FRISCO DROPS SERIES OPENER TO NATURALS 12-4:

In game one of their six-game series across state lines, the Frisco RoughRiders fell 12-4 to the Northwest Arkansas Naturals Tuesday night at Arvest Ballpark. Northwest Arkansas (22-30, 51-68) plated two in the first inning against **Ben Anderson** (2-6), but Frisco (25-27, 64-56) brought two across to tie the game 2-2 in the fourth on an **Ian Moller** RBI single. Augusto Mendieta (5-7) entered to slow down the rally. After that, though, the Naturals scored nine runs between the fourth and sixth innings against Anderson and the Frisco bullpen, highlighted by a Daniel Vazquez three-run home run. Frisco kept the offense alive with single runs in both the seventh and eighth innings, but could not overcome the wide deficit in the 12-4 defeat.

GET RICH OR DIE DREILING:

RoughRiders outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** has been amazing recently. The No. 13 prospect is 2nd in the Texas League in batting average (.314), 4th in OPS (.915), 5th in RBIs (77), 2nd in hits (129), 4th in total bases (218) and 5th in runs (79). Over his last 36 games, he is batting .389 (58-for-149)/.439/.691/1.130 with 13 doubles, 10 home runs and 31 RBIs. His 21 homers are the most by a RoughRider since **Blaine Crim** in 2022 (24 home runs), the most by a centerfielder in franchise history and the most by a primary outfielder since **Mike Bianucci** hit 30 in 2011. His .530 slugging percentage is the highest by a primary outfielder in franchise history (min. 200 AB). On a 17-game hitting streak, he is batting .437 (31-for-71)/.481/.732/1.213 with 6 doubles, 5 home runs, 18 RBIs and 15 runs scored. The streak is the longest in the Texas League this year and matches the longest by a RoughRider since 2012 (**Alejandro Osuna** with a 17-game streak in 2025). **Jurickson Profar** had a 29-game hitting streak in 2012, the franchise record.

OUCH, THAT'S A LOT OF DAMAGE:

The Riders have lost 6 of their last 7 games. Riders opponents are averaging 8.3 runs per game on 8.0 hits while clubbing 11 home runs and stealing 21 bases. Riders starters during the last 7 games have a 9.38 ERA (25ER/24.0IP) while averaging just 3.1 innings per start.

'PEN USING ALL THE INK:

The RoughRiders have used their bullpen a lot in August. Frisco bullpen arms have thrown a Double-A-leading 108.1 innings in August (T-13th-most in MiLB) while owning the Texas League's 8th-best ERA (5.07) in the month. Frisco starters in the month have a league-worst 6.90 ERA.

THIS SHOWING IS IN IMAX:

On August 12th, **Max Wagner** crushed a walk-off grand slam against former Rangers World Series hero Jose Leclerc. It was the second walk-off grand slam for the RoughRiders in franchise history and first since **Abimelec Ortiz** hammered one against Corpus Christi on May 14th, 2025. Wagner has been hitting homers at a furious pace in 2026, setting his career high with 14 on August 11th (now 18 total). He reached 13 homers in 58 fewer games than 2023. His 15 home runs from the 8 and 9 spots in the order are the most in all of Minor League Baseball. Over his last 44 games, he is hitting .250 (37-for-148)/.323/.574/.897 with 14 home runs, 35 RBIs and 24 runs. Since June 20th, in those 44 games, he is 4th in the Texas League with 14 home runs.

TO THE WINDOW, TO THE WALCOTT:

Rangers No. 1 prospect **Sebastian Walcott** returned to the lineup following the All-Star Break after undergoing internal brace surgery on his right elbow in February. In 2025, as a 19-year-old, the No. 10 prospect in baseball hit .255/.355/.386/.741 with 13 home runs, 59 RBIs and 32 stolen bases. He became the 1st Texas League teenager to have double-digit homers, 30+ SB since **Roberto Alomar** in 1987 with Wichita. In his first 23 games this year, he hit .275 (25-for-91)/.359/.484/.843 with 10 doubles, 3 home runs, 10 RBIs, 12 walks, 5 stolen bases and 24 runs scored. After doubling 19 times in 124 games last year, he has 10 this year in 23 games, putting him on pace for 54 in 124 games. On August 2nd, he was placed on the 7-Day Injured List after being hit in the head with a pickoff throw at first base and returned on August 12th.

CRAZY EIGHTHS:

The Riders have been the best run-scoring offense in the 7th inning or later in Double-A (254 runs) and the best run-scoring team in the league in the 8th inning (103 runs). In the 2nd half of the season, the Riders are 1st in Double-A with 62 runs scored in the eighth inning. Frisco's 6-run comeback win on August 14th matched their biggest comeback win of the year (5/26 vs. ARK). In the 2nd half, **Max Wagner** has the most home runs in the 8th inning (6) and **Dylan Dreiling** and **Rafe Perich** lead the league in hits in the 8th (10). Since July 1st, the Riders have 7 go-ahead, game-winning hits in the 8th inning.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 120 games the RoughRiders are 1st in Double-A with 1,099 hits. They are 1st in Double-A in batting average (.269) and 2nd in runs (716, 6.0 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. The Riders are 3rd in the Texas League in homers (160), 1st in doubles (230), 1st in SLG (.450) and 2nd in OPS (.805).

RIDERS ARE POSTSEASON BOUND:

The Riders clinched a playoff spot with a win on June 18th, capturing the Texas League South Division 1st Half. The Riders have now made the playoffs 11 times, their first berth since 2024, with two championships in 2004 and 2022. The Riders have now won the first half 9 times, their first since 2024. Frisco finished the first half 39-29 (.567).

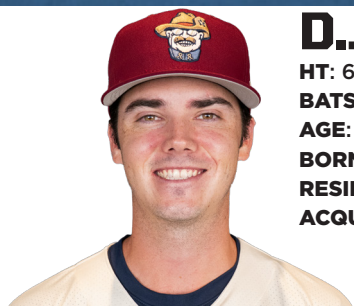

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

JASON HART

Years with RoughRiders: 9

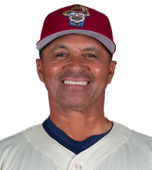
Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

BENCH COACH

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).
