THE NEW NUMBER ONE

With the graduation of Pittsburgh Pirates rookie SS KONNOR GRIFFIN on Wednesday, *Baseball America* and *MLB Pipeline* have named SS JESÚS MADE as the top overall prospect in baseball... Made joins OF JACKSON CHOURIO ('23) as the highest-ranked prospect in Shuckers franchise history, and is the second top overall prospect in Milwaukee Brewers franchise history.

➤ Made, who enters today as the youngest player at the Double-A level, holds a .255/.339/.400 slash line with 12 extra-base hits, 21 RBI and 16 stolen bases this season... Made is among the Southern League leaders in triples (T-2nd, 3), hits (4th, 37) and stolen bases (T-5th, 16).

ALL BUNCHED UP

Entering today, the Shuckers are a game back of 1st place in the South Division, despite sitting in 4th place with the 2nd-best run differential in the division... It marks the first time in the Southern League since 2005 that the top 4 teams in a division are separated by a game or less on May 16.

➤ The closest division race in the Southern League since 2005 came in 2015 and 2018 with the South Division in the 2nd Half, which saw 3 teams separated by a single game.

DeBERRY IS DEALING

RHP JARON DeBERRY set a career-high on Tuesday with a 10-strikeout performance against the Biscuits... It marked the first 10+ strikeout performance of his career and beat his previous high of 9, set on August 23, 2025, against Chattanooga.

➤ DeBerry is the first Shuckers pitcher to record 10+ strikeouts in a start since Alexander Cornielle, on April 15, 2025, at Birmingham... It marks the 7th by a Shuckers pitcher since the start of the 2024 season.

➤ DeBerry is the first Shuckers pitcher to go 6.0+ innings, strike out 10+ and allow 1 run or less since RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI on July 12, 2024, at Chattanooga.

20/20 VISION

1B BLAKE BURKE enters today with 11 home runs and 27 RBI through 36 games... Burke is the fastest player to 10+ home runs (31g) and 20+ RBI (24g) in franchise history...

➤ Burke is on pace for 21 home runs and 23 stolen bases in the first half... It would mark the 3rd 20/20 season in Shuckers franchise history, and the first since OF JACKSON CHOURIO (2023).

➤ Burke is looking to become the first player in Minor League Baseball with a 20/20 half since OF TERRY EVANS, who achieved the feat between High-A Palm Beach and Double-A Springfield in 2006.

HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

The Shuckers enter today with a home run in 10 consecutive games, the 2nd-longest streak in the Southern League this season and tied for the 4th-longest streak in franchise history... The Shuckers have hit 16 home runs during the streak, including 3 grand slams.

MARK'S GRANDEST MOMENT

OF MARK COLEY II recorded his 1st home run in the Brewers organization on Friday night, an 11th inning go-ahead grand slam... It marked his 1st home run since September 7, 2025, with Triple-A Jacksonville, and the 2nd grand slam of his professional career.

➤ The grand slam marked the 1st by a Shucker in extra-innings since July 31, 2022, when OF ANDRUW MONASTERIO hit a walk-off grand slam against Montgomery.

SHAKEN' BAKE

C DARRIEN MILLER and C MATTHEW WOOD have combined for 11 home runs, a .419 on-base percentage, a .905 OPS and more walks (42) than strikeouts (37) this season.

➤ The pair are 1 of 3 catching groups in Double-A this season with an OPS above .900 and rank 6th among all catching groups by OPS in Minor League Baseball.

WELCOME BACK, EBJ!

INF/OF ERIC BROWN JR. recorded his 2nd multi-hit game of the season (2-for-4) on Wednesday in his return to the lineup for the first time since April 17, 2026... Dating back to April 14, Brown has recorded a hit in 4 straight games and is 5-for-15 over that span.

SPEED? I AM SPEED

1B BLAKE BURKE enters today with 12 stolen bases, the most by a first baseman in Double-A... The Southern League record (since 2005) for a first baseman is 24, set by 1B JOEY VOTTO in 2006 with the Chattanooga Lookouts.

BACK IN THE SADDLE

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO is in his 8th season as Shuckers manager and 10th as manager of a Brewers Double-A affiliate... Guerrero needs 38 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,462 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP BISHOP LETSON (0-3, 6.75) makes his 8th start of the season and his 1st career start against the Biscuits... Letson has 14 strikeouts over his last 3 starts and 13.0 innings.
