July 27: Senators 7, RubberDucks 0: Akron was held to three hits as the Senators beat the RubberDucks 7-0 on Sunday to take the series. Akron finished the road trip 3-6.

Today's starting pitcher: Shane Bieber will make a rehab start for the RubberDucks on Tuesday afternoon. Bieber is making his third start since his rehab was paused for a week in June due to soreness felt in the arm and fourth start overall as he recovers from 2024 Tommy John surgery. The right-hander struck out four and allowed one run over three innings for High-A Lake County on July 22. He was originally supposed to pitch on Sunday for Triple-A Columbus, but that start was rained out. Bieber features a fastball, cutter, slider, changeup and knuckle-curve and enters Tuesday 0-0 with a 1.23 ERA with 14 strikeouts over 7.1 innings in three rehab starts this year.

Stephan in Akron: Trevor Stephan will reportedly continue his rehab assignment in Akron this week. The right-hander recently had his rehab window extended as he works back from Tommy John surgery before the 2024 season. The right-hander pitched in three rehab games for Akron out of the bullpen in June against Harrisburg allowing one run over 3.2 innings while striking out three. In total, Stephan has appeared in 11 rehab games with ACL Guardians, Akron and Columbus allowing 14 runs while striking out 10 over 9.2 innings. Stephan features a fastball, splitter and slider and last pitched in MLB for the Guardians in 2023. He has a career 3.73 ERA, 50 holds, six saves and 232 strikeouts over 180 career games for Cleveland.

Yorman waiting: Yorman Gómez is expected to follow the rehabbing Guardians at some point on Tuesday. The right-hander is coming off a win in his Double-A debut on Wednesday in Harrisburg after allowing one run over five innings while striking out five. He is now 9-0 this season between Akron and Lake County, which is tied for the most wins in the Guardians organization with now teammates **Tommy Mace** and **Trenton Denholm**. Gómez is used to pitching in long relief this season. Out of his 17 appearances with Lake County this season, 11 of them were out of the bullpen. He is 4-0 with a 3.72 ERA, 50 strikeouts to 19 walks in 46.0 innings out of the pen with the Captains.

Coming in clutch: Jorge Burgos and **Joe Lampe** have been two of the best with runners in scoring position this season. Burgos is batting .347 with seven doubles, eight home runs and 60 RBI with RISP while Lampe is batting .304 with seven doubles, two homers and 36 RBI with RISP. With men in scoring position and two outs, Burgos is batting .317 while Lampe's average jumps to .319. With a hot road trip that saw him pick up seven RBI, **Angel Genao** is now batting .359 with runners in scoring position with Akron this season.

Advincula in Akron: Jonah Advincula got off to a slow start to his Double-A career going hitless in his first six games. Since getting his first Double-A hit on July 2, Advincula is batting .310 with three doubles, three RBI, five runs scored and five stolen bases in 13 games.

Genao's big trip: Angel Genao picked up nine hits and seven RBI on the road trip to Altoona and Harrisburg. In the Senators series, Genao hit .348 with three doubles, a triple, a stolen base and five RBI.

Bazzana is back: The 2024 No.1 overall pick **Travis Bazzana** has returned to Akron. The infielder has been on the injured list since May 21 with a right oblique strain that he suffered during the second game of Akron's doubleheader in Chesapeake on May 14. Prior to the injury, Bazzana was starting to heat up for the Akron batting .279/.392/.512 with four doubles, two homers, three RBI and five steals in 12 games in May. He picked up two hits in his return on July 18. Overall since coming off the injured list, Bazzana has gone 8-for-28 with four runs scored, three doubles and two RBI in seven games.

Good eye: The RubberDucks have walked 417 times this season, which is most in the Eastern League and third most in Double-A.

Cooper Ingle (60) leads the RubberDucks and the Eastern League. The RubberDucks have worked eight or more walks in a game 10 times this year including 10 walks against the Baysox on May 17 and Richmond on July 11. 14 Akron batters have worked double digit walks so far this season, and six (Ingle, **Dayan Frias**, **Jorge Burgos**, **Jake Fox**, **Joe Lampe** and **Alex Mooney**) have drawn 30+ walks.

Can't start a fire without a spark: The RubberDucks are outscoring opponents 59-28 in the first inning and 112-71 over the first two innings this season. Akron is 46-12 when scoring first (second most wins in the Eastern League when scoring first). The RubberDucks batters have 150 hits the first time through the order this year. **Cooper Ingle** is batting .287 with five home runs in innings where he leads off this season.

Ranked Top-3 in the Midwest League in winning percentage (first), wins (tied-first), opposing average (second), WHIP (second), strikeouts (tied second) and ERA (third) at the time of his promotion.

2025 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF

#26 Manager Greg DiCenzo enters his fifth season with the Guardians organization. The 2024 season will be DiCenzo's second as RubberDucks manager, and fourth as a manager in the Guardians organization. He guided the RubberDucks to an 80-58 record and an Eastern League playoff appearance in 2024.

Prior to becoming Triple-A Columbus' bench coach in 2023, DiCenzo spent the 2021 and 2022 seasons as the manager in High-A Lake County. He guided the Captains to a 141-108 record in his two seasons including a Midwest League finals appearance in 2022.

A native of Duxbury, MA, DiCenzo was the head baseball coach at Holy Cross for 12 seasons prior to joining the Cleveland organization. The Crusaders went 137-109 in Patriot League play during his tenure, including a 2017 Patriot League Championship, and posted 20-win seasons in 10 of those 12 years.

#55 Hitting Coach Jordan Becker enters his sixth season with the Guardians organization and second with the RubberDucks. In 2023, Becker served as the hitting coach for Lake County.

Becker joined the Cleveland organization in 2019 after a collegiate coaching career that saw stops at Riverside Community College and New Mexico State University.

#29 Hitting Coach Ian Forster enters his sixth season in the Guardians organization and second season in Akron. Forster will also be a hitting coach for RubberDucks and returns to Akron after serving as the RubberDucks assistant hitting coach in 2023. He was the Arizona Complex Guardians hitting coach in 2024.

A graduate of North Olmsted High School, Forster played four years at Baldwin Wallace University in Berea.

#12 Pitching Coach Kevin Erminio enters his sixth season in the Guardians organization and first season with the RubberDucks. Prior to coming to Akron, Erminio was the pitching coach for the Lake County Captains for the 2023 and 2024 seasons.

Erminio joined the Guardians organization after a collegiate coaching career that included stops as a pitching coach in Oxford at Miami University and 13 seasons at Kennesaw State.

#54 Pitching Coach Michael Poole enters his third season in the Guardians organization and second season with the RubberDucks. He will be a pitching coach in 2025 after spending 2024 as Akron's assistant pitching coach. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Poole was the pitching development coach on the Arizona Complex Academy staff.

A native of [Akron](#), Poole played at Cuyahoga Community College and Lake Erie College before starting his coaching career at Inspiration Academy (FL) in 2019. Poole was an assistant coach at LSU-Eunice for the Bengals D2 JUCO World Series Championship season in 2021.

#49 Bench Coach Marc Mumper enters his third season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. He will also serve as the Guardians organization's assistant infield coordinator. Prior to coming to Akron, Mumper spent 2024 as the bench coach for Lake County.

A native of Highlands Ranch, CO, Mumper played 157 games from 2016-19 for Grand Canyon University. He then went on to coach at the college level in several different roles from 2019-22 before joining the Guardians organization.

#41 Development Coach Seth Caddell enters his second season as a coach in the Guardians organization and second season with the RubberDucks. Before joining the RubberDucks coaching staff in 2024, Caddell played in the Guardians organization for three seasons as a catcher.

Athletic Trainer Derrik Diaz enters his eighth season in the Guardians organization and second season with the RubberDucks. He also serves as the Guardians organization's assistant coordinator for Dominican Republic Medical Services. Diaz was the Eastern League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2024. Prior to coming to Akron, Diaz served as the head athletic trainer for the Dominican Republic Complex in 2023.

Assistant Athletic Trainer Karina Gonzalez enters her third season in the Guardians organization and second season in Akron. Prior to coming to Akron, Gonzalez spent the 2023 season at the Guardians complex in Goodyear.

Strength and Conditioning Coach Mo Cuevas enters his 10th season with the Guardians organization and third season in Akron. He was the Eastern League Strength Coach of the Year in 2024. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Cuevas served as the Guardians rehab strength and conditioning coach in 2022.

Baseball Technology Fellow Kade Enders enters his first season in Akron. A native of Medina, Enders previously worked as an intern for USA baseball, video associate for the Los Angeles Dodgers and baseball performance science video intern for the Tampa Bay Rays before joining the Guardians organization.

We Are the RubberDucks

On October 29, 2013, team owner **Ken Babby** and general manager **Jim Pfander** stood before a capacity audience at the Akron Civic Theater and announced that the team would be known henceforth as the **Akron RubberDucks**. In addition to being symbolic of the fun, family-friendly brand of entertainment offered by minor league baseball, the name also honors Akron's long history as the "**Rubber Capital of the World**." Brandiose Marketing of San Diego, California designed the team logo, colors, and various marks and insignias. Please note that for print coverage, *RubberDucks* is spelled as one word with a capital "D." In broadcast coverage, referring to the team as "*the 'Ducks*" is an acceptable variation of the team's nickname.
