in franchise history with Mark Miniccozzi (2013) and Jarrett Parker (2013). In his career, Ceballos has worked 109 walks, which is fifth-most in Flying Squirrels franchise history.

**TOP SKIPPER:** Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 329 wins in his career, which is a franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23, 2025. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Of Richmond managers since 1954, Pelfrey is second in wins behind Eddie Haas (1968, 1981-84), who had 351 wins.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Charlie Szykowny** is tied for third in triples (4), eighth in hits (105) and tied for ninth in total bases (176). **Sabin Ceballos** is tied for fifth in walks (62). **Diego Velasquez** is fifth in batting average (.295) and seventh in OBP (.384). **Bo Davidson** is tied for eighth in homers (19), seventh in SLG (.521) and 10th in OPS (.861). **Jonah Cox** is tied for first in triples (5) and ninth in stolen bases (27). **Tyler Vogel** is first in saves (15) and tied for seventh in wins (8). **Trystan Vrieling** is first in shutouts (1), tied for first in complete games (1) and sixth in ERA (4.26).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Richmond's roster features four players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Gavin Kilen** (No. 10), **Trevor Cohen** (No. 12), RHP **Miguel Mendez** (No. 20), and RHP **Yunior Marte** (No. 27). Jordan is rated as the organization's best athlete. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Kilen (No. 6), Cohen (No. 14), Mendez (No. 16), **Jancel Villarroel** (No. 19), Marte (No. 25) and **Lisbel Diaz** (No. 30).

**MISC NOTES:** **Tyler Vogel** is the first Eastern League reliever to reach 15 saves in a season since Portland's Luis Guerrero (18) in 2023. He now has the fifth-most saves in a season in franchise history, with **Heath Hembree**'s 17 saves in 2011 next on the list. Vogel is also seventh in franchise history in career saves with 21, trailing **Josh Osich** (2013-2016) and **Tyler Myrick** (2023-2025) for a tie for fifth with 22. // **Lisbel Diaz** hit his first Double-A homer on Friday and his 25th overall this season between Low-A San Jose, High-A Eugene and Richmond, which is tied with Bo Davidson, who also homered on Friday, for the most in the Giants organization this year. // Former Richmond pitcher **Taylor Rashi** (2022) made his first appearance for the Athletics on Thursday, allowing one run over two innings. He was designated for assignment by the Diamondbacks in June and the Twins in August before being claimed the Athletics. // Former Flying Squirrels reliever **Erik Miller** (2023) pitched a scoreless inning against the Giants on Friday night at Fenway Park. // There have been 47 Flying Squirrels alumni who have played in the majors this year (plus **Donovan Walton**, who had previous MLB experience before playing in Richmond), including 25 with the Giants. // Friday's win moved the Flying Squirrels back into the best overall record in the Eastern League this year, a half-game ahead of Erie. Richmond sat alone with the EL's best record from April 11 (7-1) until August 15 (66-46, tied with Erie, which sat a half-game ahead of Richmond from August 16-20. // The Richmond pitching staff threw 13 consecutive scoreless innings from Wednesday's ninth inning through Friday's fourth inning, their second-longest streak of the year trailing only 14 consecutive innings from May 10-12.

### THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

**1976:** The Richmond Braves beat the Charleston Charles, 6-5, at Parker Field. Down by two entering the bottom of the ninth, Jeff Geach hit an RBI single and Jimmie Collins drove in a run to tie the game. After Dale Murphy struck out and Chico Ruiz was intentionally walked to load the bases, Jack McKeon brought on pinch-hitter Jerry Maddox, who drove a single to bring home the walk-off winning run. **1979:** The Richmond Braves beat the Pawtucket Red Sox, 5-4, at Parker Field. In the bottom of the 11th inning, Jerry Maddox won the game with a walk-off single. Tommy Boggs pitched all 11 innings for Richmond and struck out eight. **2024:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Altoona Curve, 7-6, at The Diamond. Diego Velasquez hit an RBI single in the eighth to tie the score, 4-4. Altoona score a run in the top of the 10th, Velasquez tied the game with a single in the bottom of the 10th. Altoona scored a run in the top of the 11th. In the bottom half, Justin Wishkoski hit an RBI double to tie the score, 6-6. Victor Bericoto hit a groundball to second that was misplayed by Kervin Pichardo to bring home the walk-off winning run.
