LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn could not secure a series victory on Saturday night, falling to Jersey Shore 7-2. Despite the loss, LF **Karell Paz** extended his on-base streak to 10 games, while Cyclones pitchers struck out 12 BlueClaws batters, headlined by RHP **Kade Morris**' eight punchouts. All three runs Morris surrendered went down as unearned, but he was still tagged with the defeat. Brooklyn was limited to only four hits, as RHP **Mitch Neuborn** gave up two runs over 5.0 innings. Jersey Shore's bullpen did not surrender a run.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On July 21, 2008, DH **Joe Abruzzo** broke a one-all tie in the top of the eighth with a two-run home run in a three-run frame in a 4-1 win at Staten Island. In 2010, RF **Cory Vaughn** delivered the go-ahead sacrifice fly in the bottom of the eighth in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell. In 2011, 3B **Richard Lucas** went 5-for-6 with four runs scored and CF **Travis Tajeiro** went 4-for-4 with a double, a home run, and five runs batted in as part of Brooklyn's 20-hit performance. RHPs **Jeff Walters** (6.0 IP), **Steve Winnick** (1.0), and **Eric Beaulac** (2.0) united on a five-hitter in a 13-0 win vs. Aberdeen. In 2013, DH **Julio Concepcion** tied the game with a fielder's choice in the eighth and won with a walk-off RBI single in the 10th in a 3-2 win vs. Batavia. In 2017, LF **Quinn Brodey** hit a go-ahead grand slam in a six-run top of the eighth in a 10-6 win at Connecticut. In 2013, LF **Alex Ramirez** registered the first six-hit game in franchise history in an 8-7 win at Hudson Valley. **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch runner and stole second base for his 33rd of the season to break OF **Walter Rasquin**'s previous mark of 32. Brooklyn took the lead with three in the top of the ninth, sealing the win on a diving stop by 3B **William Lugo** with the tying and winning runs on base.

SO, YOU'RE TELLING ME THERE'S A CHANCE?: Brooklyn used an unlikely five-run top half of the ninth inning to tie and eventually walked off Jersey Shore on Friday night. After CF **Nick Morabito** led off the frame with a single, RHP **Estibenzon Jimenez** retired the next two batters to tie the 'Clones down to their final out. 3B **Junior Tilen** drew a two-out walk before 1B **Kellum Clark** spoiled the shutout on a bloop single to right field. Following a run-scoring wild pitch, LF **Karell Paz** kept the line moving, with an RBI single on a grounder through the left side to trim Brooklyn's deficit to two runs. RF **Omar De Los Santos** smashed a game-tying two-run shot that stayed fair down the left field line. Entering play on Friday, Brooklyn had only scored 19 runs in the ninth inning all season. The five-run frame marked the Cyclones' biggest ninth inning offensively since scoring six in the top of the ninth on June 4, 2022, to erase a 4-2 deficit in an 8-4 win at Jersey Shore. The walk-off win was the Cyclones' second of the season and first since **Nick Lorusso**'s game-ending home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Asheville on April 14.

'TALK 2 'EM: RHP **Kade Morris** has started to find his stride at the High-A level. Despite being tagged with the loss on Saturday against Jersey Shore, Morris still holds a minuscule 1.63 ERA over his last five starts dating back to June 21 vs. Jersey Shore. Morris' record during that five-game span (four starts) sits at 2-2. He has yielded just 21 hits and 10 walks while striking out 29. Since June 20, Morris and RHP **Jonah Tong** have been two of the best arms in the South Atlantic League. In that span, Morris is second in the circuit in ERA (1.63) and Tong is fourth (1.75). Additionally, Kade is third in innings pitched (27.2), eighth in batting average against (.204), and 11th in WHIP (1.12). Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is second in the league in innings pitched (51), eighth in batting average against (.231) and WHIP (1.25), and ninth in ERA (3.33).

SHUT IT: Brooklyn is no stranger to tossing shutouts lately. The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season in last Sunday's 5-0 win at Wilmington. The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record. The 11 shutouts are two behind Rome (13) for the most in the South Atlantic League. The Cyclones are also tied for third in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts. Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season. The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park. The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks. Over his last five starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-1 with a 1.75 ERA (5 ER in 25.2 IP), allowing only 14 hits and seven walks, while striking out 36. Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native has led the circuit in strikeouts (74). He is also second in batting average against (.203), third in ERA (3.14) and WHIP (1.19), and eighth in innings pitched (57.1). Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season. Among full-season Minor League pitchers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.09), fourth in strikeout rate (35.4%), and sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.0%) and eighth in strikeouts (110).

TAKING KELLUM 123: OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since. The 23-year-old had a four-game multi-hit streak snapped last Saturday but has five multi-hit efforts in his last seven games. Since July 6, he is 11-for-26 (.423) with four runs scored, a

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn opens a nine-game home stand with three contests against the Phillies' High-A affiliate. The BlueClaws boast three of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF **Aidan Miller** (2), INF **William Bergolla** (11), OF **Emaarion Boyd** (16), OF **Hendry Mendez** (22), and RHP **George Klassen** (28). INF **Bryan Rincon** (7) is on the 7-day injured list. The Cyclones split both series played in 2024 at ShoreTown Ballpark, going 6-6 in 12 contests. Brooklyn does not return to Jersey Shore in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 15 meetings. Through six games, Jersey Shore leads the series at Maimonides Park, 4-2. Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 55-48 (.534).

double, two RBI, and two walks. Clark had just one multi-hit game in the first 48 contests. In 11 games during July, the Brandon, Miss. native is hitting .333/.442/.361 with a .803 OPS. His .442 on-base percentage is fifth in the South Atlantic League during the month.

WIZARD OF PAZ: OF **Karell Paz** is in the midst of one of his best offensive stretches of the 2024 season. Since clubbing a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning on June 30 at Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is hitting .349/.440/.535 with a .975 OPS in 14 games. Paz has scored five runs and picked up three doubles, a home run, six runs batted in, six walks, and seven stolen bases. Since that date, Paz is third in the SAL batting average (.349), tied for third in stolen bases (7), fifth in on-base percentage (.440), and seventh in OPS (.975).

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Starting with the June 25 game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones have just six home games in 28 days. Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome. So far, Brooklyn is 7-13 in the stretch. The Cyclones played three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and will play another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break. The stretch also includes a 12-day run without a day off (June 25-July 6), the longest of the season for Brooklyn.

MORABITO FUEL: OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season. The 21-year-old is 12th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (38). Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito is tied for second in the league in hits (64), tied for third in stolen bases (27), and tied for sixth in runs scored (40). On the year, the former second-round selection is tied for eighth in the SAL in stolen bases (27). The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.305) and stolen bases (38), and on-base percentage (.402). He is also second in hits (95) and runs scored (54), and tied for fourth in triples (3).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton. The speedster clobbered a game-tying two-run home run in the ninth inning with Brooklyn down to its final out to help complete a 5-0 comeback vs. Jersey Shore. Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fourth in the South Atlantic League with 32 stolen bases. The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer**'s (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (68) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen. Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (69) and is tied for fourth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (14).

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024. OF **Nick Morabito** loves his time on the road. He is hitting .302/.385/.396 with a .781 OPS, adding two home runs, nine RBI, and 25 stolen bases in 36 road contests. He is seventh in the circuit in road batting average (.302) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (45) and stolen bases (25) in the circuit. In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .226/.293/.262 line with a .555 OPS, three extra-base hits, two RBI, and two stolen bases over 20 games. INF **Junior Tilen** has thrived at Maimonides Park, posting a .308/.366/.444 mark with a .810 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 33 games. On the road, Tilen is hitting .171/.272/.243 with a .515 OPS, a home run, and nine runs batted in over 38 contests. C **Chris Suero** is hitting .246/.403/.421 with a .824 OPS, three home runs, and 12 RBI in 17 games on Coney Island. The 20-year-old is batting .170/.284/.250 with a .534 OPS, a home run, and 15 RBI in 33 affairs in visiting ballparks.

ONE-TWO MISSTEP: The Cyclones have struggled in games decided by one or two runs. Brooklyn is 6-15 in one-run games and 5-6 in two-run games for a combined record of 11-21 (.344). The Cyclones hold a record 30-27 (.526) in games decided by three runs or more.

WALK-OFF WOES: Brooklyn's 3-2 loss at Wilmington last Friday night marked the team's seventh walk-off defeat of the season. Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 17 walk-off losses, accumulating 15.04% of all defeats. Brooklyn has two walk-off wins this year on **Chris Suero**'s RBI single in the 10th on Friday and **Nick Lorusso**'s game-winning home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Asheville on April 14.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline. The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesus Báez** (9), RHP **Jonah Tong** (15), RHP **Kade Morris** (23), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (26), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29). Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list. Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his sixth defeat of the season last Saturday night at Wilmington...Permitted three runs on eight hits over 5.1 innings...Did not issue a walk and struck out five... Plunked a batter and tossed a wild pitch...Charged with a balk... Threw 83 pitches and 60 strikes (72.29%)...Relieved by RHP **Victor Castañeda** with the bases empty and one out in the bottom of the sixth and Brooklyn trailing 3-2...Blue Rocks went on the defeat the Cyclones by the same score, 3-2.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

HOME COOKING: De La Cruz has been outstanding on Coney Island in 2024...Through his first seven appearance (six starts) of the campaign, the southpaw is 1-2 with a 1.84 ERA (6 ER in 29.1 IP), 13 walks, and 38 strikeouts...De La Cruz has not seen the same level of success on the road...The 23-year-old holds a 2-4 mark in visiting parks, but yields a 6.03 ERA (25 ER in 37.1 IP), with 15 walks, and 38 strikeouts...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 29.0 innings pitched at home, De La Cruz ranks fifth in ERA (1.84).

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': The 23-year-old celebrated his birthday a day early by shutting out Hudson Valley on May 25 over 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts...De La Cruz was one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP **Mike Cox** (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP **Brad Holt** (7/24/08 vs. VER)...He was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP **Rob Gsellman** accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13-punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
