# Inland Empire 66ers (12-22)







RHP Yeferson Vargas (4-2, 3.86 ERA) vs. LHP Sterling Patick (0-1, 6.75 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field for game two of a six-game set, as your first-place Quakes host the Inland Empire 66ers in game two of the six-game series. Tonight is Bark in the Ballpark, presented by Raising Cane's, as four-legged friends are welcome with the purchase of a \$3 Pet Pass. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the eighth of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the second of 12 here at home. Last year, the Quakes went 7-5 here at home against the 66ers, 17-7 overall. Last night's win, coupled with five of six in San Bernardino in late-April give the Quakes a 6-1 mark against the 66ers through seven games.

LAST GAME: It was a record-setting night at LoanMart Field on Tuesday, as the Quakes throttled the Inland Empire 66ers by a final of 25-8. Mairo Martinus had three hits and a game-high five RBIs, while Samuel Munoz paced Rancho's 23-hit attack with a four-hit game, collecting three RBIs along the way. Gio Cueto (1), Martinus (1) and Eduardo Quintero (7) all went deep, helping Rancho to a third straight win overall. Christian Zazueta (3-1) allowed three runs in five innings for the win, while Inland Empire starter Andre Sanchez (0-3) got shelled for ten runs in the loss.

**THE RECORDS FALL:** The Quakes posted some gaudy numbers last night, breaking two franchise records. Their 25 runs breaks the previous record of 24, set in June of 2021 in a 24-5 win over Visalia here at home. Their 13-run eighth inning also set a new record as the most runs in a single inning.

**EVEN MORE WEEKLY AWARDS:** The Cal League Awards just keep coming for Rancho, with Eduardo Quintero getting tabbed as this week's Player of the Week. Quintero, the fourth Quake to win a weekly award this year, hit .375 (9-for-24) last week with three homers, five RBIs and six walks, giving him OBP of .500 for his week in Visalia.

**MORE ROSTER MOVES:** Rancho added a catcher today, as Angel Diaz will join the club. On Monday, OF Mike Sirota was promoted to High-A Great Lakes. Sirota was tops in the league in homers (7), slugging (.687), OPS (1.130) and extra-base hits (17) at the time of his promotion. Last Thursday, the Quakes promoted two of their most valuable arms to High-A Great Lakes. Starting pitcher Sean Paul Linan, who, at the time, led all of Minor League Baseball in strikeouts with 50 over just 29.2 innings, will be making his first trip to High-A. Reliever Alex Makarewich, who did not allowed an earned run over his first 13 innings and has 27 strikeouts is also in High-A for the first time. Shawn Oduber took one of those open roster spots and debuted on Sunday in Visalia. Joendry Vargas, who's been gone from the team for exactly one month with an injury, has been activated from the Injured List.

**STERLING PATICK:** The Quakes will start left-hander Sterling Patick tonight for the third time this year, as he'll make his seventh appearance and second against the 66ers. In his last game, he dominated the Visaila Rawhide over four innings, allowing just two hits while fanning five. In one relief outing against Inland Empire, he allowed six runs on four hits with two walks, while recording just one out in a no-decision on April 26th. Patick was named Cal League Pitcher of the Week two weeks ago for five perfect innings against Stockton. Patick was a 2023 18th-round selection for the Dodgers out of South Hills High School in West Covina.

YEFERSON VARGAS: Right-hander Yeferson Vargas makes his eighth start of the year and his third against the Quakes. In his last outing, he allowed two runs on three hits over 5.1 innings in a win vs Stockton on May 9th. In two games against Rancho, Vargas is 0-1, allowing five runs on eight hits over ten total innings. Vargas originally signed with the Boston Red Sox in June of 2023 out of the Dominican Republic. He was traded from Boston to the Angels in July of 2024 as part of the deal that sent RHP Luis Garcia to the Red Sox.
