SHUCK FACTS

- Grew up in Oceanside, California, the same birthplace as former MLB pitchers Heath Bell and Trevor Cahill.

- Acquired by the Brewers on March 27, 2026, in exchange for cash considerations.
- Selected in the 18th round of the 2021 Draft by the Los Angeles Dodgers from California Baptist University.

2025

- Appeared in 89 games with Double-A Tulsa.
- Placed on the 7-Day Injured List on September 15, 2025... Missed the remainder of the season.
- Placed on the 7-Day Injured List on August 27, 2025... Reinstated on September 12.
- Set season-high with 2 home runs, 7 RBI on May 15, 2025, against Northwest Arkansas.

2024

- Appeared in 79 games between Double-A Tulsa (75g) and Rookie-level ACL Dodgers (4g).
- Hit 12 of 17 home runs, recorded an .872 OPS against right-handed pitchers.
- Transferred to the Development List on September 11, 2024... Missed the remainder of the season.
- Between June 5 and September 1, 2024, held a .266/.344/.502 slash line, an .846 OPS and a 137 wRC+.
- Tied career-high for hits with 4 on July 28, 2024, at Frisco.
- Placed on the 7-Day Injured List on April 6, 2024... Transferred to 60-Day Injured List on April 12... Sent on a rehab assignment with the ACL Dodgers on May 25... Reinstated on June 5.

2023

- Appeared in 106 games with High-A Great Lakes.
- Hit 10 of 11 home runs against right-handed pitchers.
- Set season-high with 4 RBI on June 7, 2023 against Lake County.

2022

- Appeared in 119 games between Single-A Rancho Cucamonga (88g) and High-A Great Lakes (31g).
- Slugged a solo home run at Lake County in first High-A at-bat with Great Lakes on August 4, 2022.
- Assigned to High-A Great Lakes Loons from Single-A Rancho Cucamonga Quakes on August 3, 2022.
- Tied career-high with four hits on June 22, 2022 at Lake Elsinore.
- Began May on a 7-game hit streak.
- Named April, 2022 California League Player of the Month after finishing with a slashline of .391/.519/.672 and a 1.191 OPS.
- Began season with 8-game hit streak and hits in 15 of first 16 games at Single-A.
- Assigned to Single-A Rancho Cucamonga Quakes from ACL Dodgers on April 5, 2022.

2021

- Appeared in 23 games with Rookie-level ACL Dodgers.
- Recorded multiple hits in 35% of games played
- Finished tied for 10th in the ACL for triples (3) despite only playing 23 games.
- Finished a homer shy of hitting for the cycle on a career-high 4-for-5 day against the ACL White Sox with two singles, a double, and a triple on September 4, 2021.
- Collected first professional hit on August 9, 2021 with an RBI double against the ACL Angels.

COLLEGE/AMATEUR

- Spent college career at California Baptist University (2019-2021)
- Voted 2021 WAC Player of the Year and all-conference first teamer.
- Led the WAC in home runs (13) and runs (57), ranked second in hits (72) and slugging percentage, fourth in walks (35), fifth in runs batted in (44), sixth in batting average, seventh in stolen bases (12) and eighth in OBP-- was the only player in the conference to rank top-10 in all those offensive categories in 2021.

- 35 walks ranked fourth in CBU's single-season history.
- Listed as a top-200 NCAA prospect for the 2021 MLB Draft at 165 overall by Perfect Game in 2020.
- Spent 2019 summer with the Peninsula Oilers of the Alaska League.
