Captain's Log

LAST SERIES: The Lake County Captains took game three over the Great Lakes Loons 6-5, to punch their ticket to the Midwest League Championship Series. After dropping game one at home, Lake County took both games two and three in Midland, Michigan. Game two saw a combined shutout from pitchers Tommy Mace, Alaska Abney and Raymond Burgos. In game three, the Captains power came to play. Alexfri Planez launched a three-run homer in the first, while Yordys Valdes sliced two doubles including a two-run two bagger in the fourth. The Loons down a run would not score in the final three innings against Trey Benton and Jordan Jones.

TALE OF THE TAPE: The South Bend Cubs and Lake County Captains will play a three-game series to decide a Midwest League Champion. Both teams won the second half title in their division. The Captains and Cubs finished top five in the Midwest League in pitching strikeouts, opponents' batting average and saves. On offense, both Lake County and South Bend were top five in batting average and slugging percentage. In a six-game series played between the two in the final week of July at Four Winds Field, both teams won three games.

S STAT SO?: This year will be the third time in franchise history the Captains will play in the Midwest League Championship Series. Lake County won it all in 2010, their first year in the league, defeating the Clinton LumberKings three games to two.

NO DOG DAYS IN AUGUST: In the month of August, the Lake County Captains were outstanding going 20-6. Lake County had 15 wins at home combined in the month of May, June, and July. They matched that number in August going 15-3, at Classic Park. It was the first month with 20 wins for the Captains since August 2014, where they went 20-10.

STREAK OF THE SUMMER: The Lake County Captains won nine games in a row from August 5th to August 14th, the second longest winning streak in Captains history. The unbeaten streak started included three consecutive wins over the Great Lakes Loons and a six-game sweep of the Fort Wayne TinCaps, all at Classic Park. The longest winning streak in Lake County history is 13 games, which was achieved from May 27 to June 8, 2003, a season where the Captains won a franchise best 97 games.

PLANEZ'S PLACE IN CAPTAINS HISTORY: Alexfri Planez this season strung together a 22-game hit streak. It stands as the longest streak in the Midwest League this season. The 20-year-old was just two hits away from the longest hitting streak in Lake County history. Francisco Mejia, now a Tampa Bay Ray had a hit in 24 consecutive games with the Captains in 2016. Over the stretch, Planez had a .333/.340/.667 slash line with eight home runs, 23 runs batted in and 32 hits. Planez only walked once during the streak. The streak began on June 14th and ended July 14th

2021 DRAFT: Five starting pitchers for the Captains' were all selected in the 2021 draft. Tommy Mace was taken in the second round, 69th overall via a competitive balance pick, the right-hander has 75 strikeouts in 85 innings pitched. Aaron Davenport, was the sixth round and 186th overall pick in the 2021 draft, his 13 home runs allowed is the lowest among qualifying Captains starters. Cleveland selected Jack Leftwich with the 216th overall pick in the seventh round. Leftwich has allowed just 16 runs over 46 innings with Lake County. Rodney Boone was an eighthround selection, pick number 246, and has made 13 starts including a complete game shutout against the Lansing Lugnuts on July 2nd. Will Dion, Cleveland's ninth round pick pitched 12.1 innings in the regular season and allowed only one run.

LAST TIME OUT: Rodney Boone made his first relief pro ball appearance in game one of the Midwest League Eastern Division Championship Series and shut down the Loons in four straight innings. The left hander kept the Captains in the game in the middle innings.

ON THE HILL AS A HILLCAT: Boone began the 2022 season with the Lynchburg Hillcats, the Low-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. Over 10 games started he permitted only 10 earned runs, striking out 63 batters and walking only eight. The San Francisco native posted a 1.85 ERA and 0.92 WHIP.

NEAR-PERFECT: On May 11, 2022, Rodney Boone carried a perfect game against the Down East Wood Ducks into the sixth inning. Although a single broke it up, Boone completed six innings, after strikeout number eight and a flyout.

LIFE AS A GAUCHO: Over three seasons at the University of California at Santa Barbara, Boone started 34 games reaching 199.2 innings pitched and allowing 56 runs. In 2021, Boone was the Co-Big West Pitcher of the Year and the most hits he gave up in a start was seven. Current Guardians Pitcher Shane Bieber also played his college ball at UCSB.

SCOUTING THE SOUTHPAW: Cleveland Director of Amateur Scouting Scott Barnsby says Boone's off-speed stuff has an "advanced feel, deception."

HANG-15: As a teenager Boone bodysurfed. His favorite memory is surfing a 15-foot wave. He stopped surfing once he committed to UCSB because of the dangerous nature of the sport.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND: 11 former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut with the Cleveland Guardians in the 2022 season.

Cody Morris: Friday September 2nd, Cody Morris made his MLB debut earning a start against the Seattle Mariners at Progressive Field. The right-hander went two innings allowing two earned runs. Morris spent three seasons in the Cleveland minor league ranks, including 2019 with Lake County where he pitched 45 innings allowing just 16 runs over nine starts.

Xzavion Curry: The Atlanta, GA native made his first start against the Detroit Tigers in the second game of a doubleheader on August 15th. Curry went five innings permitting only three runs. The right-hander was a Captain in 2021, and started 13 games posting a 2.66 ERA.

Hunter Gaddis: The right-hander made his Major League Debut on August 5th, getting the start against the Houston Astros at Progressive Field. Despite a scoreless first, Gaddis would allow eight runs on seven hits in 3.1 innings. Gaddis quickly worked through the minor league ranks and was a Captains just last season where he had a 4.16 ERA in 20 games pitched.

Tyler Freeman: On August 3rd, Tyler Freeman made his MLB debut, getting the start at third base and went 1-3 with a walk against the Arizona Diamondbacks. The 23-year-old played 61 games with Lake County in 2019, going .292/.382/.424 and starting 57 games at short before being called up.

Will Benson: Benson in his major league debut came across the plate as the winning run in a 6-5 11-inning triumph for the Guardians over the D-Backs on August 1st. The 2016 Draft's 14th overall pick played in Lake County in 2018 and 2019 and is remembered for hitting four home runs, the most in a game by any Captain, on April 18, 2019 against the South Bend Cubs at Classic Park.

Nolan Jones: The 2016 second round pick, played his first game in the show, on July 8th against the Kansas City Royals. In his first major-league at bat, Jones smacked a RBI double down the right field line. Jones was a Captain in 2018, playing 90 games, compiling 90 hits including 16 longballs.

Oscar Gonzalez: The 24-year-old made his MLB debut on May 26th against the Detroit Tigers going 2 for 4, with a single and double. Gonzalez played 114 games in the 2018 season in Lake County, posting 135 hits, 13 Home Runs and 25 doubles.

Richie Palacios: The Brooklyn born Palacios earned two singles in his first two major league at-bats on April 25th against the Angels. Palacios earned had both his mother and father in attendance. Palacios played 20 games with Lake County in 2018 and had 24 hits.

Kirk McCarty: McCarty took the hill for the first time as a Guardian on Sunday, April 24th at Yankee Stadium. He appeared in the sixth inning, going three innings, surrendering four runs but adding three strikeouts. He made 22 starts in the 2018 season as a Captain, accumulating a 4.29 ERA through 115.1 innings.

Tanner Tully: The left-hander from Elkhart, Indiana, made his MLB debut on April 22nd entering in the fifth inning against the Yankees. He went two innings allowing two hits, and one run over 38 pitches. Tully was a Captain in 2017, where he 16 appearances, eight starts and posted a 3.16 ERA over 77 innings.

Bryan Lavastida: Lavastida caught all nine innings for the Guardians in their 17-3 win over the Kansas City Royals on April 10th. He earned his first big league hit April 22nd at Yankee Stadium. Lavastida was a Captain in 2021 playing in 48 games where he batted .303/.399/.467.
