THE SWEET LIFE: Rick Sweet enters the series against Sugar Land four wins away from tying Bob Coleman for the second-most wins by a manager in Minor League Baseball history.

INTERSTELLAR: Nashville travels to Texas for an Interleague matchup with Sugar Land (Triple-A Houston Astros). It'll be the first time the Sounds have played the Space Cowboys and Nashville's first series against a Pacific Coast League team since the Sounds joined the International League ahead of the 2021 season.

CROW-LITY START: Coleman Crow tossed a quality start (6.0 IP, H, 0 R, 6 K, 2 BB) in Sunday's series finale against Norfolk. It was his second career Triple-A quality start (4/3/26 vs. CLT) and the 18th of his minor league career. It was the seventh career start in which he did not allow an earned run where he worked 6+ IP. The Brewers no. 23-rated prospect set his single-season career-high with seven quality starts during the 2022 season with Double-A Rocket City. Crow earned his fifth win of the season with the Sounds, which is the second-most wins on the team behind Reiss Knehr (6). Crow owns a 24-8 record with a 4.16 ERA in 63 appearances (58 starts) in his five-year minor league career.

SHUTOUT CITY: The Nashville Sounds tossed their sixth shutout win of the season with a 4-0 victory against the Norfolk Tides Sunday night at First Horizon Park. The shutout win was led by Coleman Crow and supported by Cameron Wagoner (1.0 IP, K) and Gerson Garabito (2.0 IP, H, 2 K) to complete the shutout. It marked the 61st shutout win for the Sounds since 2021 to lead all Triple-A clubs. The two hits allowed by the Nashville pitching staff are tied for the least amount of hits allowed in any game this year, along with the two-hit performance in a 3-0 shutout of the Gwinnett Strippers earlier this year on June 25. It was the 18th time that Nashville has allowed fewer than five hits in a game this season. The Sounds are tied for second along with four other Triple-A clubs with their six shutouts this season, one behind Jacksonville.

BLACK SMACK: Tyler Black extended his on-base streak to 24 consecutive games in Sunday's finale, going 2-for-4, with a triple and an RBI. Black is hitting .305 (25-for-82) with 10 XBH and 17 RBI during the 24-game span. The streak marks the longest-active on-base streak on the Sounds and is tied for the fifth longest-active streak in Triple-A with Lehigh Valley's Dylan Moore. Black is currently one game away from tying Cooper Pratt's 25-game on-base streak, which is the second longest on the team behind Brock Wilken (30 G) this season. His three triples during his on-base streak (since June 13) are tied for the most in the International League (T-2nd in AAA), and he ranks fifth in stolen bases (11) during the span. His 10-game hitting streak is tied for the sixth-longest active streak in the International League, and he's the only Sounds' player to reach a 10+ game hitting streak this season, now doing it for a second time this season. He posted an 11-game hitting streak to lead the club from March 28-May 14.

BROCKET LAUNCHER: Brewers no. 19-rated prospect Brock Wilken launched his ninth home run of the season on Saturday night and ended an 0-for-14 stretch at the plate since his last hit left the yard with a grand slam July 10 on the road in Charlotte. Wilken leads the club with 51 RBI this season and is in a four-way tie for eighth in the Brewers farm system in RBI. He has tied his single-season career-high in RBI, a mark he set in 2024 in 108 games with Double-A Biloxi and reached 51 RBI this season in just 81 games this season. Of his nine home runs this season, six have been go-ahead home runs.

NO LIES: Right-hander Lyon Richardson set his Sounds-high with four strikeouts over 2.0 IP in relief of Colton Gordon on Saturday night. The four strikeouts were his most since striking out five on May 13 against Indianapolis when he was pitching for Triple-A Louisville. It was his ninth appearance without allowing a hit this season and just the second in which he worked 2+ innings. He also retired all eight he faced on April 15 also with Louisville against Toledo.
