FROM THE CROWS NEST

WELCOME TO THE STRETCH RUN: After dropping the two of the week's first three games, Bradenton is off to a 18-21 start in the second half, currently 3.5 games behind the Threshers and tied with Fort Myers for the FSL West's final playoff spot. With 27 games to go, the Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. After taking two of three from the Mighty Mussels last week, they have secured the season-series win which gives them the tie-break advantage if the two teams finish with even records at the end of the season. The Marauders don't have the head-to-head advantage with Clearwater.

PLAN Z: Right hander Zander Mueth will take the ball for the Marauders as they look to even the series with the Flying Tigers. Over nine starts and 19.1 innings of work in Class-A, Mueth has posted a 7.45 ERA this season. In the process, he's punched out 31 hitters but also walked 26. In his last start on Saturday versus Clearwater, he allowed six runs (3 ER) over 1.1 innings. Throughout the year, Mueth has struggled with his command. However, he has done a tremendous job of pitching with traffic as he's limited oppoents to a
.219 average with runners in scoring position. Mueth is currently ranked as the Pirates No. 12 prospect (MLB Pipeline) after a strong 2024 season where he posted a 2.31 ERA over 74 innings between the FCL and Single-A. He was selected by the Pirates in the CB-B Round as the

67th overall pick of the 2023 draft. This season, right-handed hitters have struggled to find the barrel against Mueth, as they're batting just .163 with one extra-base hits against him. He features a sinker (94.1 mph), slider (83.9 mph), and changeup (86.7 mph). Last year Single-A opponents batted just .176 against his heater and .077 versus his slider.

ELECTRIC EDWARD: Bradenton Marauders outfielder Edward Florentino was named Florida State League Player of the Month for his dominant performance in July. He remains the only Marauders player to be honored this season by Minor League Baseball. Over the 23-game stretch, Florentino slashed ´.301/.433/.663 with 16 stolen bases and 17 walks. His eight home runs and 23 RBÍ were the most of any player throughout the Florida State League and Single-A. Florentino was also one of three Single-A players, and the only in the FSL, to tally 15 or more walks and ten or more extra-base hits. Florentino is the Pirates No. 6 ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline and was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on June 21

TONY TATORS: Pirates No. 21 prospect (MLB Pipeline) Tony Blanco Jr. demolished his first two Single-A homers last week. On Wednesday night, he sent a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A this season, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. Only five batted balls at the Major-League level have been hit harder this season. He joins Oneil Cruz (3) and Vladamir Guerrero Jr. (2) on the list. Only him and Cruz (122.9 mph) have left the yard with such batted ball quality. He also demolished a walk-off three-run homer on Saturday that left the bat at 119.8 mph - the hardest-batted ball in Mil.B this season. He was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter. Blanco began the season on the injured list and just completed a two-game rehab assignment with the FCL Pirates where he went 1-for-6 with a home run. In 30 FCL games last year, Blanco Jr. batted .305 and slugged .505 with four homers. His father Tony Blanco played 62 big-league games for the Washington Nationals in 2005 and spent eight seasons in the Nippon Professional Baseball League in Japan.

MARAUDERS MASHERS: The Bradenton Marauders return from the All-Star Break as one of the best home-run hitting teams in all of Class-A. Their 84 longballs this season are the most in the Florida State League and second in Class-A (San Jose - California League, 89). 131 of their 472 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.7%). They're 31-24 when leaving the yard at least once, and 17-29 when not homering at all. They've seen four players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin,

BURNING THE BASE PATHS: Yordany De Los Santos stole his 41st and 42nd stolen bases last night, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-Ain 2024). In the process, he's passed **Jesus Castillo** (39 - 2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. He ranks first in the Florida State League and seventh in Single-A. Moreover, he sits only behind **Konnor Griffin** (50) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40 + stolen-base seasons in Pirates-Milb history. The two are approaching **Rich** Thompson for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer when he stole 58 in 2005 between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis.

Right hander **Zander Mueth** will take the ball for the Marauders as they look to even the series with the Flying Tigers. Over nine starts and 19.1 innings of work in Class-A, Mueth has posted a 7.45 ERA this season. In the process, he's punched out 31 hitters but also walked 26. In his last start on Saturday versus Clearwater, he allowed six runs (3 ER) over 1.1 innings. Throughout the year, Mueth has struggled with his command. However, he has done a tremendous job of pitching with traffic as he's limited oppoents to a .219 average with runners in scoring position. Mueth is currently ranked as the Pirates No. 12 prospect (MLB Pipeline) after a strong 2024 season where he posted a 2.31 ERA over 74 innings between the FCL and Single-A. He was selected by the Pirates in the CB-B Round as the 67th overall pick of the 2023 draft. This season, right-handed hitters have struggled to find the barrel against Mueth, as they're batting just .163 with one extra-base hits against him. He features a **sinker (94.1 mph), slider (83.9 mph), and changeup (86.7 mph)**. Last year Single-A opponents batted just .176 against his heater and .077 versus his slider.
