GENERAL STATEMENT

On behalf of the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, the proud Double-A Affiliate of the New York Mets, the practices below represent best efforts to proactively invest and keep our fans and community safe when attending functions, events, and games at RumbleTown Stadium. The outlined steps and initiatives are intended to preserve the safety of staff, players, fans, and guests.

The Rumble Ponies will continue to follow the guidance of MLB, national, state, and local agencies to develop these policies.

Per New York State guidelines, to begin the season attendance for games will be limited to approximately 20% capacity.

COVID-19 TESTING/PROOF OF VACCINATION

Per New York State guidelines, to begin the season each fan in attendance, over the age of two (2), will be required to take a PCR or rapid antigen COVID-19 test with negative results or provide proof of a full COVID-19 vaccination (Excelsior Pass, paper copy, or digital photograph) upon entry.

Or

Full vaccination, meaning both doses of either the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine or one dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine received at least 14 days prior to the day of the game.

Or

A negative test result from a PCR COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours of the day of the game.

A negative test result from a COVID-19 Antigen test taken within six (6) hours of the game's scheduled start time (i.e. 1:10 p.m. for a 7:10 p.m. game).

TEMPERATURE CHECKS

In addition to the above, each guest in attendance will be required to complete temperature checks and screening questions on each game day in order to gain entry. Any patron with a temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or greater will be denied entry, as well as any member of the patron's party who may have been in close contact with the effected patron within the past 10 days.



FACE COVERING PROTOCOLS

All Guests ages two (2) and above, including those who have received a COVID-19 vaccine, must wear a face covering over their nose and mouth at all times while visiting RumbleTown Stadium except when actively eating or drinking at their ticketed seats. Facial shields without an accompanying facial covering, gaiters, bandanas and face coverings with an exhalation valve are not permitted.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

We will be selling a limited number of tickets in specified seating locations (“Ticket Pod(s)”) to select home games (“Limited Capacity Games”) in an effort to maintain New York State’s physical distancing requirements. Seating will be sold in Tickets Pods that range in size from one (1) to eight (8) Guests. The majority of the Ticket Pods will be two (2) and four (4) Guests in size.

MOBILE TICKETING

Due to health and safety concerns related to the pandemic, contactless technology will be implemented in many aspects of the RumbleTown experience. As such, tickets will be available digitally and available on the Guests’ mobile devices. Printed tickets will be available upon request for those who need them, but digital/mobile tickets are encouraged.

CLEANING

Based on current health and safety guidelines, enhanced cleaning and disinfecting protocols have been instituted to include public areas frequented by Guests and staff. RumbleTown Stadium will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected as needed.

STADIUM MODIFICATIONS

Plexiglass, signage & floor markers, and other physical distancing equipment and signage has been installed in customer contact areas. There will be hand sanitizing stations throughout the concourse level.

The Armory Team Store capacity will be limited to 6 patrons at a time.

There will also be a 12’ buffer zone around the dugouts and bullpen areas. The first two rows of seats in front of each dugout will be roped off to ensure player safety.



PROMOTIONS/ON-FIELD ACTIVITIES

MLB is currently not allowing any fan or employee to participate in any on-field/promotions. Contests, if allowed, will take place in locations other than the field. Autograph sessions with players will not be permitted.

RUMBLETOWN STADIUM STAFF HEALTH SCREENINGS

Your safety is of our utmost concern and as such all employees of RumbleTown Stadium will be required to provide proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 PCR/Antigen test, temperature checked and appropriately health screened upon entering the Stadium. Personnel will be required to wear face coverings as part of updated uniform policies.

CONCESSIONS UPDATES

Many concession locations will remain active to continue to serve and promote physical distancing. Guests may only eat or drink in their ticketed seat and are not permitted to eat or drink while on the concourse. Face coverings are required at all times while visiting RumbleTown Stadium, including while in your ticketed seat, unless actively eating or drinking.

As a means to alleviate lines on the concourse the Rumble Ponies have partnered with FanFood to offer mobile concessions ordering for the 2021 season at RumbleTown Eatery, portable carts, and beer stations. Fans will be able to pick up their food at the location at a given time and/or have it delivered to their seat.

Fans are encouraged to use this system and to use credit/debit cards or the FanFood app to pay for concessions and merchandise.

BAG POLICY

Due to the heightened health concerns, the Rumble Ponies encourage fans to leave all bags at home, but the following items will be allowed into RumbleTown Stadium: clear bags, medical bags, and diaper bags.
