On May 18, 2017, the Sounds thumped the Fresno Grizzlies 13-3 and tallied 19 hits. Franklin Barreto went 3-for-6 with a double, triple, and home run and drove in five runs.

Six Shooter: The Sounds have won every series they have played this year. It's the first time since at least 1987 the team has won its first six series in a season (team records date back to 1988).

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 2.96 (316.0 IP/104 ER) after last night's win. The 2.96 ERA is the best mark across Triple-A Baseball, far ahead of Iowa with a 3.46 ERA.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.

LAST OUTING: Small made his last start on May 12 in a start at Jacksonville and earned his third win of the season. The southpaw struck out a season-high nine batters in 5.0 innings. He allowed one run on four hits and three walks. Small threw 52 of his 85 pitches for strikes as the Sounds improved to 6-1 in games he starts.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Small is facing Louisville for the third time in his career. The first was a start at First Horizon Park on June 30, 2021 and the tossed six shutout innings (6.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 4 K). He faced the Bats a second time last year and went three innings in a start (3.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 5 K).
