JACKSONVILLE CRUSHES DURHAM, 12-2

Jacksonville blasted four two-run home runs in consecutive innings on Wednesday to stampede Durham 12-2. The Bulls scored the game's first two runs in the fourth. **Deyvison De Los Santos** crushed a two-run shot in a three-run bottom of the fourth to give the Jumbo Shrimp the lead. **Matthew Etzel** blasted a two-run bomb in the fifth and **Kemp Alderman** capped a three-run sixth with another two-run long ball. Jacksonville added three in the seventh, with two coming on a **Rece Hinds** two-run homer. One more Shrimp run in the eighth capped the scoring at 12-2.

GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT!

Jacksonville's pitching staff has recorded a whopping 893 strikeouts through 88 games, a rate of 10.1 per game. The Jumbo Shrimp have 59 more punchouts than Charlotte, the team that ranks second in Triple-A. Thus, the Knights' 834 strikeouts are as close to 13th-place St. Paul (775) than they are to Jacksonville in first. In addition to the swings and misses, the Jumbo Shrimp have also shown an ability to limit hard contact; their 87.0 average exit velocity against is the best such figure in Triple-A.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Jacksonville has racked up an impressive 24-18 (.571) record on the road this season - the 24 away victories rank in a tie for sixth in all of Triple-A. The biggest difference for the Jumbo Shrimp in their away contests has been their offense. At VyStar Ballpark, the club is hitting just .221/.336/.368/.704 with 210 runs scored (4.6 per game). Jacksonville is batting .261/.337/.425/.762 with 245 runs scored (5.8 per game) on the road.

ONE DIRECTION

Prior to Saturday's doubleheader, Jacksonville had won 11 of their last 14 one-run games, including each of their previous five such decisions. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost three consecutive one-run affairs. Nonetheless, the Jumbo Shrimp are still 16-10 (.615) in one-run games, the second-most such victories in Triple-A. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp earned 29 one-run victories, tied for the most one-run victories in MiLB. The 29 one-run triumphs were the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014, when the Jacksonville Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs.

WHITE NOISE

Brandon White made his Triple-A debut on May 21 against Norfolk, striking out eight in 5.0 innings of one-run ball. The Chehalis, Wash., native then struggled in three starts from May 28 through June 11, surrendering 21 runs, 19 earned, on 27 hits (.422 BAA) with six home runs allowed in 12.2 innings for a 13.50 ERA. White, however, has been magnificent in the three starts since that point. During this stretch, the Washington State product has yielded two runs total on eight hits (.145 BAA) with only one homer allowed in 16.0 innings. Over these last three starts, White has fanned 23 against two walks.

WHEN YOU'RE HOT, YOU'RE HOT

Jacksonville has won 13 of their last 19 games dating back to June 17, mainly behind a dominant pitching staff. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A in runs allowed (75), ERA (3.44) and batting average against (.213) while placing second in strikeouts (185) and third in hits allowed (130). Offensively, Jacksonville's 113 runs scored are tied for fifth in Triple-A since June 17. Their AVG/OBP/SLG/OPS slash line ranks 18th, 11th, 16th and 15th, respectively.

ETZEL DAY? WELL, I LIKE ETZEL DAY

Matthew Etzel got off to a very slow start to the season, hitting just .183/.256/.254/.510 over his first 20 games of the season. Over the last 49 contests, however, the Texas native is a scorching 52-for-180 at the plate, slashing a robust .289/.396/.522/.918 with eight doubles, two triples, 10 home runs, 31 RBIs, 31 walks and 42 runs scored. Since this stretch began on May 3, Etzel ranks third in the IL in runs, 11th in OPS, 12th in OPS, tied for 14th in walks, tied for 17th in homers, 19th in OBP, tied for 19th in hits and tied for 21st in extra-base hits (20).

SHRIMP BITES

Over his last 19 games, **Deyvison De Los Santos** is hitting .375/.430/.653/1.083 with five doubles, five home runs, 15 RBIs, five walks and 11 runs scored... **Kemp Alderman** is batting .348/.434/.565/.999 with one double, three homers, 11 RBIs, six walks and 12 runs scored... Jacksonville is 10-4 against Durham this season, marking the first time the Jumbo Shrimp have recorded double-digit wins against the Bulls since 2021 (15-21).

ABOUT BRANDON

-White was originally selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2018 draft out of W.F. West High School (Chehalis, Wash.). He opted to honor a commitment to play at Washington State University, where he appeared in 30 games, including 29 starts, over three seasons (8-12, 5.69 ERA, 131.1 IP, 153 H, 67 BB, 119 K). At Washington State, White was teammates with current Cleveland Guardians first baseman Kyle Manzardo.

-The Miami Marlins selected White in the 12th round of the 2021 draft, but did not appear in a professional game until 2023 while recovering from injuries. With his professional debut for the FCL Marlins on June 6, 2023, 693 days went by between when he was drafted and when he first stepped on a mound in professional baseball.

-White was a terrific basketball player at W.F. West High School, where he was coached by his dad, Chris. Brandon earned four letters and was a two-time All-Evergreen League forward. He was named to the All-State Tournament team as a senior after leading WFHS to a 24-5 record and second-place finish in the 2A tournament. White also lettered three times in football as a wide receiver.

-After finishing high school with a 3.96 GPA, White majored in electrical engineering while at Washington State. His uncle Eric and aunt Linhda both graduated from Washington State.
