## ROUGHRIDERS FALL ON SUNDAY, SPLIT SERIES IN ARKANSAS:

The Frisco RoughRiders spotted the Arkansas Travelers an early lead in an 8-4 loss on Sunday at Dickey-Stephens Park. Arkansas (2817) led off the game with a home run and never relinquished the lead. The Travelers tied the series at three games apiece with Frisco (20-24). The teams split a series in Frisco in April and will not play each other again in the regular season. Matt Brosky (0-1) made his Double-A debut for Frisco on the mound. After allowing a home run to the first man he saw and letting the next three batters reach, he escaped damage in the first with a strikeout and a double play. Frisco tied the game at 1-1 the next inning with back to back singles by Liam Hicks and Jax Biggers, the latter scoring Kellen Strahm. Brosky allowed four runs in the second inning before ending his night with a scoreless third. Alex Speas struck out the side in the fourth inning and the bullpen allowed just one earned run. Triston Polley went two innings with two unearned scores, Antoine Kelly did not allow a hit in the seventh but conceded one run, and Eudrys Manon faced the minimum in the eighth inning. Bryan Woo (3-2) gave up just one earned run in five innings for the win. Jax Biggers had two hits for the RoughRiders in the final game Frisco will play in North Little Rock. Biggers, the former Arkansas Razorback, had the team's first RBI with his base hit in the second inning. He singled and scored in the seventh as well. Thomas Saggese collected an RBI single in the seventh and also walked twice. He totaled eight hits in the series with four doubles.

## PLEASE CONNECT TO POWER:

Over the last nine games, Frisco has hit just two home runs while batting .227/.337/.307/.644. The two home runs (from Liam Hicks and Trevor Hauver) are tied for eighth-fewest in the league over the last nine (tied with Amarillo and San Antonio has 0 home runs during that stretch).

SCORE THEM ANY WAY YOU CAN:
The RoughRiders are hitting well this season with a .254/.356/.401/.757 slashline while being third in the Texas League in runs per game, averaging 5.5 runs per contest. They are fourth in average, third in OBP, fourth in SLG and third in OPS despite being tied for seventh with 42 home runs on the year.

## DOESN'T GET BETTER THAN TREVOR

RoughRiders utility man Trevor Hauver was hitting just . 163 through April 26th, but he has been on fire since. Over his last 21 games, Hauver is hitting .316 (24-for-76)/.372/.500/.872 with two home runs and 15 RBIs. In his last 14 games, the former Arizona State Sun Devil is hitting . 333 (18-for-54) with 14 RBIs. In 2022 with Frisco, Hauver hit .230/.432/.492/.924 over 21 games after starting the season in High-A Hickory.

## DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 19 bags in 42 games this season to lead the Texas League and the entire Rangers organization. If Harris plays 110 games this season, he is on pace for 50 steals, which would by far be a career high. The RoughRiders are tied for the fewest caught stealings in the league with just seven while stealing 67 bases ( 91 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:
The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with Liam Hicks hitting Frisco's sixth grand slam of the season on Saturday. They are the only team with six grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball and the only team with more than four. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese). Frisco also has a 1.230 OPS with the bags full, which is third in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.391 and Triple-A St. Paul, 1.243).

## THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 28 games, he is hitting .360 ( 41 -for-114)/.419/.526/.945 with eight doubles, a triple, three homers, 22 RBIs and 22 runs. In the month of May, he is batting .360/.419/.526/.945 and has four games with three or more hits to his name. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

## ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .302 ( 51 -for169)/.374/.432/.806 through the first 40 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (51), eighth in average (.302), tied for seventh in doubles (11) and tied for first in stolen bases (18). Over his last 36 games, he is batting .318/.395/.464/.859. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (119).

## WALK THIS WAY

On the season, Frisco's 224 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their 356 team OBP is third in the Texas League. Dustin Harris is second in the league with 33 walks while Evan Carter is fourth in OBP (.414) in the league and third in the league with 31 walks.
