GAME 100: After getting back in the win column last night for the first time in this series, the FredNats aim to even the series tonight on Travis Sykora start day in Lynchburg. Sykora has been one of the best starting pitchers in the Carolina League since debuting with Fredericksburg on May 1, and he will face Lynchburg for the second time after allowing two runs in three innings the first time he faced the Hillcats back in May. Sykora is coming off a career-high 10 strikeout outing last week, and will face Lynchburg lefty Melkis Hernandez, who is making his full-season debut today.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats exploded for 11 hits (seven for extra bases) in the first four innings of last night's game, and hung on at the end for a 9-7 victory over the Hillcats on Thursday night. Cristhian Vaquero hit a two-run double in the 1st inning, the first of three doubles in the game for him. Yohandy Morales hit a three-run homer in the 4th, and Brenner Cox had a two-run single as well. Nick Peoples' RBI double in the 3rd gave FXBG the lead that they would not relinquish. Brayan Romero allowed just two unearned runs in four innings in his full-season debut in a start last night as well.

JULY RECAP: The FredNats had the second-best record in the Carolina League in the month of July, going 14-9. Fredericksburg's pitching staff led the league in ERA for the vast majority of the month, but the rough finish in Lynchburg allowed Down East to edge FXBG for that accomplishment. The FredNats were pretty much in the middle of the road as a team offensively in the month, but did end up scoring the fourth-most runs in the league.

DON'T LET HIM GET HOT: Elijah Green homered in each of the first two games of this series, and has an extra-base hit in all three games as well. Since July 1, Green is slashing .269/.372/.493/.865 and has posted a wRC+ of 151 (100 is league average), and a wOBA of .406 (.313 is league average). He also cut his strikeout rate by 9% from June, and his walk rate in July was 14%. Green also has five career home runs in Lynchburg's Bank of the James Stadium, three this year and two last year.

CLUBHOUSE SWITCHER00: When the Nationals traded Lane Thomas to the Cleveland Guardians on Monday, the trade had repercussions in this series. Cleveland sent back Top-30 prospects Alex Clemmey and Rafael Ramirez Jr., both of whom were on Lynchburg's team prior to the trade. Both have switched clubhouses, and Ramirez Jr. will make his third straight start tonight, while Clemmey will make his Washington orgainzational debut on Saturday in a start. Ramirez has three hits in two games against his old team.

YO!: 2023 FredNat and top Washington infield prospect Yohandy Morales is off to a red-hot start in his first two rehab games with FXBG, homering in both games he's played in. Morales broke his thumb in Harrisburg in late May and had not played since then. Last year's second round pick out of Miami, Morales played in 18 games for the FredNats after last year's draft, slashing .390/.448/.571 for an OPS of 1.019. Morales is currently ranked as Washington's 4th-best prospect.

DOMINANT STARTS: After heavily relying on the bullpen for the first two months of the season, the FredNat starting rotation has majorly improved over the last six weeks. Since June 11, FredNat starters have logged 177.1 innings and allowed just 36 earned runs for a group ERA of 1.84. In the three weeks prior to that, the starting rotation's ERA was 5.70. In the second half, Fredericksburg leads the Carolina League with a 2.78 team ERA.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 197-163 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

TONIGHT'S START: Travis Sykora is making his 14th professional start this evening for Fredericksburg, against the Lynchburg Hillcats.

He was taken in the third round by Washington in the 2023, who gave him double-slot money to sign him away from a commitment to pitch at the University of Texas. That, along with some command issues that popped up during his senior year at Round Rock HS, caused him to fall from a first-round projection into the third.

QUICK CLIMBER: Sykora was promoted to the FredNats during the late April series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, but did not pitch. He also did not pitch last year after being drafted, but Washington felt he was ready to jump to full-season ball and will bypass the Florida Complex League entirely.

Sykora's calling card is a big fastball that reached 101 MPH on the prep circuit, and will sit in the mid to upper 90's. He pairs the heater with a splitter and a tight slider, both in the mid 80's.

A BIG MENTOR: Sykora has been open about how much he looks up to fellow Texan Nolan Ryan. Travis sees similarities in their two deliveries, between a high leg kick and "elbows and knees flying everywhere," Sykora said in a MLB.com interview. He was able to meet Ryan this offseason.

LAST TIME OUT: Sykora bounced right back after a slight bump in the road against Carolina. Against the Shorebirds last week, the big righty struck out a career-best 10 batters, as he allowing just an unearned run over four innings.
