### MUÑOZ SHINES AS JAX CLAIMS SERIES VICTORY

Roddey Muñoz dazzled over 8.0 scoreless innings on Sunday and Marty Costes homered and drove in three as the Jumbo Shrimp earned a series win with a 3-1 victory over the Stripers. Muñoz scattered three hits in his 8.0 dominant innings, walking just two with three strikeouts. He retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced. Costes crushed a two-run home run in the fifth to open up the scoring. He added a sacrifice fly in the ninth. Luke Waddell's RBI single brought Gwinnett within 3-1, but Anthony Maldonado stranded the tying run on first to pick up his third save.

### CONNECT FOUR

After dropping the first two games of their set at Gwinnett, the Jumbo Shrimp rallied to win the last four games to claim the series - the club's first series victory since taking four of six from April 23-28 at Memphis. The four consecutive victories also match Jacksonville's longest winning streak of the season. A victory in Tuesday's series opener over Durham would mark the club's first five-game winning streak since an eight-game roll from August 4-12, 2023.

### THE GREAT AWAKENING?

The Jumbo Shrimp were shut out on Wednesday, marking their 17th loss in 20 games. During that 20-game stretch, Jacksonville ranked 27th in Triple-A in batting average (.233), 29th in OBP (.319), 30th in SLG (.351), 30th in OPS (.670), 25th in hits (157) and 29th in runs scored (75). Over the last four games, however, the Jumbo Shrimp have plated 33 runs - more than a third of what they had compiled in the previous 20 games and tied for the second in Triple-A - on 45 hits (2nd) with 25 walks (3rd). As a team over these last four games, Jacksonville is 45-for-146 (.308/.408/.473/.881) with six homers and only 33 strikeouts.

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 33 of Jacksonville's 51 games (64.7 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 15 of the club's last 20 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 15 of its last 18 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 15-18 (.455) in these affairs.

### \*STARTING\* THE FIRE

After not having a pitcher toss 8.0 innings since Chi Chi González went 8.0 innings on August 2, 2023 at Memphis, the Jumbo Shrimp have seen consecutive starters fire 8.0 innings. This marks the first time since 2019 that the club has had two starters pitch at least 8.0 innings in a start in a season (Daniel Castano and Cody Poteet). It's also the first time that Jacksonville has had starters go at least 8.0 innings in consecutive games since Jose Alvarez tossed 8.0 innings in a 1-0 loss at Mobile on August 2, 2012 and Graham Taylor followed that up with 8.0 frames the next day in a 2-0 victory over Montgomery. Jumbo Shrimp starters have yielded two runs or fewer in three consecutive games (19.0 IP, 12 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 7 BB, 8 K).

### LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 17 of his last 18 games, notching eight multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 27-for-73 (.370/.447/.521/.968) with six doubles, one triple, one home run, 13 RBIs, 11 walks and 10 runs scored. Among the 186 IL hitters with at least 100 PA, Sanoja has posted the highest opposite-field rate (52.3 percent) and the third-lowest swinging-strike rate (3.8 percent).

### GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 18 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 16-for-his-last-58, slashing .276/.394/.621/1.015 with five doubles, five home runs, 15 RBIs, 12 walks and 12 runs scored. He's driven in at least one run in 10 of those 18 games.

### SHRIMP BITES

When the Jumbo Shrimp won four out of six games at Durham from April 2-7, it marked the club's first series victory over the Bulls since taking four of six from April 12-17, 2022 in the Bull City. Jacksonville had gone 0-5-1 in series (11-25 record) against Durham between those victorious sets.
