

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones matched their longest winning streak of the season, earning their 4th-straight triumph with a 7-4 win over the Blue Rocks in 10 innings on Thursday...Wilmington tied the game in the bottom of the 9th on a 2-run pinch-hit double from Viandel Peña...RF Omar De Los Santos and 2B D'Andre Smith combined on a throw to toss out the potential winning run at the plate...Cyclones took the lead for good in the 10th...1B/2B Chase Estep and Smith provided consecutive RBI doubles, while CF Rhylan Thomas added a run-scoring single...Estep, Smith, and C Kevin Parada each composed multi-hit games...2B/18 José Sánchez collected two hits and an RBI for Wilmington...Brooklyn's RHP Blade Tidwell tied a career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings, allowing 2 runs and only 1 walk in a no-decision.

Innings, allowing 2 runs and only 1 walk in a no-decision. **CUTTING 'EM DOWN:** RHP **Blade Tidwell** is amid his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22-year-old has tossed 4-straight quality starts dating back to June 17 at Aberdeen...Tidwell has earned the win in 3-of-4 outings with Brooklyn winning all 4 games... He has permitted just 4 runs on 16 hits over 26.0 innings...He has walked only 5 (5.2 BB%) and struck out 37 (38.5 K%) in those contests...Tidwell punched out a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 in consecutive starts on Thursday at Wilmington and last Friday vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after tied a thencareer-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 9 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 5-0 with a 1.55 ERA (8 ER in 46.1 IP) with just 26 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 25 and struck out 70 (37.6 K%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .16 hatting average (26-161) against him... Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League and Minor League Baseball in batting average against (161) and is 2nd in strikeouts (70) and ERA (1.55) since that date (min. 40.0 IP)...On the season in the SAL, the Loretto, Tenn. native is 2nd in strikeouts (97) and batting average against (.192), tied for 5th in wins (5), and 9th in ERA (3.48).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Brooklyn matched their longest winning streak of the season — tallying 4-straight wins — with a 7-4 victory at Wilmington in 10 innings on Thursday...It marked the 3rd time this season the Cyclones have won 4-consecutive ballgames...Most recently, Brooklyn captured 4-straight games from June 22-25 vs. Hudson Valley...The Cyclones first accomplished the feat in 2023 by taking 4 in-a-row at Hudson Valley from May 17 until Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...The 4-game streak is the longest for the 'Clones since they won 6-straight from September 3-9, 2022, vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: Brooklyn earned their 5th win in extra frames in 2023 with a 10-inning triumph at Wilmington on Thursday...The win snapped the Cyclones' 6-game losing streak in extra-inning affairs...This came after Brooklyn started the season 4-1 in extra-inning games...Brooklyn's previous victory in added frames also came at Fravley Stadium..The Cyclones defeated the Blue Rocks, 5-4, in 11 innings on May 9...Overall, the 'Clones are 5-7 in 12 extra-inning contests this season.

LOST IN THE 'CORN': RHP Joshua Cornielly has hit his stride over the last 2-plus months for the Cyclones' bullpen...Since allowing 5 runs in 0.1 innings on April 15 at Winston-Salem, the 22-yearold has been as consistent as any relief arm on the staff...Dating back to April 21 vs. Wilmington, Cornielly holds a 2-1 record with a 1.88 ERA (6 ER in 28.2 IP) in 15 appearances (1 start)...The Caracas, Venezuela native has permitted 24 hits, walked 10 (8.4 BB%), and struck out 35 (29.4 K%)...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with one or fewer starts since that date, Cornielly ranks second in the league in ERA (1.88) trailing only teammate RHP Paul Gervase (1.32)...He is also 4th in walk-to-strikeout rate (.286) and 5th in walks-per-9 innings (3.14) in that span.

HIT 'EM UP: Brooklyn tallied a season-best 16 hits in Wednesday's 9-3 victory over Wilmington...8-of-9 Cyclone starters tallied at least 1 hit, while 6-of-9 registered multi-hit games...The team's previous season-high was 13 on 2 occasions, most recently on June 14 at Aberdeen...The 16 knocks were the most for the Cyclones since collected 16 hits in an 18-1 victory at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022.

**COMEBACK 'CLONES:** Brooklyn earned their 11th and 12th come-from-behind victories of the 2023 season with 6-4 and 9-3 wins over Wilmington on Tuesday and Wednesday...The Cyclones came from 4 runs down to earn the victory on Tuesday, matching their largest deficit erased on the campaign...The 'Clones erased a 4-0 margin entering the 5th and a 4-1 deficit going into the 7th...Brooklyn also erased a 4-run ledger on Opening Day — April 7 — vs. Jersey Shore...The Cyclones trailed 4-0 after the 1st inning that day, ultimately topping the BlueClaws, 9-8, in 11 innings.

STU-PENDOUS: RHP Tyler Stuart earned his third victory in as many starts after a 6-inning, 2-run performance on Wednesday at Wilmington...He set career-highs in innings pitched (7.2) and strikeouts (11), in his start on June 22 vs. Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old was the first Cyclone to record 11+ strikeouts in a single game since RHP Carson Seymour accomplished the feat on July 15, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Stuart was also the first Brooklyn arm to work into the 8th inning since RHP Conner Grey tossed 8.1 innings vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...The Southern Miss alum was the first Cyclone to work 7.0+ innings and record 10+ strikeouts in a single game since HP Kernic Carlon whiffed 10 over 8.0 frames at Hudson Valley on August 25, 2015...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.42)...Double-A Pensacola's LHP Patrick Monteverde (1.93) is 2nd in the minors...The Kankakee, III. native leads the league in LOB% (87.4%), is 3rd in WHIP (1.04), FIP (3.10), xFIP (3.50), and inning spitched (75.2), 5th in batting average against (.206), 6th in strikeouts (84), 7th in walk rate (7.6%), and 8th in strikeout rate (27.8%).

**PITCHING IN:** Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Basebal...Entering Friday, Brooklyn has posted an MiLB-low 2.75 ERA (122 ER in 400.0 IP) over their last 46 games, holding a 26-20 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (2.76) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 5 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.0% and a walk rate of 11.5%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching has permitted the fewest home runs (13), are tied for the 2nd lowest opposing OPS (601), and hold the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.77) in that time period...RHPs **Blade Tidwell** (1.55) and **Tyler Stuart** (1.62) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 45.0 IP).

**RELIEF READY:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Friday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.17) in the entire South Atlantic League, and 3rd lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East leads (3.00) in MILB, while Hudson Valley (3.77) is 2nd in the circuit...RHP **Paul Gervase** (1.07) is 1st in ERA among SAL relievers (min. 30.0 IP).

LICENSE TO TIL: INF Junior Tilien tallied his second home run with the Cyclones as part of a multi-hit effort on Wednesday night...The 20-year-old enters Friday on a 6-game hitting streak dating back to June 28 vs. Jersey Shore...Tilien is 8-for-his-last-23 (.348) with 4 runs scored, 2 home runs, 5 RBI, and 2 walks...Tilien is slashing .348/.400/.609 with a 1.009 OPS and 171 wRC+ during the streak.

vs. WILMINGTON: After a 2-week homestand, the Cyclones open up a 6-game road trip against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess 7 of Washington's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: SS Brady House (3), LHP Jake Bennett (8), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (10), OF T.J. White (12), and RHP Andry Lara (15)...C Israel Pineda (19) and 2B Darren Baker (28) are on rehab assignments...Brooklyn and Wilmington are meeting at Frawley Stadium since May 9-14...Wilmington captured 5-of-7 games...In 2023, the Cyclones are 7-8 against the Blue Rocks through 2+ series...Dating back to 2021, the 'Clones are 33-32 (.508) all-time against the 'Rocks.

WIZARD OF OS: C Drake Osborn has been unconscious at the plate through his first 2 games of Brooklyn's series in Wilmington...The 24-year-old has matched a career-high in hits (3) in consecutive contests to open the set...Osborn is 6-for-9 (.667) so far against the Blue Rocks with 3 runs scored, 2 RBI, and a walk...Drake is on a 3-game hitting streak dating back to Monday and is 7-for-his-last-13 (.539).

GARCÍA LATER: RHP Benito García has been as reliable as any Cyclones reliever over the last month...Dating back to June 9 vs. Greenville, the 23-year-old has tallied 6-consecutive scoreless relief appearances...In 71 innings, García has earned a save and permitted just 6 hits and 1 walk, while striking out 7...The right-hander holds a 25.9% strikeout rate (7/27) and 3.7% walk rate (1/27) during that span...In 10 relief outings with Brooklyn in 2023, García holds a 1.26 ERA (2 ER in 14.1 IP).

CAPTAIN KEVIN: C Kevin Parada tied a career-high with 3 hits on Wednesday and has picked up the pace offensively over the last few weeks...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .333/.394/.600 with a .994 OPS and 166 wRC+ in 23 games...Parada has accrued 14 runs scored, 3 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 17 RBI, 8 walks, and a hit-by-pitch...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Friday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (17), 6th in hits (72), and 7th in extra-base hits (29) and total bases (121).

AL-WAYS ON: OF Alex Ramírez is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in walks (20), tied for 3rd in runs scored (22), and 4th in pitches-per-plate appearance (4.152) since the beginning of June (min. 120 PA)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Thursday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (69) and is 22 behind INF José Percaz (91) for the all-time mark and surpassed IF/OF Jaylen Palmer (68) for 3rd on Wednesday...He is also 3rd in doubles (29), tied for 3rd in hits (125) with C José Mena, 5th in total bases (186), and 7th in runs scored (62).

LUGO LAND: INF William Lugo has been on a tear for Brooklyn offensively over the last 2-plus weeks...Since June 22 vs. Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is slashing .343/.415/.714 with a 1129 OPS and 192 wRC+ over his last 10 games...Lugo is 12-for-35 at the plate (.343) with 2 doubles, a triple, 3 home runs, 10 RBI, 4 walks, and a hit-by-pitch in that span..The Dominican native has raised his season batting average by 29 points (.181 to .210) during that time.

OH MY, OMAR: OF Omar De Los Santos has 30 stolen bases in 2023 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 100 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (106), Marlins farmhand INF Masim Núñez (103), Diacks prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (103), and Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (102) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 59 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 41...Omar is already 2 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

POWER OF PAUL: RHP Paul Gervase garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on June 9 vs. Greenville and has tossed 7-straight scoreless outings since that date (12.0 IP)...Gervase averages 13.90 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 34.9% strikeout rate for the season...Since June 9, the numbers have ballooned to 16.50 K/9 and a 44.9% strikeout rate.

MARATHON MEN: Brooklyn is in the midst of their longest stretch without an off day for the 2023 season...The Cyclones will play 12 games in 12 days from Wednesday, June 28, until Sunday, July 9... Brooklyn completes their 2-week homestand with a 6-game series at Maimonides Park vs. Jersey Shore until Monday, July 3...The 'Clones then travel south to Wilmington for a 6-game set at Frawley Stadium against the Blue Rocks starting on Tuesday, July 4...So far, Brooklyn is 6-3 during the stretch...Following the 12 games in 12 days, Brooklyn will have a 4-day break for the Major League All-Star Game before returning to Coney Island on Friday, July 14, to open up a brief 3-game home series vs. Greensboro.

**BEND, BUT NO TE-BRAKE:** RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 12 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 1.23 ERA (3 ER in 22.0 IP) on 10 hits and 10 walks, registering 34 strikeouts (13.91 K/9)...That equates to a 39.5 K% (34/86) and 11.6 BB% (10/86)...Since moving to a relief role, Tebrake is 2nd among SAL relievers (min. 18.0 IP) in opposing OPS (.391), tied for 2nd in strikeouts (34), and 4th in hits-per-9 innings (4.09), ERA (1.23), and strikeouts-per-9 innings (13.91), and 5th in WHIP (0.91).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on June 14...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), OF Alex Ramírez (5), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Raimon Gómez (15), RHP Christian Scott (16), and RHP Tyler Start (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasil (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (19), RHP José Butto (23), RHP Luis Montas (24), OF Rowdey Jordan (25), and RHP Matt Allan (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Conev Island.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision pitching in relief on Saturday evening vs. Jersey Shore...Entered in support of RHP Sean Reid-Foley to start the top of the 5th with Brooklyn trailing 2-0...Yielded 1 run on 2 hits over a career-high-tying 2.0 innings...Walked a career-high-tying 2 and struck out 2...Induced a double play...Tossed a season-high 46 pitches and 30 strikes (65.2%)...Relieved by RHP Robert Colina to begin the top of the 7th and the Cyclones behind 3-0...Blue-Claws went on to defeat Brooklyn, 4-0.

NORTHERN BOUND: Ankeney started his 2023 season with Single-A St. Lucie when he joined the squad on April 16...Had a stint on the 7-day injured list from May 10-23...Did not allow an earned run (1 total) over 9.0 innings and 6 relief appearances...Permitted just 2 hits and 2 walks, striking out 14 (46.7 K%)...Transferred to Brooklyn on June 3.

2022: Ankeney made his professional debut with the Florida Complex League Mets after signing on August 1 and being assigned on August 12...Made 3 relief appearances and did not yield a run or hit over 3.1 innings...Did not issue a walk and struck out 6 (60.0 K%)...Struck out 2 of 3 hitters faced in his debut on August 13 vs. the FCL Cardinals.

UP THE ANTE-LOPE: Ankeney was selected by the New York Mets in the 20th round of the 2022 MLB draft out of Grand Canyon University in Phoenix, Ariz...Spent 3 seasons with the Antelopes...Tallied a 3-3 record with a 2.68 ERA (12 ER in 40.1 IP) and 61 strikeouts (37.2 K%) in 29 appearances... Did not pitch in the 2020 campaign due to injury...Played his final season at GCU with his younger brother, **Beau**, who played infield and outfield.

SCRAPPY BUNCH: Prior to being drafted last summer, Ankeney made 5 relief appearances for the Mahoning Valley Scrappers of the new MLB Draft League...Ankeney tallied a 3.38 ERA (2 ER in 5.1 IP) with 6 strikeouts...Was managed by former New York Yankees infielder Homer Bush, whose son, Homer Jr., was Ankeney's college teammate at Grand Canyon...Bush now manages the Staten Island FerryHawks of the Atlantic League.
