Tonight: Coming off a series-opening victory, the Lugnuts play the third game in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, the ninth meeting of 24 between the two Michigan-based High-A clubs this season. The Loons have won five of eight games against the Lugnuts this year, splitting the first two games of the current series, with each contest played in Lansing.

Michigan Baseball Hall of Fame: This evening marks the first of three consecutive Michigan Baseball Hall of Fame inductions, beginning with longtime Greater Lansing baseball coach Javier Cavazos, who founded the Capital Area Youth Association and won seven state baseball championships. Tomorrow will see the induction of the Class of 2020: Drew Henson and the late Bob Miller. Saturday, the final day of inductions, will see the Lugnuts honor the Page Fence Giants, a legendary traveling black baseball team of 1895-1898 based out of Adrian.

On the Air: Tonight's game is on MiLB.TV and via streaming online audio at http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing, with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa on the call of the game.

Last Night: Loons 6, Lugnuts 4. Great Lakes reliever José Martínez tossed six one-hit shutout innings of relief and the Loons held off the Lugnuts late despite a Shane Selman three-run homer in the bottom of the ninth, responding from a loss in the series opener on Tuesday.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

Streaking: Catcher Drew Millas went 0-for-3 with a walk last night, extending his on-base streak to 19 games. The Lugnuts' longest streak this season is 24 games, set by Max Schuemann from May 8-June 6.

Man of Steal: Infielder Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University) leads Minor League Baseball with 27 steals, three more than Augusta's Braulio Vasquez and ten more than the Major League leader, Kansas City's Whit Merrifield. Schuemann is tied for second in the Minors with 12 HBPs and is tied for second in the High-A Central with 32 runs scored and fifth with a .395 on-base percentage.

Double Your Pleasure: The Lugnuts' offense tops the High-A Central with 80 doubles. Nine different hitters have notched at least six doubles.

Midland Update - Wait, Not That Midland: The Great Lakes Loons play home games in Midland, Mich., but we're talking Midland, Tex., where the A's Double-A affiliate plays. Last night, former Lugnut Jake Suddleson homered in the ninth inning for the RockHounds in a 9-6 win at Amarillo, and is now hitting 2-for-19 (.105). Fellow former 2021 Nut Jack Weisenburger has appeared in one game for the RockHounds, tossing two hitless, scoreless innings with one strikeout.

Seeking Health: Not only do the Nuts have three players -- pitchers Charlie Cerny and Jeff Criswell and outfielder Lester Madden, Jr. -- on the Injured List, outfielder Michael Guldberg has not played in a game since May 29th and first baseman Patrick McColl has not had a plate appearance since June 3rd

Hail to Arms: The Lugnuts' pitching staff tops the High-A Central with a 3.53 earned run average with the second fewest walks in the league (117), third fewest home runs (26) and tied for the fourth most strikeouts (388)

Highs and Lows: The Lugnuts have scored at least seven runs in a game 14 times this season, and have also scored two runs or fewer in a game 15 times. The season series against the Great Lakes Loons bears out this divide: In the Nuts' three wins, they have scored 10, 9 and 7 runs. In the Nuts' five losses, they have scored 1, 2, 2, 2 and 4 runs.

Keys to Success: When the Nuts outhit the opposition, they are 14-1 this season. When they get outhit, they are 2-18.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

1997: The Lugnuts hosted the Midwest League All-Star Game, won by the East 6-5 over the West before an All-Star Game league-record crowd of 10,060. The event included a "Stars of Yesterday" old-timers game involving Bob Feller, Fergie Jenkins, Gates Brown, Willie Horton, and Mickey Lolich.
2016: The Lugnuts activated first-base coach / bench coach Alex Maldonado as an infielder on the roster. Maldonado played in three games, going 1-for-8.
2017: The West Michigan Whitecaps set a Midwest League record with 11 doubles and tied a franchise record with 25 hits, demolishing the Lugnuts, 15-8, at Cooley Law School Stadium.

Major League Lugnuts: Two former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, pitcher Ty Tice '18 and outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, with the duo making their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals.

Familiar Settings: 13 of the 30 Lugnuts active players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members Scott Steinmann, Don Schulze and Anthony Phillips all have experience in the league.

A Full Complement of Starters: The Lugnuts have used 11 starting pitchers this year, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Colin Peluse, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

Fly Like an Eagle: Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University.

Finally: Pitchers Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama, and Ryan Gridley, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons; though **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year, Peluse hosted Simoneit on his visit and convinced him to attend Wake.


Personal: The first letter of Richard's last name is pronounced with an "h" sound, as in "hwahsh"... rated Baseball America's No. 35 Oakland prospect, with his slider rated as the best in the organization.

Last Outing: After allowing 1 ER in his first 20 1/3 innings, Richard gave up four runs on nine hits in four innings at West Michigan on June 10, jumping his ERA from 0.44 to 1.85... removed after facing three batters in the 5th and not recording an out; lefty Dalton Sawyer allowed a run on a sacrifice fly but stranded the other two runners... Guasch was charged with the loss as the Lugnuts fell, 10-0.

2021 in the High-A Central:

- Opened the season as the No. 3 starter in the Lugnuts' rotation, working 2 1/3 scoreless innings on May 6th vs. Lake County... struggled with command, working around a one-out walk in the 1st inning with a strikeout of top prospect George Valera... hit a batter and walked a batter in the 2nd inning but stranded runners at the corners... gave up a double and a walk in the 3rd inning, but responded by striking out Valera and cleanup hitter Jonathan Engelmann before he was relieved in favor of Bryce Nightengale, who escaped the jam... departed with the Lugnuts leading, 3-0, only to see bullpen relinquish the lead in a 7-6 loss.
- Relieved Shohei Tomioka in a piggyback assignment on Thursday, May 13th, at Dayton... struck out six Dragons in four innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on four hits and a walk in a no-decision... relieved Tomioka starting the 3rd inning, allowing a home run to Jose Tello, the second batter faced; Victor Ruiz followed with a single, but was erased on a strike 'im out double play... pitched around singles by James Free and Jonathan Willems in a scoreless 4th... whiffed Quincy McAfee and Ruiz in a perfect 5th... in frustrating 6th, walked Quin Cotton on a 3-2 pitch, Cotton stole 2nd and then stole 3rd on a strikeout of James Free, coming home on a throwing error by catcher Jared McDonald, giving Dayton an enormous insurance run, on their way to a 4-2 win over the Lugnuts.
- Pitched brilliantly in a start Thursday, May 20, at Fort Wayne, tossing five scoreless innings while allowing two hits, two walks, and striking out seven... pitched around an Agustin Ruiz single in the 1st inning... allowed a leadoff double to Justin Lopez in the 2nd inning and wild-pitched him to third, then struck out the side to strand him... walked Adam Kerner and Reinaldo llarraza to open the 3rd and wild-pitched them to scoring position, but stranded them there... struck out two in a perfect 4th... struck out his seventh batter in a perfect 5th... Lugnuts went on to win, 12-1.






2019: Received one start with the Vermont Lake Monsters on June 19th, going four innings, allowing no runs, with five strikeouts and one walk, spending the rest of his 2019 season in Beloit, where he pitched in 18 games, 10 starts, and finished the year with a 4.53 ERA, 77 strikeouts / 37 walks, and just one home run allowed.

2018: Made his professional debut in DSL rookie league as a member of the A's starting rotation, pitching in seven games, starting five, with an ERA of 1.16 in 23.1 IP, walking four while striking out 27 in a stunningly impressive campaign.

The Road to MLB: At age 20, signed with the Oakland Athletics as an international free agent on July 13th, 2018... scout: Juan C. De La Cruz, who also signed teammate Rafael Kelly.

Coming Up in Cuban Baseball: First gained notice after reached the national championship game while pitching for Santiago de Cuba's 11- and 12-year-old team... pitched in 2013 at the U15 National Championship, where he went 8-0 with a 2.12 ERA and a team-leading 70 strikeouts... unfortunately, this experience damaged his elbow, preventing him from competing in 2014 at the U18 National Championship... appeared in the 2015 U18 National Championship, recording a 5-1 record with a 1.99 ERA in seven outings... went 8-2 with a 0.62 ERA in the 2016 U18 National Championship... member of Cuba's 2017 Pan-American team... also in 2017, Richard's father died, causing him to make the decision to leave Cuba and seek his fortune pitching professionally in MLB... he lived for three months in Mexico, two months in Guatemala, and then formally moved to the Dominican Republic... originally expected to sign with the Philadelphia Phillies, but after complications emerged, signed instead with Oakland.
