THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2017, Sounds pitchers Paul Blackburn, Tyler Sturdevant and Tucker Healy combined to pitch a four-hit shutout in Nashville's 6-0 win at Iowa. Blackburn went 7.0 innings, allowing two hits and one walk. Matt McBride and Matt Chapman also homered in the contest.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Durham Bulls play game five of the six-game series tonight. A quality start from Caleb Boushley and a grand slam by Corey Ray helped Nashville even the series with a 8-4 win yesterday. Right-hander Alec Bettinger starts for Nashville, going against left-hander Josh Fleming for Durham.

Alec Bettinger: 26-year-old Alec Bettinger starts for the Sounds tonight. The right-hander is 0-0 with an 8.18 ERA (11.0 IP/10 ER) in four games (3 starts). He last pitched on May 29 at Toledo. Bettinger allowed four runs (3 ER) on eight hits and two walks in the no decision. He struck out one over 3.0 innings, totaling 64 pitches (43 strikes). Bettinger is currently ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Brewers system, according to MLB Pipeline. The Virginia native went 0-1 with a 13.50 ERA in four games (1 start) for the Brewers in 2021. He spent most of last season with Nashville, finishing 3-7 with a 4.75 ERA in 21 games (18 starts). Bettinger was selected by Milwaukee in the 10th Round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Virginia.

Josh Fleming: 26-year-old Josh Fleming starts for the Bulls in game five of the series. The left-hander is 4-0 with a 1.59 ERA (22.2 IP/4 ER) in four starts with Durham. He's also gone 2-3 with a 6.38 ERA in six games (2 starts) for Tampa Bay in 2022. Fleming added his fourth straight win in as many starts for Durham in his last outing on May 29 vs. Charlotte. Though he yielded 10 hits, he held the Knights to two runs (both earned) in 6.0 innings of work. He struck out four on 82 pitches with 58 strikes. The Missouri native spent much of 2021 with Tampa Bay, going 10-8 with a 5.09 ERA in 26 games (11 starts). He also went 1-0 with a 0.90 ERA in seven relief outings with Durham last season. He made his Major League debut for Tampa Bay in 2020. The Rays took Fleming in the Fifth Round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of NCAA Div. III Webster University in Webster Groves, Mo.

The Nashville List: Yesterday's win for Rick Sweet was his 181st as manager of the Nashville Sounds. It's the sixth-most managerial wins in franchise history. Pete Mackanin is fifth on the list with 186 wins.

Willy Goes Deep: In his second appearance with the Sounds, Brewers shortstop Willy Adames went 1-for-3 with a homer and two walks last night. It is his second home run on the rehab stint (first was with Carolina on May 29 vs. Kannapolis).

Free Ride: Sounds first baseman Jon Singleton walked twice, bringing his base on ball total to 38 on the year. His 38 walks lead Triple-A baseball. He's also walked 2+ times in 12 games this season.

He Gets On Base: Jonathan Davis reached base safely in his 16th-straight game on Thursday, going 1-for-5 with a stolen base. During the 16-game streak, Davis is hitting .292 (19-for-65) with 11 runs, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 8 RBI, 12 walks and 5 stolen bases. It's the 5th-longest active streak in the International League.

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 3.56 (447.2 IP/177 ER). The 3.56 ERA is the best mark across Triple-A Baseball, ahead of Indianapolis' 3.89 as second-best. Nashville's seven shutouts also leads Triple-A Baseball.

Making Moves: RHP Luke Barker, C Alex Jackson and INF Pablo Reyes were all recalled by Milwaukee prior to yesterday's game. Barker made his MLB debut, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings in the Brewers loss to San Diego. RHP Peter Strzelecki was optioned back to Nashville, while LHP Nick Bennett was transferred to Double-A Biloxi.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 20 prospect, right-handed pitcher Alec Bettinger is the No. 22 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 24 prospect.
