FRED NATS WIN BACK-AND-FORTH AFFAIR: The Delmarva Shorebirds were defeated in the middle game of their seven game series to Fredericksburg as the Nationals edged them 6-5 on Thursday night. After falling behind in the top of the first, Delmarva grabbed the lead quickly thanks to a two-run double by Aneudis Mordan to make it 2-1 Shorebirds after an inning. Fredericksburg would score two more runs in the second to go back in front 3-2. The seesaw battle continued as Adam Crampton evened the game at three with an RBI single in the bottom of second and would score himself moments later on a wild pitch to give Delmarva a 4-3 lead after two innings. Luis Valdez would use his speed to score another run as he forced an error on a steal attempt of third base as he would score on a ball thrown into left field to give the Shorebirds a 5-3 advantage. The National would get back within one on a wild pitch in the fourth, and then would get the lead back on a two-run homer by Max Romero Jr. with two outs in the fifth to take lead at 6-5. That home run would prove to be the decisive swing of the game as the Fred Nats would hold on to win by one to even the series at two.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Luis De Leon gets the start for Friday night's match-up against the Fred Nats and he'll face the reigning Carolina League Pitcher of the Week, **Luke Young.** Young is coming off his best start of the season on Sunday against Lynchburg as he threw 7 innings, allowing just one unearned run on two hits, while striking out 9 batters. Delmarva has seen Young plenty this season as Friday will mark the fifth time he'll pitch against them and in his four prior appearances, he has an ERA of 2.63 allowing 4 earned runs in 13.2 innings with 18 strikeouts.

HEY STIVEN: Stiven Acevedo has emerged as one of the top power bats in the Delmarva batting order as the outfielder. Since the All Star Break, Acevedo has hit 10 home runs with 29 RBI while also producing 8 doubles with 2 triples. Acevedo has an OPS of .811 in the time frame and currently remains the leader in stolen bases with 32. He had an RBI streak of five games snapped on Tuesday against Fredericksburg.

ON-BASE REGULAR: Tavian Josenberger is coming off a strong road trip where he reached base in every game he played in as he currently owns a 14 game on-base streak. Josenberger has multiple hits in three consecutive games and has RBIs in four-straight. Most impressively, the 3rd round selection out of Arkansas has showcased an incredible eye at the plate, drawing 19 walks in 20 games.

MORE PROMOTIONS: Three of the recent draft selection by the Baltimore Orioles have officialy moved up to join the Aberdeen Iron Birds. **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (1st Round), **Mac Horvath** (2nd Round), and **Matthew Etzel** (10th Round) all earned a call-up to High-A after a month with the Shorebirds.

ON THE RUN: The Shorebirds currently ranked 8th in the league in stolen bases, but have been running much more lately as they stolen a league-best 89 bases since the start of August.

A LITTLE EXTRA: The offense for Delmarva leads the league in extra-base hits this season with a total of 304. They are top five in the league doubles (195), triples (36), and home runs (88).

LEARNING HOW TO WIN THE CLOSE ONES: The Shorebirds are coming off a road trip where they finished 6-6, but won four of those game by one run. Delmarva prior to the 12 game trip had only won four games by a single tally.

FINAL HOMESTAND: The Delmarva Shorebirds begin their final series of the regular season on Tuesday as they face the Fredericksburg Nationals for a seven game series. The Nationals have had Delmarva's number this season as they've won 11 of the past 16 games against the Shorebirds.

TODAY'S STARTER: Luis De Leon drawes the start on Friday night for the Shorebirds as he makes his 9th appearance and 5th start in a Delmarva uniform.

LAST OUTING (9/2 @ COL): Last time out was De Leon's toughest outing of the season as he surrendered 5 runs (2 earned) in 1.1 innings. He allowed just one hit but he struggled with his command as matched his career-high with five walks. He would take his first defeat of the season in an 11-4 loss to the Fireflies.

vs. FREDERICKSBURG: This will be the first time De Leon will face the Fred Nats in his career.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: Left-hander Luis De Leon made his professional debut last season after signing with the Orioles out of the Dominican Republic in December of 2021. De Leon pitched all of last season in the DSL and made 10 appearance with 5 starts where he=covered 28 innings, finishing with a 4-4 record and a 5.14 ERA. But most impressively, De Leon struck out 45 batters with 13 walks and generated a K/9 of 14.46 in his brief, debut season.

ROLL OVER: Getting the ball on the ground has been a strength for Luis De Leon as 31 of his 70 outs have been ground-ball outs in addition to his 27 strikeouts in 23.1 innings of work as a Shorebird. De Leon has now allowed a home run in 78.2 career innings.
