Inland Empire 66ers (17-41)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue a six-game road trip with the second game of a six-game series against the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on June 17th, when they host the Lake Elsinore Storm as part of the final home stand of the first half. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the 14th of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the eighth of 12 here at San Manuel Stadium. The Quakes have taken five of six in both series so far against the 66ers, but after last night's loss, have a 10-3 mark against the 66ers. Last year, the Quakes went 10-2 here at San Manuel Stadium, 17-7 overall.

LAST GAME: The 66ers capitalized on three Rancho errors, taking the lead for good with two in the sixth, as they defeated the Quakes by a final of 7-5 on Tuesday night at San Manuel Stadium. Dario Laverde's two-run double plated a pair of unearned runs against Jhonny Jimenez (1-1) for the game-winner. 66ers' reliever Sadiel Baro (3-1) was credited with the win, while closer Bridger Holmes notched his sixth save with a scoreless ninth. Rancho's Jaron Elkins had three hits, two walks and three stolen bases, while Eduardo Quintero had two hits, two walks and four stolen bases to lead the Rancho attack. The win for Inland Empire ends their own six-game skid, while sending Rancho to an eighth straight loss, their 14th loss in the last 19 games. The losing streak is the longest of their Low-A tenure and the longest since they lost ten straight back in 2014.

ROSTER MOVES: On Tuesday, the Quakes added 2024 17th-round pick Jackson Nicklaus, an infielder from Oklahoma University. Over the weekend, the Quakes activated INF Niko Perez from the IL, transferred Raynerd Ortega to the Arizona Complex League and placed INF Joendry Vargas on the Injured List for the second time this year.

WRONG SIDE OF HISTORY: San Jose's win over the Quakes on Sunday marked just the second six-game sweep the Quakes have endured in franchise history. Since the league went to six-game series in 2021, the Quakes had only been swept on one occasion, a first-half six-game series on the road last season at Lake Elsinore. The Quakes entered that 2024 May series with a five-game lead in the South Division and exited Lake Elsinore trailing by a game. They never recovered, as the Storm won the 2024 First Half.

HOW TO WRAP IT UP: Tuesday's loss, an eighth straight for Rancho, means there are only eight games left to play in the first half, with the Quakes having just a three-game lead over Visalia and a six-game lead over Lake Elsinore to start the day. Rancho's magic number is five against the Rawhide and three against the Storm. After this six-game set with Inland Empire, the Quakes will finish the half at home with three against Lake Elsinore. This week, the Visalia Rawhide travel to Lake Elsinore for six. In the north, San Jose's lead over Modesto now stands at just one game.

LOGAN TABELING: 23-year-old right-hander Logan Tabeling makes his 13th overall appearance this year and fourth start, his third outing and first start against Inland Empire. In two games against the 66ers, he's worked 4.1 innings, allowing two runs on seven hits, with eight strikeouts and no walks. In his last outing overall, he allowed two runs on five hits over 3.2 innings in a no-decision against San Jose on June 6th. The undrafted free agent out of Illinois signed with the Dodgers in July of 2024.

BRANDON DUFAULT: 26-year-old right-hander Brandon Dufault makes his second start for the 66ers and first against the Quakes. In his only other outing for Inland Empire, he allowed one run on one hit with one strikeout in a no-decision at Visalia on June 6th. Dufault is making his way back from an injury that cost him part of 2023 and all of 2024. Dufault was a 16th-round selection by the Angels in the 2021 draft out of Northeastern.
