Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, wrap up a five-game series with the Beloit Sky Carp, High-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins with a getaway day doubleheader, the Lugnuts' fourth doubleheader of the year. Lansing has lost a season high five consecutive games, dropping two over the weekend at home to Cedar Rapids before falling in the first three games of this series.

Last Game, Friday: Sky Carp 4, Lugnuts 3. Johnny Olmstead drilled a game-tying two-out two-run homer in the bottom of the eighth inning and Jake DeLeo lined a game-winning RBI single in the bottom of the ninth to lift the Sky Carp to a thrilling walk-off victory to open the second half. In the losing cause, Lansing third baseman Luke Mann played stellar defense and went 2-for-4, hitting safely in his ninth straight game.

On the Air: Today's games are on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jaksa on the call.

On Deck: The Nuts return home for a nine straight days at Jackson Field vs. West Michigan and Fort Wayne.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.260), total bases (897), doubles (119), triples (28), and OPS (.757), and is tied for 1st in on-base percentage (.351) and slugging percentage (.406), and 2nd in base hits (575), runs scored (352), and RBIs (322).

Skidding: Lansing has tied a season high for longest road losing streak after dropping the first three games of the series. The Lugnuts' overall five-game losing streak is the longest of the year. The last time the Lugnuts won a game in Beloit, it was on May 28, 2022, 757 days ago. That was a 1-0 10-inning victory distinguished by a 11-K game from debuting **Blake Beers**. The Lugnuts' top three hitters in the lineup that day: RF **Brayan Buelvas**, DH **Jonny Butler**, SS **Euribiel Ángeles**.

Streaking: Cam Masterman had a 9-game hit streak end Friday; Luke Mann went 2-for-4 to extend his streak to nine games.

The Athletics Connection: Which current Major Leaguer suited up for both Beloit and Lansing on his way up the ladder? The answer is Max Schuemann, who played for the Snappers in 2019 and the Lugnuts in 2021 and is now a member of the Oakland Athletics. Schuemann was one of 17 Beloit Snappers from 2019 to go on to play for Lansing when the A's reaffiliated with the Nuts in 2021. Three years later, he made his Major League debut. (If coaches were included in the question: pitching coach Don Schulze, who pitched in the Major Leagues between 1983 and 1989, was the Beloit pitching coach in 2018 and 2019 and has served as the Lugnuts' pitching coach from 2021-present.)

Prospecting: Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 Athletics prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 24), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 29).

Nothing but Goose Eggs: 2022-23 Lugnuts pitcher Grant Holman has pitched 28 2/3 scoreless innings between Double-A and Triple-A this season, 19 1/3 with Midland and 9 1/3 innings with Las Vegas, the most scoreless innings for any MiLB pitcher. Holman tossed 2 1/3 scoreless innings last night, fanning two.

Today in Lugnuts History

2016: In the opening game of the second half, Ryan Borucki struck out eight in eight innings, and the Lugnuts beat the West Michigan Whitecaps, 5-1, at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2023: The Lugnuts opened the second half the same way they closed out the first half, silencing the Wisconsin Udder Tuggers, 4-2, at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium. Stevie Emanuels tossed two perfect innings, striking out four, and Tyler Baum set down the final six batters in order, fanning three. The Lugnuts' bullpen allowed just one run in 17 2/3 innings in the first four games of the series, striking out 20 while allowing just six hits and three walks. Junior Pérez went 2-for-3 with a single, double, HBP and stolen base, reaching base for the 11th straight game.


Prospecting: Morales is ranked the Oakland Athletics' no. 2 prospect and top pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50.

They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodríguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings.

Morales' whip-like delivery produces an electric fastball that sits around 94-97 mph and can reach up to 99. His four-pitch mix also includes a slider, a changeup and a curveball, all of which appeared to be quality secondary pitches as he rapidly ascended through the Minors in his debut season.

Adding about 10 pounds of muscle to his 6-foot-3 frame in preparation for his first full season as a pro, Morales will see his durability tested as he looks to navigate the rigors of pitching. While his command was solid upon joining the A's, he has struggled with controlling his pitches in the past. If he can keep that control steady, he has a chance to make another significant jump through the system in 2024, with enough potential to evolve into a frontline starter in the future."

Path to Lansing: Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder... strikeouts high: 6, 6/20/23.
