THE OFFENSE GOES OFF: The Delmarva Shorebirds authored their best offensive performance of the season on Friday night against the Fred Nats as they exploded for 16 runs on 17 hits. **Jackson Holliday** led the way with the first multi-homer game of his career with a three-run home run in the fifth followed by a solo bomb in the ninth. **Anthony Serviceo** connected for his first home run of the season as part of a seven-run fifth. **Stiven Acevedo** came through with one of his best games of the season as he brought home three runs with a pair of doubles as the Shorebirds went on to dominate the Nationals 16-4.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Delmarva will look to earn a series victory against the Fred Nats as they send **Wyatt Cheney** to the bump for his second start of the season as he faces **Brad Lord** who makes his third appearance and second start of 2023. Lord was the 18th round selection by the Nationals in the 2022 out of South Florida.

BASALLO ON FIRE: Samuel Basallo has on a roll during his first month of action in Single-A as the 18 year old is tied for the Carolina League lead in RBIs with 16 as he has now driven in a run in five consecutive games after bringing in a pair with a double on Friday. Basallo is tied with **Jackson Holliday** for the most hits on the team with 19, both are just one hit behind **Tim Elko** (KAN) for the most hits in the league.

CAREER NIGHT FOR JACKSON: Jackson Holliday delivered another signature performance on Friday night as the No. 1 overall pick homered twice in a game for the first time in his professional career. He also drove in four runs for the third time this season and has done in once in each of the first three series of the year. Holliday has 14 RBIs for the season, good for third most in the Carolina League behind fellow teammate **Samuel Basallo** and **Tim Elko** (KAN) who each have 16.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE: Douglas Hodo came through late for the Shorebirds in Wednesday's win over Fredericksburg by driving in a total of three runs in his final two hits in the seventh and eighth inning in the 7-4 win over the Fred Nats. Hodo has reached base in all eight games he's played in, drawing a walk in each of the first six as he obtains an on-base percentage of .516 currently with his 3 RBIs on Wednesday a young career-high for the 2022 6th round pick.

THE BATS ARE HOT: The offense for Shorebirds has been on an absolute tear to start 2023 as they lead the Carolina League in most offensive categories. Delmarva's 106 runs are most in league, 22 more than the next closest team (Lynchburg). They also are tops in the league in hits (133), Doubles (28), Home runs (12), batting average (.287), slugging percentage (.430), and OPS (.826).

HALT THE WALKS: The Delmarva pitching staff has been haunted by walks in the first ten games of the season as they have allowed 92 free passes after yielding a season-high 15 on Tuesday night versus Fredericksburg. Tuesday was Delmarva's fourth game this year with ten or more walks but are now 3-1 in those games.

ACEVEDO'S TURN AROUND: **Stiven Acevedo** has been off to a terrific start in his first full-season in Single-A as he's batting .362 through his first 11 games of the year with multiple hits in seven of those starts, including a two double performance on Friday against the Fred Nats with a new career-high of 3 RBIs in the game.

PAYBACK TIME: Delmarva looks to reverse their fate from 2022 against the Fred Nats as their North Division rival had the upper hand in 2022 by going 7-17 versus the Nationals. Virginia Credit Union Stadium was especially not kind to the Shorebirds as they went 1-11 in games at Fredericksburg including losses in their first 9 contests there.

TODAY'S STARTER: Wyatt Cheney takes the mound for his second start and third appearance of the year on Saturday as the Shorebirds look to earn a series victory in Fredericksburg.

LAST OUTING (4/16 vs KAN): Cheney last appeared in relief on Sunday against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers and took the loss in a narrow, 5-4 defeat. Cheney allowed a home run in his first at-bat of the outing as Troy Claunch took him deep, the decisive run of the game came home on him in the seventh on an RBI single by Logan Glass. He struck out a young, career-high three batters last time out.

vs. FREDERICKSBURG: Tonight will be the first time Cheney will face the Fred Nats.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: The right-hander appeared in just two games for the Shorebirds after being drafted out of McClennan Community College in Texas. His first outing was a full inning against the Pirates in the FCL where he dealt a full inning with two strikeouts as he retired the side in order. He faced just two batters in his only Delmarva appearance where he faced two batters, allowing a hit and a walk. Appeared in 16 games at McClennan in 2022, making 15 starts where he struck out 122 in 81.2 innings to earn a 10-3 record and an ERA of 3.20. Struck out 11 batters or more in three starts including a career-high 13 versus Hill College on March 19.

MANAGER



Returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.


