# A TRUE TEAM VICTORY

The Chupacabras took down the Micheladas, 14-0. The Chupacabras jumped out to an early 2-0 lead in the first thanks to an opposite field blast by LF Dustin Harris that scored RF Sandro Fabian. Round Rock doubled its advantage to 4-0 in the second inning after its second two-run homer of the night, this time by CF Jose Barrero, plated 2B Matt Duffy. Round Rock took a 12-0 lead after six. Barrero added his third RBI of the game, drawing a bases loaded walk to bring home 1B Blaine Crim. SS Jonathan Ornelas drove in C Sam Huff and 2B Jax Biggers on a single up the middle. Fabian launched a no-doubt grand slam to continue the onslaught. In his second plate appearance of the inning, Crim plated Harris on a single to round out the eight-run inning. Fabian added an RBI triple to his tally in the bottom of the seventh inning which gave him five RBI on the night. Harris plated Fabian on a ground out to make it 14-0 in favor of Round Rock

## **GARABITO GETS THE BALL**

Express RHP Gerson Garabito is scheduled to take the mound in game one. Garabito has not allowed a run in his last 11.1 innings on the bump. The last run he surrendered came in a relief appearance on April 24 against Salt Lake. He has made two relief outings and four starts. As a starter, the righty is 1-1 with a 1.17 ERA (2 ER/15.1 IP).

### WHITE RETURNS

Round Rock RHP Owen White is scheduled to throw game two of the doubleheader. White has not appeared in a game with the Express since May 1. He spent the last few weeks with the Texas Rangers out of the bullpen where he made two appearances and allowed three earned runs in each outing. In his last start with the Express on May 1, he tossed 6.0 innings and allowed only rwo runs with only one walk and five strikeouts at Albuquerque.

# **BARRERO BREAKS THROUGH**

Express INF Jose Barrero posted a 2-for-3 night yesterday with a home run, three RBI, two runs scored, a walk and a strikeout. Barrero went 5-for-15 in his first three games from May 1-3 with the E-Train. From May 5-11, he went 0-for-20. In his last three games he is 4-for-11.

# **BLANKING THE ACES**

The E-Train collected their second shutout of the season yesterday. The first came on April 25 against Salt Lake. In both shutouts, RHP Aidan Anderson has collected the win and gone 3.0 innings out of the bullpen.

For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

## **EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS**

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win

campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
