NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: Binghamton split Saturday's doubleheader with Erie, winning the first game 9-2 and dropping the second 7-6 in extra innings (8 innings). Jeremiah Jackson drove in five runs across the two games and Brandon McIlwain went 4-for-7 with three runs batted in across the two games. The series is tied 2-2 and Binghamton will win the series with a win on Sunday.

DOUBLE DIP: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies split Saturday's doubleheader at Erie. Binghamton had tons of success in doubleheaders last season, having never been swept in seven twin bills. The Ponies swept three doubleheaders and split four of them last year.

JACKSON HITS JACKS: INF/OF **Jeremiah Jackson** picked up his first hit of the season in the second game of the doubleheader on Saturday. Later in the game, Jackson clubbed his first home run of the 2024 campaign. Jackson hit 22 home runs in Double-A last season, with two organizations, and hit seven in 37 games with Binghamton last year. He drove in a career-high-tying four runs in the second game of the twin bill.

BIG BMAC: OF **Brandon McIlwain** had a terrific doubleheader on Saturday. Across the two games, he went 4-for-7 with three runs batted in and two multi-hit games. In the first game, McIlwain hit a three-run triple and scored on an error on the same play, resulting in a little league inside-the-park grand slam. McIlwain is currently riding a three-game hitting streak and is 6-for-11, hitting .545 in that span with three runs batted in, a double, a triple, a walk, and just two strikeouts.

PARADA POWER: Mets No. 1 catching prospect **Kevin Parada** hit his first home run of the season in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. Parada slugged 14 home runs across three levels in his first full professional season in 2023, including three with Binghamton over 14 games.

JOSÉ...JOSÉ, JOSÉ JOSÉ: Corner infield prospect **José Peroza** clubbed his second home run of the season in the first game of Saturday's twin bill. Peroza also homered on Opening Night on April 5 against New Hampshire. He got off to a hot start last year too, hitting 10 home runs over his first 58 games for Binghamton. Peroza was a MiLB.com Mets Organization All-Star last year. The 23-year-old has played both third base and first base for the Ponies in 2024.

GUTS GLORY RAM: Mets No. 16 prospect **Alex Ramírez** is off to a hot start to his Double-A career. The 21-year-old is hitting .320 over his first seven Double-A games. Ramírez has two multi-hit games, three extra base hits, including a homer, two walks, four RBIs, and five stolen bases in seven games.

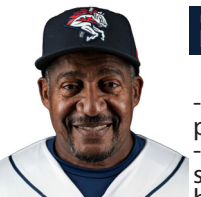

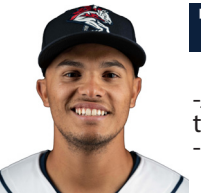
