FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: Carlson Reed, Elijah Birdsong, Tyler Kennedy, Yoldin De La Paz, and Landon Tomkins combined for the Marauders second shutout of the season in a 1-0 win against the Clearwater Threshers at BayCare Ballpark on Friday night. P.J. Hilson clubbed a go-ahead solo-home run off the Tiki Bar in left field in the eighth inning against Chase Hopewell. It was the first road win of the season for the Marauders.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Friday night's win marked their ninth one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own a 3-6 record in those games with 15 of their first 19 (78.9%) games having been decided by three runs or less. In last week's series against Daytona, the Bradenton Marauders played three extra-innings contest in which they won two of them including Sunday's series finale. The first four games of this week's series against the Threshers have been decided by a total of five runs.

ROAD TRIP: Friday night's victory over the Clearwater Threshers at BayCare Ballpark was the Marauders first road victory of the season. Bradenton dropped all six games in their first road trip in Lakeland and lost the first three games of this series. Five of those nine losses were decided by just one run with another two games decided by just two runs.

NO SWEAT: In the first four games of the series against Clearwater, the Marauders pitching staff has stranded 38 Threshers on the basepaths, about 9.5 per game. On the series, the Threshers have hit just .136 (6-for-44) with runners in scoring position, including going 1-for-11 on Friday night.

GETTING HOT: INF Garret Forrester has reached base in seven straight games in which he's collected a hit in six of his last seven. Over this span, Forrester is hitting .391 (9-for-23) with 3 doubles, 3 RBIs, 5 walks, and 2 runs. It's currently the longest active on-base streak for the Marauders.

FINDING THEIR GROOVE: Since April 16, the Bradenton Marauders pitching staff owns the third-best ERA in the Florida State League at 2.98.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: With a 1-0 victory over the Clearwater Threshers on Friday night, Bradenton picked up their second shutout win of the season. They join Clearwater, the St. Lucie Mets, and the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels who also have two. The Daytona Tortugas and Palm Beach Cardinals have blanked a team three times to lead the way.

GOT EM!: Peyton Stumbo picked off Avery Owusu-Asiedu in the eighth inning on Thursday night for the Marauders seventh pickoff of the season. As of Saturday, the Marauders currently sit tied for second in all of MiLB, only trailing the Lehigh Valley IronPigs (Triple-A, PHI) who all have eight. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: In their extra-inning victory on Sunday, the Marauders offense collected six doubles, a new season-high. It's also tied for the most by any club in a single-game across Single-A, High-A, and Double-A. **Juan Jerez** and **Javier Rivas** each had a pair of doubles to lead the way.

WORKING THROUGH THE WEEKEND: In the six games against the Daytona Tortugas, the Bradenton Marauders pitching staff struck out 72 batters in 60.0 innings of work while sporting a 3.45 ERA. It was the fourth-best ERA in the FSL last week while the strikeouts were the second-most. Bradenton has also walked just 22 batters as a pitching staff, which is tied for the fewest in the FSL after they walked 43 in 47.1 innings last week in Lakeland (the most in FSL).

OH WHAT A NIGHT: On Saturday night against Daytona, **LHP Michael Kennedy** became the first Marauders pitcher to qualify for a win after tossing five innings. The five innings and eight strikeouts tied a career-high for the Pittsburgh Pirates' No. 15 prospect.

DAYTIME IS BETTER: Prior to Friday night's win, all three of the Marauders previous wins this season came during day games with two of them occurring on Sunday's.

Last Time Out: Kennedy retired the first 10 batters before allowing a one-out double in the fourth to Ricardo Cabrera. Next batter, Dominic Pitelli, singled him home for the only run allowed in the contest by Kennedy. He sat down the next four batters to give through five-innings, which is the longest start of the season by a Marauders starter. The 5.0 innings was a new career-high as were the eight strikeouts.

2024 Highlights:

- Set new career-highs tossing 5.0 innings and striking out eight vs DAY (4/20). It also marked the longest start by a Marauders pitcher on the season.

2023 Highlights:

- Spent most of the season in the FCL (RK). Over his last six appearances (two starts), posted a 1.90 ERA with a 0.93 WHIP and .195 AVG against in 23.2 IP.
- Named FCL Pitcher of the Month in August after recording a 0.61 ERA in 14.2 innings across three appearances (one start). Struck out 18 and walked just three while holding opponents to a .109 average.
- Named a Baseball America Rookie All-Star.
- Ranked 4th in the FCL in strikeouts (55).

Personal:

- Enters the 2024 season as the Pirates' No. 15 prospect per MLB Pipeline, No. 20 on Baseball America.
- Was committed to playing baseball at LSU.
