NEWS & NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: CHIEFS 2, SKY CARP 0

Nate Dohm, Victor Santos and Ty Van Dyke combined to allow just two hits in last night's shutout over the Sky Carp at ABC Supply Stadium...Dohm worked three shutout frames to open the contest, striking out four...After a scoreless fourth inning from Santos, Van Dyke took over and propelled Peoria the rest of the way...In five innings, Van Dyke didn't allow a hit and struck out five, working around three walks...The Chiefs mustered two runs against Beloit starter Joey Volini, who took the loss despite striking out 11 across five innings...Peoria opened a 1-0 lead in the second, as Sammy Hernandez drove in Luis Pino on a sacrifice fly...In the fifth, Jack Gurevitch blooped an RBI single, scoring Jose Cordoba and making it 2-0 Chiefs...

GOOSE EGG

The Chiefs pitching staff dealt its fifth shutout of the season on Thursday night, limiting Beloit to just two hits - the third time this season Peoria has held its opponent to two hits or fewer. The shutout is the Chiefs second in the last four games and second this season against Beloit (June 6). The Chiefs are one of just two teams remaining in High-A (Winston-Salem) that have not been shutout this season, while their five shutout wins are tied for the second most in the MWL.

TURNAROUND ON THE MOUND

After surrendering 36 runs in the first four games of the series with Dayton, Chiefs pitching has allowed just four earned runs in the last four games. Starting pitching has led the way, as **Jacob Odle** (6 IP, 0 R), **Blake Aita** (5.2 IP, 1 R), **Yhoiker Fajardo** (5 IP, 1 R) and **Nate Dohm** (3 IP, 0 R) have combined for 19.2 innings of two run ball in those four contests. Peoria has posted a 4.87 ERA in June after pitching to a 6.19 mark in May.

SITUATIONAL SLUMP

The Chiefs have been held under five runs in 12 of their last 15 games. Since June 9, Peoria is batting .216 and just .174 with runners in scoring position. More notably, the Chiefs are hitting only .189 since last week's series against Dayton began and are just 12-79 (.152) with RISP, with no home runs, 37 strikeouts, and five walks in those spots. Through 3 games this week, the Chiefs are 7-40 (.175) with RISP.

POWER OUTAGE

The Chiefs have been held without a home run in three straight games for the first time this season to open this week's series in Beloit. However, Chiefs pitching has also held Beloit without a longball. In the last series between the two teams at ABC Supply Stadium (May 12-17), the Chiefs and Sky Carp combined for 25 home runs in six games.

DIGGING THE LONGBALL

- Peoria's 106 home runs lead the Midwest League and rank second in High-A (Greensboro, 127). The Chiefs are tied for 7th in MiLB in home runs.
- This season marks the first time the team has reached 100 home runs since they hit 111 in 120 games in the shortened 2021 season. Since 2005, the Chiefs have had just five 100 home run seasons.
- The Chiefs are on pace to break the franchise record for home runs of 122, set in 2002 (when **Yadier Molina** hit 7).

EXTRA, EXTRA!

Peoria's 251 extra base hits lead High-A and are tied for 11th in Minor League Baseball. At their current pace, the Chiefs are on track to surpass the High-A era Midwest League record of 419 extra base hits, set by the Great Lakes Loons in 2021. Of Peoria's 251 XBH this season, 106 have been home runs (42%). The Chiefs have had just one extra base hit in each of the last two games.

TRENDING CHIEFS

- In 17 games in June, **Jalin Flores** is batting .303 (20-66) with 4 HRs, 13 RBIs and a .968 OPS.
- **José Suárez** is batting .308 with an .849 OPS through 17 games this month.
- Since 6/3, **Cade McGee** has connected for 6 home runs. However, McGee has just 9 total hits this month (9-59, .153).
- In his last 5 games, **Josh Kross** is 2-17.
- Across his last 10 games, **Sammy Hernandez** is hitting .483. The backstop has posted a 1.541 OPS with 9 walks and just 6 strikeouts in those 10 games.

Baseball America - Cardinals No. 4 Prospect: "Franklin is a physical righthander who delivers the ball from a three-quarters arm slot with a slight crossfire finish. Entering his junior campaign, Franklin added 3 mph to his four-seam fastball and improved his spin efficiency, which resulted in more ride, arm-side run and a more deceptive plane of approach to the plate. Franklin's fastball is now a double-plus pitch... Franklin's command is fringe-average and will need to improve for him to make the jump to a starting role."
MLB Pipeline - Cardinals No. 10 Prospect: "The 6-foot-5 right-hander showed a 94-98 mph four-seamer in Knoxville that got some of the best overall and in-zone whiff rates among all Division I heaters. The pitch can touch 102 but is especially untouchable because of its tremendous ride..."

STARTING TO START: After making just four collegiate starts in three seasons, Franklin's Opening Day start marked his fourth in the pros in less than a year.

COLLEGE DAYS: Made just four collegiate starts... Spent one season with Vols, pitching out of the bullpen, posting 4.89 ERA in 38.2 innings... Spent first two seasons of college career at Kennesaw State... Pitched 38.1 total innings in two seasons with the Owls, striking out 61 while walking 40...
FAMILY TIES: Dad, Jim, was drafted by Rangers in 11th round in 1993...

COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO ESPINOZA

MANAGER

Roberto Espinoza, 37, returns to Peoria for his second season guiding the Chiefs and his 13th season coaching with the Cardinals organization. He is the lone returner from the team's 2025 coaching staff. Espinoza's career in baseball began as a catcher, as the Cardinals signed the Palo Aragua, Venezuela as an international free agent in 2006. Espinoza played five Minor League seasons, including parts of three seasons with the Quad Cities River Bandits. Espinoza began his coaching career in 2013 as the hitting coach for the Appalachian League's Johnson City Cardinals. The former backstop is no stranger to the big leagues, having served as a bullpen catcher for St. Louis in 2014 and as a coach during the stretch run of the 2020 season. Espinoza managed Johnson City from 2017 through 2019, winning the Appy League Championship in his final season. He spent the next four seasons (2021-24) managing the FCL Cardinals.
