History vs. South Bend

The Lugnuts are 214-193 all-time vs. the Cubs, 103-90 at home and 111-103 in South Bend.

This is Lansing's first trip to South Bend since 2023, when the Nuts won three of five. On September 4, 2022, the Lugnuts threw a combined no-hitter in the road season finale vs. the Cubs.

Today is the finale of a six-game season series between the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and the South Bend Cubs, High-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. The Cubs won the first four games of the series before the Lugnuts struck back yesterday.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 8, Cubs 5. South Bend southpaw Cole Reynolds had tossed three perfect innings on Tuesday, but was treated to a far different outcome, knocked out of the game after failing to record an out five batters into the second inning. Casey Yamauchi and Rodney Green, Jr., each singled, doubled, and tripled, and Tzu-Chen Sha allowed three runs in six innings in the winning cause.

LUG-NOTES

Milestone Watch: Lansing is four wins from the 2,000th victory in Nuts history and three players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Roll Call: Today's starter, **Nathan Dettmer**, is the eighth Lugnuts starter this year, 19th different Lansing pitcher, and 34th different player used this year.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster boasts five players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarría**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 26 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 30 (**Bobby Boser**).

That's Quality: **Tzu-Chen Sha's** quality start yesterday (6 IP, 3 R) was Lansing's third quality start of the year (joining back-to-back quality starts from **Jackson Finley** and **Steven Echavarría** from April 21-22 at Quad Cities); Sha's fourth career quality start; and his first quality start since June 18, 2025, in the California League.

Lightning Bolte: 2024 Lugnuts outfielder **Henry Bolte** went 5-for-5 for a second straight night for Triple-A Las Vegas, collected one single, two doubles and two homers. Bolte has now hit safely in his last 12 at-bats and is batting .632 (24-for-38), five doubles, one triple and five home runs in his last eight games. Bolte, the A's No. 5 prospect and the only Athletics outfield prospect ranked higher than **Devin Taylor**, is batting .351/.419/.669 with seven doubles, three triples, 12 homers, and 16-for-18 steals this season.

Triple Time: The Nuts came into yesterday's game with one triple in 31 games... and then **Rodney Green, Jr.** and **Casey Yamauchi** each tripled in the win. Don't expect South Bend to be impressed; the Cubs have four triples in five games in the series.

Pitcher's Best Friend: Lansing has turned eight double plays in the series, increasing the club's league-leading total to 41.

Lugnuts on the Leaderboard:

- **Davis Diaz** is tied for 1st in doubles (11) and tied for 9th in extra-base hits (14).
- **Devin Taylor** is tied for 3rd in base hits (35), 4th in runs batted in (23) and tied for 6th in walks (27).
- **Bobby Boser** is tied for 3rd in base hits (35) and tied for 9th in total bases (56).
- **Zane Taylor** is 4th in ERA (2.00), 6th in batting average against (.204) and 9th in WHIP (1.22).

Thou Shalt Not: Catcher **Davis Diaz** has nabbed eight of 14 attempted base-stealers, the highest total in Minor League Baseball for a catcher who has caught more runners than have been successful against him.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

Major League Nut: The 201st Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, 2023 Lugnuts catcher **Daniel Susac**, opened his career batting .478 (11-for-23) with the Giants before landing on the Injured List on April 21. The 202nd Lugnut to reach the Majors was 2024 southpaw **Eduardo Rivera**, who was called up for emergency relief purposes and tossed 3 1/3 scoreless innings against the Yankees on April 22.

MAY 10 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: After Josh Almonte was called out at the plate to end the top of the 7th at Bowling Green, Lugnuts manager John Schneider was ejected by home plate umpire Jose Matamoros. Schneider took his time leaving, walking across the field to the clubhouse, located beyond the left-center field wall... and then discovered that the outfield gate was locked. He was locked in. At last, the Bowling Green bullpen in left field allowed Schneider to use their exit, and the game was able to resume. David Rodriguez homered in the bottom of the 9th to force extra innings, and Zacrey Law's RBI single in the bottom of the 11th off Josh DeGraaf lifted the Hot Rods to a 4-3 win.

2019: Henry Bolte forced extra innings with a two-out RBI double in the ninth, Carlos Amaya broke the tie with a sacrifice fly in the eleventh, and Great Lakes pinch-runner Jake Vogel made a costly mistake to end a Lugnuts 7-6 win at Dow Diamond. Vogel entered the game pinch-running for Luis Rodriguez as the placed runner in the bottom of the eleventh inning. With two outs, he attempted to steal third, arriving in safely ahead of a one-hop throw... but then lost sight of the ball and walked off the bag, allowing third baseman Dereck Salom to tag him out to end the game.
