JACKSONVILLE BLANKS CHARLOTTE

Max Meyer, Austin Kitchen and Elvis Alvarado combined to shut out Charlotte in an 8-0 Jacksonville win on Tuesday. The Jumbo Shrimp jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the second on Marty Costes' two-run home run. The score remained that way until the sixth, when Jonathan Davis laced an RBI double and Troy Johnston notched a two-run single to make it 5-0. Johnston crushed a three-run home run in the eighth inning to truly put the game out of reach. Jacksonville surrendered only four hits in the effort.

SHUT OUT AND DRIVE

Jacksonville compiled just two shutouts in 75 games of the season's first half of the season, the second-fewest in the International League. Thanks to Tuesday's 8-0 blanking of the Charlotte Knights, the Jumbo Shrimp have now earned three shutouts in eight second-half games. The last time Jacksonville collected three blankings in this small of a span was in seven games from July 12-22, 2022, when the Jumbo Shrimp earned a pair of 4-0 victories at Syracuse and a 9-0 triumph over Charlotte.

RATMFN

Heading into play on June 16, Jacksonville had mustered only 304 runs in 68 games (4.5 per game), which ranked last out of 30 Triple-A teams. The Jumbo Shrimp also placed just 20th in batting average (.254), 25th in OBP (.337), 24th in slugging (.409) and 24th in OPS (.746) in the first 68 games of the season. Jacksonville has registered at least nine hits in 10 of their last 15 games, sparking an offensive resurgence from the club. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp rank tied for second in Triple-A in hits (155), third in batting average (.299), ninth in OBP (.368), 10th in OPS (.829) and 12th in SLG (.461) while scoring 79 runs (5.3 per game).

GET PITCH OR DIF TRYIN'

Jacksonville has gone 14-9 in their last 23 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 16 of those 23 affairs. Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in runs allowed (82) and ERA (3.19) while ranking second in WHIP (1.33), third in OPS against (.714), fourth in batting average against (.243) and fifth in fewest hits allowed (188).

QUIT PLAYING GAMES WITH MY START

Somewhat incredibly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 20 of the last 22 games, with 16 of those starts resulting in two earned runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and nine being scoreless. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 35 runs, 30 earned, on 84 hits (8.7 H/9) in 87.1 innings for a 3.09 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 84 strikeouts (8.7 K/9) against 39 walks (4.0 BB/9) during this stretch.

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A. Javier Sanoia was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 45 of his last 50 games, notching 20 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 68for-198 (.343/.412/.500/.912) at the plate with 16 doubles. three triples, three home runs, 34 RBIs, 25 walks and 26

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine has been stellar since early May. Over his last 48 games, the Duke product is 52for-167, slashing .311/.387/.605/.992 with 11 doubles, one triple, 12 home runs, 33 RBIs, 21 walks and 31 runs scored. Among the 117 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks 14th in HR/FB (25.4 percent). On the season, he ranks tied for ninth in the IL in extra-base hits (32), tied for 13th in homers (15), 19th in SLG (.521), 22nd in OPS (.884), tied for 22nd in doubles (16) and tied for 21st in hits (71).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville relievers have worked more innings (368.2, 15th-most in Triple-A) than their starters (366.1, ninth-most in Triple-A). However the club's starting pitching ERA of 4.35 ranks leads all Triple-A rotations. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has collected a 4.32 ERA, which places seventh... Over his last 34 games, Troy Johnston is hitting .359/.417/.563/.980 with seven doubles, two triples, five home runs, 20 RBIs, 11 walks and 27 runs scored... Jacksonville is just 1-4-3 in their home series this season. Their only home set win came when they took four of six from Norfolk from April 16-21.

DEDEDTAIDE

-A fifth-round pick by Miami in 2019, Fitterer had committed to UCLA prior to signing with the Marlins. He signed for 1.5 million to sway him from what was considered a strong college commitment.

-The Marlins selected Fitterer out of Aliso Niguel High School in Aliso Viejo, California - the same alma mater as Miami manager Skip Schumaker

-Fitterer pitched to an extreme ground ball rate of 58% in 2023, 55% in 2022, and 66% in

-His favorite movie is Shrek 2 and his favorite baseball player growing up was Zack Greinke.

-In past stops in the minor leagues, Fitterer has worn number 17 as a nod to Master Chief John-117 in the video game Halo.

-Fitterer is an avid guitarist and helped teach 2022 Beloit roommate and fellow Marlins prospect Dax Fulton to play.

2024 SEASON

-Transferred to Jacksonville on June 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, Fitterer was tied for third in the Southern League in wins (5), 13th in batting average against (.260), 14th in ERA (4.02), 16th in innings pitched (65.0), tied for 16th in strikeouts (57) and 21st in WHIP (1.45).

-At the time of his promotion, among the 140 Southern League pitchers who had logged at least 10.0 innings, Fitterer had posted the third-highest ground ball rate at 59.8 percent. His GB/FB rate of 2.97 was the fourth-highest in the circuit.

-Out of 1,106 pitches, Fitterer threw strikes 61.0 percent of the time. His 675 total strikes ranked 14th in the Southern League out of htose 140 pitchers.

-Fitterer worked 20.1 consecutive scoreless innings from April 19 through May 10. It was the ninth-longest scoreless streak in Blue Wahoos history.

2023 SEASON

-In 10 starts with Double-A Pensacola during the first half of the season, Fitterer went 4-1 with a 3.38 ERA (48.0 IP, 38 H, 20 R, 18 ER, 31 BB, 55 K, .218 BAA). However, over the campaign's second-half, he was 3-6 with a 5.34 ERA in 13 starts (59.0 IP, 57 H, 40 R, 35 ER, 41 $\,$ BB, 45 K, .251 BAA).

 $\hbox{-With Pensacola, } Fitterer\ posted\ opposite\ platoon\ splits.\ Right-handed\ hitters\ batted$.279/.387/.474/.861 against him in 197 plate appearances. Left-handed batters slashed .199/.351/.322/.673 against him in 217 plate appearances.
