MACLEAN SHINES, RIDERS SHUT OUT BY ROCKHOUNDS:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Midland RockHounds 4-0 from Momentum Bank Ballpark on Thursday night. Frisco (19-17, 58-46) starter **Dylan MacLean** (7-3) allowed a first-inning run to the RockHounds (17-19, 49-55), but it was unearned after an error, to make it 1-0. It was the seventh time in the last nine games the Riders had allowed a run in the first inning. That 1-0 score held until Luke Mann hit a solo home run to end MacLean's night in the sixth. MacLean threw 5.2 innings, allowing two runs, one earned, while striking out four and not walking a batter. The RockHounds then scored twice with two RoughRiders errors and a pair of hits in the seventh to boost their lead to 4-0. Nathan Dettmer (1-2) threw 6.1 shutout innings, striking out nine batters without a walk for Midland and Kenya Huggins locked down his third save with 2.2 frames out of the bullpen.

THE BUFFALO IS RUMBLING:

Arturo Disla has been one of the best hitters in the Texas League over the last month. Since July 10th, in 21 games, he is hitting .397 (31-for-78)/.462/.769/1.231 with 9 doubles, 6 home runs, 25 RBIs and 12 runs scored. In those games, he ranks 1st in the Texas League in batting average (.397), slugging (.769), OPS (1.231), hits (31), doubles (9), extra-base hits (16) and total bases (60). Overall this season, he is 2nd in the Texas League in batting average (.310) and 2nd in OPS (.940). He has already tied his season-highs in home runs (19) and doubles (25) with a month left to play.

WHY DO THEY CALL IT MID-LAND:

The RoughRiders are 10-11 against the RockHounds in 2026. The Riders have been out-homered 19-24, but Frisco has outscored the RockHounds 118-106. The RockHounds and Northwest Arkansas Naturals are the only two teams to outhome the Riders head-to-head. **Keith Jones II** has dominated Midland, hitting .405 (17-for-42)/.500/.643/1.143 with 2 home runs and 14 RBIs over 12 games.

THIS SHOWING IS IN IMAX:

Max Wagner has been hitting homers at a furious pace in 2026, tying his career high with 13 on July 23rd. He reached 13 homers in 58 fewer games than 2023. His 13 home runs from the 8 and 9 spots in the order are tied for the most in all of Minor League Baseball. Over his last 32 games, he is hitting .266 (25-for-94)/.373/.606/.979 with 9 home runs, 21 RBIs and 13 walks. Since June 20th, in those 32 games, he is tied for T-6th in the Texas League with 9 home runs while he is 5th in slugging percentage (.606) and 7th in OPS (.979).

ARM STRENGTH:

The Riders are 3rd in the Texas League in pitcher strikeouts this season with 1,032. Their 1,032 strikeouts are the 2nd-most in franchise history, trailing just the 2021 season (1,050 through 104 games).

GET RICH OR DIE DREILING:

RoughRiders outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** has been amazing recently. The No. 10 prospect is 6th in the Texas League in batting average (.293), 8th in OPS (.870), 4th in hits (104), 5th in total bases (177) and 7th in runs (66). Over his last 23 games is batting .355 (33-for-93)/.417/.667/1.084 with 9 doubles, 6 home runs and 17 RBIs. He has homered in back-to-back games. His 17 homers are the most by a RoughRider since **Abimelec Ortiz** in 2024. No RoughRider has hit 20 since **Blaine Crim** in 2022 (24 home runs).

BIG POWER STRETCH:

In their last 35 games, Frisco is 2nd in the Texas League with 56 long balls. Their 139 home runs through 104 games are the most in franchise history, as are their 5.9 runs per game. The RoughRiders have 8 players with at least 10 homers through 104 games (franchise record). From 2023-2025, the Riders had just 7 combined players with 10 or more home runs through 104 games.

OH, YOU THINK THE DARKNESS IS YOUR ALLY:

The Riders have been the best run-scoring offense in the 7th inning or later in Double-A (214 runs).

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 104 games the RoughRiders are 2nd in Double-A with 929 hits. They are 2nd in the league in batting average (.265) and 2nd in runs (617, 5.9 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 7 or more runs in 40 percent of their games (41-of-104). The Riders are 4th in the Texas League in homers (139), 1st in doubles (195), 2nd in SLG (.446) and 2nd in OPS (.800).

RIDERS ARE POSTSEASON BOUND:

The Riders clinched a playoff spot with a win on June 18th, capturing the Texas League South Division 1st Half. The Riders have now made the playoffs 11 times, their first berth since 2024, with two championships in 2004 and 2022. The Riders have now won the first half 9 times, their first since 2024. Frisco finished the first half 39-29 (.567).

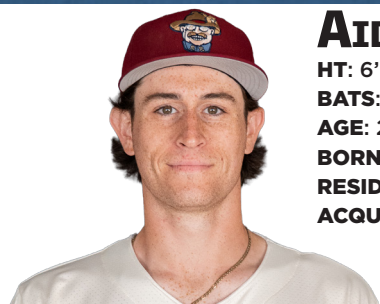

-Signed as a NDFA out of Fordham Prep High School in New York City. Fordham is the same high school as Vin Scully, Andrew Velezquez. As a junior, team went 22-4 en route to 2019 CHSAA city championship title.

-One of five Rangers pitchers to be signed after the five-round 2020 Draft, including former RoughRiders Josh Stephen and Nick Krauth.

-Originally committed to Bucknell University.

-Was part of the 2017 Ossining Little League team that won the New York state championship and advanced to the Little League World Series.

2026 SEASON

-Before promotion, went 2-1 with 3.48 ERA in 7 starts with High-A Hub City. Struck out 42 in 31.0 IP to 18 walks.

-With Hub City, led South Atlantic League in fly ball rate (51.4%) and 11th in ERA (3.48).

-Tied a career high with 12 strikeouts at Corpus Christi on 7/7. Riders tied nine-inning franchise record with 18 on the night. Over a 2-start span, Curry with 23 strikeouts, the most in a 2-start span in his career.

2025 SEASON

-Started the season with High-A Hub City, owning 4.72 ERA from 4/9-6/11 before spending short stint with ACL Rangers from 6/21-7/23. Returned to Hub City from 7/30-end of season, owning 3.00 ERA over 24.0 IP).

-116 K were 3rd among Texas farmhands and was his third-straight season with 100+ Ks.

-From 2023-25, Curry was 5th among all High-A and Low-A pitchers with 284.

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH

JASON HART

Years with RoughRiders: 9

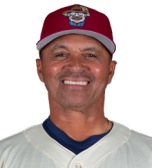
Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).
