# NEW YORK YANKEES DOUBLE-A AFFILIATE 2025 SCHEDULE HOME

FEELING OVERZIEHLOUS: Yankees 2024 fourth round pick Gage Ziehl will make his Double-A debut today, becoming the first member of the Yankees' 2024 draft class to debut at the

DJ GOT US FALLING IN LOVE: Through five games of MLB rehab with Somerset, DJ LeMahieu is 6-for-13 (.462/.500/.769) with 1 HR and 3 RBI. LeMahieu last played on Friday night, when he saw seven innings at second base and made four plate appearances, both of which were the most in any game of his

HIT, HIT HOORAY: On Friday night, Alexander Vargas became the fifth member of the Patriots this week to compile a 3+ hit game, joining Tyler Hardman, Dylan Jasso (2x), Jared Wegner and Max Burt. On Saturday, he was the only member of the Patriots with a hit. The Patriots have now collected 48 hits over the first five games of this week's series in Richmond, which is the most hits they've compiled in any series this season (2nd, 41 hits @ALT 4/15-20).

**NOT YOUR AVEARAGE JONES:** Spencer Jones crushed his Double-A leading 9th home run of the season on Friday night with an exit velocity of 112.8 mph to the opposite field. No lefthanded batter in MLB has had an opposite-field home run hit harder than 110.8 mph this season (Riley Greene, DET). Jones' nine homers are tied for the 2nd-most in MiLB this season. Of his 21 hits this year, nine have been home runs.

**NEW YEAR, NEW SPENCER:** In 2024, it took Spencer Jones 64 games to hit his 8th home run (6/30/24 @RIC as part of a two-homer game when he hit his 9th HR). This year, it took him 22 games to reach his eighth homer, also accomplishing it in Richmond. Jones also drew his Eastern League-leading 20th walk of the season on Friday night in his 25th game. In 2024, it took Jones 38 games to draw his 20th walk of the season on 5/31/24. After 25 games in 2024, Jones had a .230/.304/.350 slash line (.654 OPS), compared to his first 25 games this year, where he has posted a .236/.382/.714 slash line (.955 OPS). FLORES IS FLOURSHING: Rafael Flores returns to Richmond this week, the site of his Double-A debut on 6/26/24. Over 91 games with Somerset since debuting at Double-A that day,

Flores' 20 HR and 42 XBH are both tied for 8th in MiLB **RAFA RAKES:** Rafael Flores enters today with hits in 13 of his last 15 games, Flores is 19-for-58 (.311/.338/.574) with 13 RBI, 9 R, and 10 XBH. His 21 RBIs lead the Patriots and are tied for the 3rd-most in the Eastern League.

#### 2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

#### RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

#### MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

#### **PETER LARSON:** Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

#### **DEREK WOODLEY:** Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafters. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

#### **UZIEL VILORIA:** Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.
