### RIDERS TAKE FIVE OF SIX, DOWN HOOKS IN FINALE 5-3:

The Frisco RoughRiders bested the Corpus Christi Hooks by a score of 5-3 on Sunday evening from Whataburger Field. **Josh Stephan** shined on the mound for the RoughRiders (17-10) tossing 5.0 innings of scoreless ball, allowing just six hits and no walks while striking out a season-high seven Hooks (8-19) batters. Making his Double-A debut, Jake Bloss did not allow a base-runner until the top of the fourth inning when **Josh Hatcher** singled. He lasted 6.0 innings without allowing a run, surrendering only two hits and sitting down six Riders via the strikeout. Corpus Christi threatened in the top of sixth against notching a pair of singles and a walk before **Anthony Ho'opi'i-Tuionetoa** blew a fastball by Rolando Espinosa in a 3-2 count to strand the bases loaded. The RoughRiders started the scoring in the top of the eighth inning against Michael Knorr (0-2) on a throwing error that plated **Maximo Acosta**. Frisco scored a total of five runs in the inning, highlighted by a two-run single from **Kellen Strahm**. **Cody Freeman** added an RBI single in the frame. Trailing 5-0 in the bottom of the eighth inning, Ryan Wroblewski worked a lead off walk against **Reid Birlingmair** (1-1) and later came in to score. Chad Stevens drove in two more runs with a double, cutting the Riders lead to 5-3. In the bottom of the ninth, **Seth Clark** struck out the first batter he faced but allowed a base hit and issued a walk that brought the winning run to the plate. Second baseman **Frainyer Chavez** ended the game, snaring a line drive out of the air to secure the win and help Clark earned his first save of the season. Offensively, the RoughRiders managed just four hits, but produced five runs in the series finale.

### MISSION ACCOMPLISHED:

The RoughRiders face their division opponents for the first time this season, but the Riders have had plenty of head-to-head success against the Missions over the years. In 2023, Frisco went 13-11 against San Antonio and have gone 41-25 against them since they rejoined the Texas League in 2021. **Evan Carter** was amazing against San Antonio last year, blasting six home runs and hitting .380/.505/.684/1.189 across 21 games. Of returners, **Aaron Zavala** led the way with 15 hits across 16 games, batting .288/.435/.285/.820.

### POWER SURGE:

The RoughRiders have had more home run power recently as the calendar has moved along. Over their last 12 games, they have hit 13 home runs, which is tied for second in the Texas League. During that same span, the RoughRiders are last in the Texas League with just nine doubles, leading to a .368 SLG over their last 12 games, which is sixth in the league. For contrast, the Riders hit just six home runs in their first 15 games.

### FIRING BLANKS:

After the RoughRiders' shutout win on Saturday, Frisco is second in the league with three shutouts on the mound this season. Over the last 11 games, the Riders are first in the Texas League with a 2.55 ERA. In the six games of the series against the Hooks, all but one starter went at least five innings.

### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Part of the RoughRiders' dominance on the mound has been the Frisco bullpen. In the six games against the Hooks, the bullpen has allowed just four runs over 21.2 innings (1.66 ERA). On the season, the bullpen is fifth in the Texas League with a 3.87 ERA.

### I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

**Cody Freeman** had a monster game last Thursday against Amarillo, going 5-for-5 with two home runs and a double. It was the first five-hit game in Freeman's Minor League career and the first one for the Riders since **Blaine Crim** accomplished the feat on September 2nd, 2022 at Amarillo. Over his last 14 games, he is batting .321 (17-for-53)/.357/.585/.942 with two doubles, four home runs, eight RBIs and seven runs scored. In his last 11 games, he has batted .349/.364/.674/1.038 with all four of his homers.

### THE HATCHER HAMMER:

In an incredible win last Saturday, **Josh Hatcher** hammered a three-run, walk-off home run for a 4-3 win over Amarillo. Hatcher's capper was his third home run in as many games and he has driven in a whopping 16 runs over his 19 games while slashing .342/.392/.534/.926. Hatcher is fifth in the league in batting average (.342), eighth in slugging percentage (.534) and eighth in OPS (.926).

### DOUBLE A-RON IN DOUBLE-A:

**Aaron Zavala** reached in his first 18 games of the season, slashing .279/.438/.393/.831 with four doubles, a home run and nine RBIs. Over his last three games in May, he has gone 5-for-13 with a 1.198 OPS and 5 RBIs. He has both walked and struck out a lot this season, placing ninth in the Texas League in walk rate (17.0%) and eighth in strikeout rate (33.0%).

### ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

### 2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Threw 5.2 scoreless at CC on 4/30. Over four starts at Whataburger Field, Garcia has allowed just three runs over 20.2 IP (1.31 ERA).

### 2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

### 2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

### 2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

### 2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
