CARDS DOWN TRAVELERS 8-1, OFF TO BEST START IN FRANCHISE HISTORY:

The Cardinals hit their first two home runs of 2024 and got six shutout innings from two relievers in an 8-1 win over Arkansas to secure a series sweep on Opening Weekend in North Little Rock. With the win, the Cardinals are off to their best three-game start in franchise history. **Aaron McKeithan** had three hits for Springfield, include a three-run homer, and **RJ Yeager** added two hits and three RBIs including a solo shot of his own. **Jeremy Rivas** continued his torrid pace to start the season with a three-hit day to give him seven base hits through his first three games.



OPPOSING STARTER: Left-hander **Jaylen Nowlin** makes his season debut for the Wind Surge in the series opener...Made 9 appearances (7 starts) for Wichita last season, going 3-1 with a 3.82 ERA... Allowed 2 R on 4 H with 4 BB and 4 K over 4.1 IP in one start against the Cards (Aug 18 in Wichita)... Began the season at High-A Cedar Rapids and went 3-6 with a 4.79 ERA in 15 appearances (13 starts)...Made four starts against Peoria last season going 1-2 with a 3.43 ERA in 4 starts...Split the 2022 season between Low-A Fort Myers and Cedar Rapids and went 5-4 with a 3.80 ERA in 22 appearances (14 starts), striking out 111 in just 71 IP...Selected by the Twins in the 19th round of the 2021 draft out of Chipola JC in Florida...HS teammate of former Midland RockHound and current Oakland A Lawrence Butler...Played travel ball for Marquis Grissom with Butler and 2022 NL ROY Michael Harris (OF- Braves) in Atlanta...Passed up a commitment to UAB to sign with Minnesota...23 years old

CARDINALS WELCOME WIND SURGE TO KICK OFF HOME SLATE: The Cardinals make their long-awaited return to Hammons Field this week, opening their 2024 home schedule six-game series against the Wichita Wind Surge (Double-A, Minnesota Twins). The two teams split the season series in 2023 (12-12) with Cards going 5-4 at Hammons Field

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS OPEN HOME SLATE: Tuesday represents Opening Night at Hammons Field, a night that has been mostly unkind to the Redbirds since coming to Springfield in 2005. The Cardinals are 6-12 in home openers all-time and have lost three straight on Opening Night; their last win came back on April 11, 2019 over NW Arkansas 12-11. That win snapped a seven-game losing streak to start the 2019 season.

CARDS OFF TO BEST THREE-GAME START IN FRANCHISE

HISTORY: Springfield's season-opening three-game sweep of the Arkansas Travelers in North Little Rock over the weekend meant the 2024 Cardinals have done something no other team has done since the club moved to Springfield in 2005: begin a season 3-0. Only two other Cardinal teams (2016 & 17) began a season 2-0, and the Redbirds were 3-15 all time on Opening Day going into the 6-1 win on Friday night.

LIGHTS OUT STAFF TO START CAMPAIGN: The Springfield pitching staff shined in the Redbirds' season-opening sweep over the Arkansas Travelers. Through three games, the Cardinals' staff has a 2.00 ERA, leads the circuit in WHIP (0.81) and has allowed the fewest walks (5) of any Texas League team. The team ERA ranks 2nd in the league, as does the staff's opponent batting average (.175). The Cardinals' staff features 6 of the organization's top 30, including the top two prospects in right-handers **Tink Hence** and **Tekoah Roby**.

OPENING DAY LARS: Opening Day at Hammons Field will feature more than just the return of the Springfield Cardinals. The St. Louis Cardinals have sent OF **Lars Nootbaar** (rib fractures) to Southwest Missouri to make a rehab appearance this Tuesday on his way back to the Major Leagues. The Cardinals outfielder began his rehab stint with 5 games with Triple-A Memphis last week in Indianapolis, going 3-for-17 with a double. He played in one rehab game with Springfield last season, going 0-for-5 on April 13 at Arkansas.

Nootbaar is coming off a career year in 2023, batting .261 with 14 HR, 46 RBIs and 23 doubles in 117 games. He also participated in the World Baseball Classic for Team Japan and batted .269 (7-for-26) with 4 RBIs and 7 runs scored for the tournament champs. **Nootbaar** was the first player born outside of Japan to wear a Japanese uniform in the WBC. An El Segundo, CA native, **Nootbaar's** mother Kumi was born and raised in Japan, making Lars eligible to play for the Samurai. Kumi came to the United States on a college exchange program and met Nootbaar's father, Charlie, while studying at Cal Poly San Luis Obispo.

RED-HOT RIVAS: Cardinals shortstop **Jeremy Rivas** lit it up at the plate over the weekend at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock, hitting around the Travelers pitching staff to the tune of going 7-for-12 (.583) with a triple, 2 RBIs and 4 runs scored. **Rivas'** 7 hits stand at 2nd in the Texas League through the first weekend of the season behind only **Nathan Martorella** of the San Antonio Missions, who went 8-for-14 last week in Amarillo.

CROOKS AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: Catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has also gotten off to a hot start for the Redbirds. Although it's a very small sample size, the Cardinals backstop is 2nd in the Texas League in batting average (.625, 5-for-8) among qualified hitters through three games. **Crooks**, a 4th-round pick in 2022 out of Oklahoma, enters the season as the Cards' #11 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and is coming off his first invite to MLB Spring Training.

NO-HIT BID: The Cardinals took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on Friday night, the longest Springfield has gone without allowing a hit in nearly two years. The last time the Cardinals took a no-hitter into the 7th inning came on April 16, 2022 also at Arkansas. **Diego Robles** allowed his first hit leading off the seventh inning, just as the Cardinals did on Friday night. The Cardinals have never thrown a no-hitter in franchise history.

FAMILIAR FACES: Of the 28 players on the Cardinals' Opening Day roster, 13 donned a Springfield uniform in 2023. Of the newcomers, only two Cards, **Bryan Torres** (Richmond, 2021) and **Matt Lloyd** (Chattanooga, 2021-22), have Double-A experience. Slugger **Chandler Redmond** returns for another season in Springfield after coming up one home run shy of the Springfield franchise record in 2023 with 31 longballs.
