SALUTE TO SERVICE SUNDAY: After back-to-back wins to ensure at least a series split, the FredNats will go for the series win today against the Charleston RiverDogs, Single-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays. Fredericksburg sends RHP Davian Garcia to the mound today for the Sunday start trying to beat the RiverDogs for the second time this week. Garcia earned his first professional win in Tuesday's series opener against Charleston, pitching five scoreless innings in a 4-2 win for the FredNats.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Cristhian Vaquero hit a three-run homer (the first such home run of the year for the FredNats) and drove in four of the team's five runs in a 5-3 victory over the RiverDogs on Saturday night to earn at least a series split this week. Angel Roman pitched five solid innings after allowing single runs in the first and second innings to earn the win, and Gavin Bruni, Robert Cranz and Merrick Baldo combined to strike out 11 of the last 14 hitters to continue the bullpen's dominance.

THIS BULLPEN, MAN: The FredNat bullpen continues to be a dominant unit for Fredericksburg. After four more innings of one-run ball last night, the bullpen ERA stands at 2.89, which is not only the best in the Carolina League, it's the best in all of Single-A baseball and the 8th-best in all of Minor League Baseball behind seven teams at the Double-A and Triple-A levels. The FredNats currently have six relievers that have an ERA under three heading into this game with the RiverDogs. The bullpen has logged 102.2 innings this year compared to the starting rotation's 72.2, and the group has 119 strikeouts and only 49 walks.

MORE ON THE BULLPEN: The six relievers with an ERA under three so far are Austin Amaral, Erik Tolman, Matthew Bollenbacher, Merrick Baldo, Merritt Beeker and Adam Bloebaum. That group has allowed a combined 11 earned runs this year, and the group has a strikeout-to-walk ratio of nearly 4:1.

SUPERMAN VAQUERO: Cristhian Vaquero has enjoyed his best series of the season this week against the RiverDogs. After a three-run homer and a four-RBI game last night, Vaquero is now 9-for-21 this week with a homer, a triple, a double, 7 RBI, and an OPS of 1.169, which is the fourth best in the Carolina League this week among qualified hitters. After Jorgelys Mota's monster week last week to earn him Carolina League Player of the Week, Vaquero is putting his best case in to win this week's version of the award.

TIME FOR SOME HARDWARE: Jorgelys Mota was named the Carolina League Player of the Week for his effort last week in Fayetteville. The 19-year-old third baseman had a game-tying or go-ahead hit in the 8th inning or later of three out of the six games in that series. He hit a game-tying two-run homer in the 8th inning of Tuesday's game, drove in the eventual winning run in the top of the 9th of Thursday's game, and Friday night, hit a game-tying two-run double in the 8th inning. In the series, Mota went went 8-for-22 (.364) with a home run, three doubles, a triple, six RBI, five walks and four stolen bases.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN: While the FredNats don't have a ton of Top-30 prospect talent on this current roster, the team does have a wealth of experience returning, with 20 players out of 30 on the Opening Day roster having played for the FredNats before, and eight returners who played in the 2024 playoffs. Additionally, nine members of Washington's 2024 draft class appear on the Opening Day roster. Opening Day roster players that participated in the 2024 playoffs include Merritt Beeker, Adam Bloebaum, Robert Cranz, Alexander Meckley, Kevin Bazzell, Jorgelys Mota, Nate Ochoa and Cristhian Vaquero.

2024 CHAMPIONS: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014. The FredNats broke the Charleston RiverDogs' run of three titles in a row, and became the first non-Charleston team to win the league since MiLB realigned to its current leagues in 2021.

NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

WELCOME TO FXBG: Davian Abdiel Garcia...was selected by the Nationals with the 170th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft out of Florida Gulf Coast last summer...this is his debut season.

LAST TIME OUT: Garcia completed five innings for the first time in his professional career in game one of this series. He gave up just three hits and didn't allow a run. The game was also his first scoreless pro start.

PRO MOMENT: Garcia's first career appearance came in relief during the FredNats' second game of the season at Carolina. The righty fired 1.2 scoreless innings in his pro debut, striking out two Mudcats. Since then, he's exclusively been used as a starter.

COLLEGE EDUCATED: Garcia threw for two different schools over the course of his collegiate career. He was an All-ASUN First Team selection at Florida Gulf Coast University as a junior in 2024 after transferring in from Pasco Hernandez State. He finished the 2024 college season as FGCU's Friday night starter after starting the season as a reliever. All in all, he went 6-3 for the Eagles last year, spinning a 3.10 ERA across 61.0 IP and striking out 71 batters. He led the ASUN with a 2.89 conference ERA

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
