AFC Richmond: Somerset welcomes the Richmond Flying Squirrels to TD Bank Ballpark this week for the first meetings between the two sides. Richmond stands in fifth place in the Southwest Division despite sporting a 21-18 record, but are currently riding a season-high four-game losing streak. They feature two top-15 prospects in the San Francisco Giants organization: No. 3 Heliot Ramos and No. 11 Sean Hjelle.

LUUUUKE: New York Yankees first baseman Luke Voit began a rehab assignment with Somerset Tuesday night. It marked the second rehab assignment in franchise history (Zack Britton). In two games, he has gone 1-for-7 and played 16 innings in the field at first base. Voit hit .277 with the Yanks in 2020, led all of Major League Baseball in home runs (22) and ranked second in the American League in RBI (52).

Donny Baseball: After finishing the previous series in an 0-for-16 stretch, Donny Sands has erupted in the current set against Richmond. The Patriots' catcher went 3-for-4 with two home runs - his second multi-homer game of the year - and three RBI Tuesday night. He then hit a walk-off two-run shot Wednesday night and hit a three-run home run in his next at-bat Thursday night. Sands is 5-for-12 (.417) with four home runs, five runs and 10 RBI over the first three games of this series.

¡Olé Oswaldo!: Oswaldo Cabrera is in the midst of a nine-game hit streak, second-longest of any Patriot this season. Over the streak, Cabrera is hitting .378 (14-for-37) with three home runs, five RBI and eight runs. The Venezuelan infielder went 3-for-4 with his first multi-home run game as a Patriot last night (second of career, 8/24/19 vs. Lakeland) and is 5-for-13 (.385) with six runs across three games against Richmond.

Go Diego Go!: Infielder Diego Castillo has been red hot in the month of June. In 13 games, Castillo is hitting .421 (24-for-57) with five home runs, six doubles, 13 RBI, 13 runs, and a .450 OBP. Additionally, Castillo has recorded three hits in each of the first three games of this series. The Venezuelan is 9-for-13 (.692) from the plate in the series with one home run, six runs, and seven RBI. Castillo now ranks second in the Double-A Northeast League in batting (.361), slugging (.629), and OPS (1.035).

Starting with a Bang: The Patriots have hit 16 home runs in the first inning this season: the most in all of Minor League Baseball and nine more than any other team in the Double-A Northeast League. Additionally, Somerset is collectively hitting .309 in the first inning - tops in all of Double-A - and is outscoring their opponents 42-15 in the first frame.

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff owns a 3.04 ERA, lowest among all Double-A teams and second-lowest in all of Minor League Baseball . The team has also struck out the most batters (472), 38 more than the next-closest team (Corpus Christi), leads in WHIP (1.14) and has the lowest batting average against (.199) amongst all Double-A teams.
