### LAST GAME

A tale of two halves, the Bowie Baysox were able to ride their early game work to their second-consecutive win on Friday night, taking down the Akron RubberDucks 6-4. Bowie scored all of their runs in the first five innings, while Akron scored all of theirs in the final four innings. After stranding two runners on in the first two innings, Maverick Handley laced a two-RBI single in the third inning, and Connor Norby followed with an RBI single in the fourth. Norby added another run in the fifth inning, and Zach Watson contributed as well in the fifth inning as Bowie built their six-run edge. Justin Armbruster teased a no-hitter for Bowie, working into the sixth inning before allowing his first base hit. Akron tagged him for three runs in that sixth inning before departing.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

Bowie has already had a good season against Akron, winning eight of the 11 games played between the pair by an average of over four runs in each win. When Akron missed a berth to the playoffs in the first half by just one game, their 4-11 start to the second half did not help their chances at making a run for the second half berth. Since that start, however, Akron has gone 11-5, the second best record in the league over that span behind Bowie's 13-3. Their late game work has kept them competitive on this current stretch. Out of their 11 wins on this current stretch, four wins are by one run, and four more wins by two runs.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Tanner Bibbee is still in just his first season as a professional after being drafted in the fifth round of the 2021 draft, and has proven his worth as another quality arm in the Guardians organization. He struck out 86 batters in just 59 innings while working with High-A Lake County for most of this year, and allowed only five earned runs over 22.1 innings in his last four starts before earning the promotion to Double-A. His work at Double-A has been just as impressive, as he's struck out at least four batters in every start for the Ducks, while walking only three total batters. He tossed a complete game in a doubleheader the last time he saw Bowie, but took the loss as he allowed two solo home runs to Connor Norby. His fastball can work in the upper 90s while his slider has drawn praise for its hard movement and swing-and-miss action.

### I'VE GOT A FEVER, AND THE ONLY PRESCRIPTION IS MORE COWSER

Bowie outfielder Colton Cowser has been staying hot since his call up to Double-A to start the second half. Cowser went 0-for-1 at the plate on Friday, but drew four walks and was on base after all five plate appearances. Already established as a patient batter, Cowser sports a 16.7% walk rate across the full season, third-best in the Orioles minor leagues. Cowser is ranked as the Orioles #4 prospect and #54 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline at the time of his promotion.

### NORBY KNOWS HOW TO HIT

After going 0-for-4 on Thursday, Bowie infielder Connor Norby got back to work on Friday with a 4-for-6 performance. Norby started the day 4-for-4 with a quartet of singles, two RBI, and a run scored. It was only the eighth four-hit day from a Baysox batter this season, but the second for Norby in just four games, after he went 4-for-5 in Bowie's 18-1 win over Harrisburg on Sunday.

### NOW THAT'S A STAFF

Bowie pitching has been on strong run since the standings reset. Over the second half, Bowie pitching has held a strong 3.12 ERA and 1.10 WHIP, leading all of Minor League Baseball in both categories. While the Baysox did enter this half with an overall 4.99 ERA, the highest in the league, the work in the second half has brought them down to just a 4.34, only the seventh-highest in the league. Bowie has only had one starting pitcher allow more than four runs in a start once this month.

### MIGHT AS WELL JUST START ON BASE

Some of Bowie's offensive woes this season have not been from a lack of effort. In fact, the Baysox are the team most likely to start an inning with a runner on base in the Eastern League. Bowie leads the league in all three slash lines (.276/.372/.479) from the first batter of an inning this season. They also lead the league in lead off doubles, while sporting the second-fewest strikeouts from the first batter of an inning. All of those numbers combine to Bowie leaving 778 runners on base this season, the most in the league, and an average of 7.4 per game. Inversely, Bowie has the second-most strikeouts in the league when batting with runners on base.

## CAREER NOTES

- Saw his ERA more than double across the jump from Low-A to High-A. 2.14 across 33.2 innings with Delmarva, and 4.94 across 31 innings with Aberdeen.
- In the Orioles system, his 79 strikeouts in 2021 were the third-most among pitchers who made at least half of their appearances in relief.
- Auburn native played four years for his local university, logging a 4.01 ERA, but a 0.67 WHIP.

## What They're Saying:

Watson on his approach to at bats: "I took what my college coach, coach Thompson at Auburn, he was big on not walking guys. Challenging the hitters, and going right after them. I try not to waste any time, and just go after them with my best stuff, and my best locations. Attacking hitters is my philosophy."

Watson ongoing through the 2020 draft as an NDFA: "There were a couple of teams that had made contact, but Baltimore was the one that been the most thorough in talking with me so it was a no-brainer."

Garrett Stallings, Bowie Starter and Watson's Throwing Partner: "He's put a ton of work on this offseason. Moving better, a lot more aware of his body. Honestly, I think he's just out there not thinking too much. When a pitcher is in a groove, the gears start turning. He's the most electric guy on the team right now, and he's trying extremely hard to get better, and that's a dangerous combination."

## NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/13 @ BNG Double-A debut, fired four perfect innings of long relief against Binghamton to earn a one-run win. He struck out seven batters, including the first four batters he faced.
- 4/20 v AKR Matched his previous relief outing with four more consecutive perfect innings, completing a one-hit shutout of Akron while earning a long save. Struck out three batters, induced six ground outs, and three fly outs. Across first 24 batters faced, only two reached a three-ball count.
- 4/27 @ RIC Saw his perfect streak come to an end on the fifth batter of the game on a single by Brandon Martorano. Allowed two runners to reach second base, but none to reach third base.
- 5/3 v HBG Lost his 13 inning scoreless streak after only two batters. Allowed back-to-back doubles to open the first inning, as Jake Alu drove in a run. Taylor Gushue followed with a two-run home run for three runs in the opening frame. Faced the minimum for 12-consecutive batters, but hit another snag in the fifth inning when he allowed a two-run home run to Alu. Bowie tied the game at five in the fifth, as Watson departed midway through the top of the sixth.
- 5/11 @ REA Allowed a two-out solo home run to Aldrem Corredor in the first inning, just into the corner in left field. Allowed two baserunners in the second inning through a walk and an error, but worked a double play. Faced exactly four batters in all five innings pitched on the night.
- 5/17 v HFD While Bowie did take an early 2-0 lead, he allowed five runs in the second inning after facing the minimum in the first inning. Three-run home run by Jimmy Herron was the key hit in the frame. Allowed a pair of unearned runs in the third inning after a leadoff error.
