Today marks game #9 of the 2021 season, the fourth game of a six-game homestand, and the fourth of a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 19 times during the 2019 regular season, with the Whitecaps going 8-11. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 27th season in professional baseball, and their first in the High-A Central League. Great Lakes is in their 12th year of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers. The last playoff meeting with Great Lakes came in the 2018 Midwest League Eastern Division Quarterfinals, with the Whitecaps sweeping a two-game series. Today marks the 2021 home opener, and first game at the newly-named LMCU Ballpark.

Up Next: The 'Caps take a six-game roadtrip to visit the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers from May 18-23 at Fox Cities Stadium before returning home to LMCU Ballpark for a six-game series against the Lake County Captains.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The West Michigan Whitecaps struggled to find offense as the Great Lakes Loons pitching staff shined in downing the Whitecaps 4-1 Thursday night in front of a 2,000-fan sellout crowd at LMCU Ballpark. The Whitecaps had runners in scoring position in seven out of nine innings tonight but were only able to push one run across as the Tigers 2019 third-round pick Andre Lipcius, smoked a solo home run in the defeat. Great Lakes jumped all over the 'Caps early, plating three runs through the first inning – highlighted by a two-run double by Ryan Ward to take an early 3-0 advantage. The Whitecaps threatened to score in both the bottom of the first and second frames, advancing men to second and third base in back-to-back innings but were unable to get on the scoreboard as the Loons notched another tally in the third to extend their lead to 4-0. Despite the poor offensive performance, the Whitecaps bullpen shined as Sandel De La Cruz, Sam Kessler, and Chavez Fernandez tossed six innings of shutout baseball with six strikeouts. Meanwhile, the Whitecaps offense advanced men into scoring position in each of the last five innings but were able to add only one lone run – the Lipcius solo fly – as the Loons escaped with a 4-1 victory. Great Lakes reliever Austin Drury (1-0) picked up his first win of the 2021 campaign allowing no runs on three hits and six strikeouts through 3.2 innings of work. Whitecaps starter Chance Kirby (0-1) allowed four runs (one earned) on five hits and just one strikeout in his first defeat this season. The Loons improve to 3-6 while the Whitecaps fall to 3-5. Lipcius, who only homered twice in 2019, notched his second on the season while increasing his batting average to a staggering .385 with a .452 on-base percentage in leading the offense with a 3-for-4 performance. The loss marks the Whitecaps' 100th loss against the Great Lakes Loons in franchise history. After Thursday's defeat, West Michigan now owns a career record of 122-100 in regular season matchups, along with a 2-1 series advantage in the postseason against the Los Angeles Dodgers affiliate.

'TORK' HEADLINES 'CAPS ROSTER: For the first time in Whitecaps history, the franchise features the first overall pick in the Major League Baseball Draft. Infielder Spencer Torkelson, the Detroit Tigers top prospect, headlines the Whitecaps 2021 roster. Torkelson also rates as the #3 prospect in Major League Baseball behind only Tampa Bay's Wander Franco, and 2019 first overall pick Adley Rutschman of the Baltimore Orioles. The highest previous draft slot of a former 'Caps player belonged to 2nd overall pick Ben Grieve of the Oakland Athletics who played the 1995 season in West Michigan. The highest Tigers draftee came in the form of 3rd overall pick Eric Munson in 1999.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: Torkelson headlines a team featuring seven of the Tigers Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. In addition, four of the six Tigers selections in the abbreviated 2020 MLB Draft are now Whitecaps, including catcher Dillon Dingler, outfielder Danny Cabrera, and infielder Trei Cruz of the third round.

GRAND CENTRAL STATION: During the 20-month MiLB offseason, the Midwest League and all other neighboring leagues were essentially dissolved as Major League Baseball took over control of the Minors. The Whitecaps, who won six Midwest League championships in 26 seasons now play in the Eastern Division of the High-A Central League along with Dayton, Fort Wayne, Lake County, Great Lakes and an unknown team in Lansing.

HEALTH REPORT: The 'Caps injured list holds two players at this time in pitcher Hugh Smith and infielder Trei Cruz.

ALUMNI REPORT: 2017 Whitecaps pitcher Greg Soto picked up his fourth save of the season as the Detroit Tigers beat the Kansas City Royals 4-2 on Thursday night at Comerica Park. This season, Soto is 3-1 with a 2.87 ERA in 15.2 innings with 18 strikeouts. Soto went 10-1 with a 2.25 ERA in 18 games with the 'Caps in 2017.

Name: Beau Brieske**Born:** April 5, 1998**Resides:** Chandler, AZ**Acquired:** Selected by the Tigers in the 27th Round of the June 2019 MLB Draft from Colorado State University - Pueblo.

Brieske entered the Tigers system as a bit of a project after posting a mid-5s ERA during his college days, but has been developed into an effective bullpen arm since joining the Tigers organization. Detroit will now try him back in the starters role in which he struggled back in college, but is perhaps more equipped to be back in the rotation again.

LAST START: Brieske had a tough adjustment to High-A life as he marked the shortest start by any Whitecaps starting pitcher to date, lasting just two-thirds of an inning while giving up five runs as the Whitecaps lost 10-3 to the Fort Wayne TinCaps on Thursday at Parkview Field.

2019: Brieske's first professional season saw him placed in the bullpen, where he thrived by going 3-1 with a 3.10 ERA in 11 appearances.

COLLEGE: Brieske pitched 79.2 innings as a starter for CSUP and posted a 5.42 ERA in 14 starts, but showed flashes of talent with a total of 116 strikeouts during that span to just 27 walks.

Also spent time playing for Glendale Community College as a two-way player, where he hit .295 with a .429 OBP as a sophomore.

- Batted .350 at the plate and posted a 2.10 ERA for the Perry Pumas at Perry HS.

- Son of Bob and Casey Brieske. Younger brother of Cylee and Baylee. Father Bob played baseball at Eastern Oregon. Majoring in communications. Hobbies include being outdoors, paintball and reading.
