YESTERDAY: The Great Lakes Loons shut out the Captains, 5-0. Great Lakes hit three solo homers, all against Captains starter Xzavion Curry. James Outman and Andy Pages hit leadoff homers in the fourth and fifth. Joe Vranesh added a solo shot in the seventh. The Loons' other runs came on RBI doubles by Zac Ching in the fifth and Pages in the ninth. Four Loons pitchers combine to hold the Captains scoreless. Lefty starter Alec Gamboa worked the first five and earned the win, Melvin Jimenez pitched one inning, Franklin De La Paz pitched two and Cameron Gibbens finished the game in the ninth.

VALERA GOES DEEP: George Valera has hit five home runs in his last 10 games. He has gone deep in every other game he has played since last Friday.

ROCCHIO ON A ROLL: Since July 4, Brayan Rocchio has hit .339/.413/.482 (.895 OPS).

SUPER NOVA: Victor Nova has hit .381/.471/.786 (1.256 OPS) in July with four home runs in 13 games. Over the first two months of the season, he hit .179/.295/.241 (.536 OPS) with one home run in 37 games.

LEADERBOARD: Captains OF Will Brennan and INF José Tena are neck-and-neck on the High-A Central League leaderboards. Brennan is fourth in the league in batting average (.299) and tied for first in doubles (21). Tena is eighth in batting average (.288) and sixth in doubles (16).

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 19-7 at home, compared to 18-24 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.10 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.83 ERA on the road.

HOT LAVA: Bryan Lavastida is riding a 20-game on-base streak. Over the last 20 games (since June 24), Lavastida is hitting .408/.477/.728 (1.195 OPS) with four homers and 10 doubles. Lavastida has eight multi-hit games during that span, including four three-hit performances.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP Justin Garza became the 102nd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on May 11, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

**2021:** Assigned to Triple-A Columbus on May 23 and made four appearances out of the Clippers' bullpen, posting an 8.31 ERA. Transferred to Double-A Akron on June 11. Made three starts and four relief appearances for the RubberDucks, posting a 6.43 ERA. Transferred to Lake County on July 21.

**COLLEGE OF IDAHO HISTORY:** Draper was drafted in the same year as his College of Idaho teammate, Riley O'Brien, a right-handed pitcher who the Tampa Bay Rays selected in the eighth round in 2017. It was the first time two C of I Yotes were drafted in the same year since 1996, when the Montreal Expos selected Kurt Alderman in the 15th round and the St. Louis Cardinals picked Tim Onofrei in the 28th round.

**COLLEGE ACCOLADES:** Draper earned All-NAIA West honors in both of his seasons at the College of Idaho (2016 & 2017).

WEST COAST LEAGUE: Draper was named the WCL Pitcher of the Year in 2016 after posting an 8-0 record with a 0.72 ERA. He did not allow an earned run in July, tossing 35 shutout innings.

**COLLEGE TRANSFER:** Transferred to the College of Idaho after two seasons at the College of Southern Idaho. He was initially signed to play at the University of Central Florida.

COLLEGE TEAMMATE LINEAGE: Draper's college teammate, Tampa Bay Rays pitching prospect Riley O'Brien, is the grandson of former Pittsburgh Pirates infielder Johnny O'Brien. Johnny and his twin brother Eddie O'Brien played together on the Pirates in the 1950's and even formed the Bucs' double play combo (one of four pairs of brothers to play together up the middle in MLB history) in their rookie season of 1953 (Eddie at shortstop and Johnny at second). Johnny was mostly a second baseman during his six-year career, but also pitched 25 times, including 16 appearances (one start) in 1957. Eddie also pitched five times (one start) during his career with Pittsburgh, though he was primarily a shortstop and centerfielder. In addition, the pair played basketball at Seattle University where they upset the Harlem Globetrotters and were both drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, though neither signed. In basketball, Johnny earned the distinction as the first player in NCAA history to score 1,000 points in a season and was the shortest player to be named an All-American (5'9") until
