Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play a doubleheader at the Lake County Captains – the 256th and 257th all-time meetings between Lansing and Lake County and the tenth and eleventh meetings of the 2025 regular season. The Nuts and Caps split a six-game series in Lansing at the end of April and start of May. Lansing is coming off winning five of six games at home against South Bend.

Last Night: Captains 8, Lugnuts 4. Alfonsin Rosario homered twice to offset solo home runs from Ryan Lasko, Cole Conn and Tommy White, and the Captains defeated the Lugnuts for a third straight game to open the series.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and Captains wrap things up tomorrow, then the Nuts return to Michigan's state capital to open a six-game series with the Beloit Sky Carp.

Prospecting: The Nuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 7 prospect (Tommy White), No. 10 (Joshua Kuroda-Grauer), No. 12 (Steven Echavarria), No. 17 (Ryan Lasko), No. 18 (Rodney Green, Jr.) and No. 28 (Nate Nankil).

Welcome to The Show: Center fielder Denzel Clarke made his Major League debut last night for the Athletics, becoming the third Nut to make his MLB debut this season, alongside Max Muncy and Gunnar Hoglund, and the 196th all-time Lugnut to go from Lansing to the Majors.

Roll Call: When pitcher **Nathan Dettmer** debuted last night, he became the 965th Lugnut in franchise history (as well as the eighth to start a game this season, the 19th different pitcher and the 34th different player used this season).

Promotion: Infielder **Sahid Valenzuela** was called up to Triple-A Las Vegas yesterday, going 0-for-4 with two strikeouts in the Aviators' 5-4 loss in Sugar Land in his Triple-A debut. Valenzuela joined **Colby Thomas, Max Muncy, Daniel Susac** and **Cooper Bowman** in the starting lineup, each of whom he had played alongside in Lansing the last three years.

Atop the League: First baseman T.J. Schofield-Sam (.341) leads Lake County infielder Christian Knapczyk (.336) for the Midwest League batting title. Both players went hitless yesterday, ending Schofield-Sam's 14-game on-base streak and Knapczyk's 13-game hitting streak.

Tommy Tanks: Third baseman **Tommy White** went 2-for-3 yesterday with a walk, a double and his fourth home run of the season, continuing his mastery of Lake County pitching even with a golden sombrero in the series opener. White is batting .409/.517/.773 with 17 total bases vs. the Captains in seven games: 9-for-22, 2 doubles, 2 homers, 5 walks and even 1 stolen base.

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank second in the Midwest League in batting average (.261), second in base hits (361), second in doubles (83), second in on-base percentage (.358), third in total bases (535) and are the toughest team to strike out (284).

In the Field: The Nuts are the best defensive group in the league, posting a .981 fielding percentage with only 28 errors committed in 1,473 chances. The Lugnuts also rank third in the league in fewest stolen bases allowed (33 in 47 attempts).

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is first in the league in holds (19), first in complete games (2), first in fewest HBPs (14), first in fewest balks (3), tied for first in fewest walks (148) and fifth in saves (11).

DK at the Helm: The 19th manager in Lugnuts history is **Darryl Kennedy**, entering his second year in the A's organization. Kennedy distinguished himself as a catcher at Manatee Community College before starring at the University of North Florida and was named an NCAA All-American in 1991 en route to North Florida's Hall of Fame, inducted in 2017. Kennedy played in the Minor Leagues for seven seasons, including parts of four seasons in Triple-A. Following his 1997 retirement, he immediately began managing, leading the Gulf Coast League Rangers to the 1998 GCL Championship. Kennedy won a second title with the GCL Rangers in 2000, moving on to stops in the Florida State League, Northwest League and Texas League through 2006.

History vs. Lake County

The Nuts are 124-131 all-time vs. the Caps, 69-63 in Lansing and 55-68 in Ohio. The Captains won the 2024 MWL championship, but the Nuts went 12-6 vs. the Captains last year, 4-2 at home. 12-6 on the road.

2009: An hour and 46 minutes?! The Lugnuts' Henderson Alvarez (7 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 4 K) and the Cedar Rapids Kernels' Will Smith (8 IP, 5 H, 6 K) breezed right through a 1-0 Kernels victory in Cedar Rapids. The game featured zero walks and a combined seven runners left on base.

2017: With time running out due to intensifying rainstorms that progressed from an early mist in the early innings to a steady drizzle in the middle innings to utterly pouring by the end, the Lugnuts rallied for two runs in the bottom of the seventh to beat Lake County (who were furious that the game wasn't called sooner), 5-4. Broadcaster Jesse Goldberg-Strassler called the game from The Outfield apartment complex and was thoroughly drenched. Justin Maese set a career high with 12 strikeouts in seven innings, his league-leading third complete game of the year (6 IP, 7 IP, 9 IP).

Dominating in Cuba: Yunior pitched three seasons for Avispas ("Wasps") de Santiago de Cuba in the Cuban National Series, from 2018-2021... in 2019-20, at age 19, posted remarkable line: 0.00 ERA, 9 saves, 22 scoreless innings, 8 hits, 16 walks (two intentional) and 24 strikeouts... teammate: Oscar Colás, now with the White Sox... followed up in 2020-21: 2.11 ERA, league-leading 14 saves, 38 1/3 IP, 32 hits, 10 runs (9 earned), 25 walks, 45 strikeouts.

2023 - Joining the A's: Signed with the Athletics for \$100,000 three days before the end of the international signing period on May 8, 2023... made his pro debut with the Arizona Complex A's on June 5, allowing two runs (one earned) in four innings with no walks and four strikeouts against D-Backs Black... moved up to Stockton on June 17 and finished the season with 19 appearances out of the Ports' pen.

2024 - Back to Stockton: Pitched in relief for the Ports on Opening Day, April 5, and pitched a scoreless sixth before allowing three runs in the seventh inning, suffering the loss in a 7-2 defeat to Modesto... worked as a piggybacker throughout the year, alternating starts and relief appearances... tossed career-high five innings on four different occasions, allowing one run or fewer each time; these gems happened once a month - April 18, May 23, June 15, July 31... struck out seven Lake Elsinore Storm batters in three hitless innings, August 6, setting pro high... vs. lefties: .285/.356/.468, 6 HR... vs. righties: .255/.339/.418... base-stealers went 14-for-16 in successful attempts.
