Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Austin Peterson** to the mound today, looking to run the winning streak to 5G for the first time since 3/28-4/2. Louisville will counter with RHP **Darren McCaughan**. Columbus is 21-10 (.677) versus right handers this year. McCaughan has pitched against Columbus twice in his career, going 1-1 with a 3.52ERA (7.2IP, 6H, 3R, 3ER, 3BB, 10K).

vs. the Bats

Columbus was 7-11 against Louisville last year, going 4-10 in the last 14G to lose the season series for the third straight year (4-0 from 2018-22). Individually, **Kahlil Watson** has gone 9x25 (.360) with 2RBI against the Bats during his career (7G). **George Valera** has collected 6HR and 13RBI in 26G opposing Louisville, while **Kody Huff** owns 2HR and 11RBI in 14G.

Crazy Eighthths

Columbus had an 8th inning scoring streak snapped at 7G last Tuesday, but has scored in 11 of the last 13G (also scored in five of seven last 9ths). On the year, the Clippers have 84 runs from the 8th inning on (21 more than 2nd place), crafting a collective .980OPS (+128 points on 2nd). In the 8th alone, Columbus has 22 runs in the last 13G (more than 10 teams have all season, including Louisville).

Not Seeing It

Since his return from injury (sore right hip, 4/24-5/2), **Cooper Ingle** has drawn only 7BB in 54PA (20BB in 54PA prior), going down on strikes 14 times (9K in first 15G). After his OBP dropped to .517 on 5/15 (lowest since .500 on 4/1), Ingle has reached base 11 times in 19PA. Since taking over the leadoff spot on Sunday, he is 5x11 with a HR (.311/.426/.485 in 47G at leadoff for Akron last year).

Racking Up Numbers

Juan Brito played his 201st game as a Clipper yesterday, becoming the 96th player to achieve the feat. Of those 201G, he has batted second in 177 (more than double the next closest player in the IL since his debut), collecting 805PA from that spot (+414 on 2nd place; only Omaha's **John Rave** has more PA at a particular spot: 894PA batting leadoff). Brito is five hits from 200 in his Clipper career.

Watch Out for Watson

Kahlil Watson is hitting .308/.402/.594 with 16XBH in his last 28G (1XBH in first 12G), having reached base in each of 13G prior to Friday (.453OBP, 4/23-5/13). Watson hit 4HR and had 15RBI in 7G from 5/9-5/16 (.300, 9x30); however, he has not drawn a walk in his last 9G (40PA; hitting .282, 11x39), his longest walkless stretch since a 9G run from 7/24-8/5/25 (35PA; hit .118, 4x34).

Young'n

Ralph Velazquez made his Triple-A debut yesterday (1x3, double), eight days shy of his 21st birthday (fourth youngest player in the IL this season). Ranked as the #3 prospect in the Cleveland organization, his presence on the team has given the Clippers three of the top four prospects (**Travis Bazzana**, since been promoted, and **Angel Genao**) for the first time since seven of the top eight played in 2023.

Misleading Streaks

Nolan Jones has reached base in 15 consecutive games, posting a .354OBP since 5/3, but has seen his OBP drop 13 points over the course of the streak, while his batting average has dipped 20 points (.222, 12x54). **George Valera** owns a 12G on base streak since 5/5, but has recorded only a .302OBP on the streak (+9 points on his season line), while hitting .196 (9x46; lost 29 points on average).

Hey Now

After a rocky start to his Triple-A career (1x10, 2K), **Angel Genao** has hit .348/.400/.674 with 3HR and 7RBI in 12G, including four multi-hit games. Saturday's homer was his sixth between Akron and Columbus in 36G (max of 10HR in 110G in 2024). Genao was leading the Eastern League in walks (22) at the time of his promotion, but has just 4BB in 60PA with the Clippers (1BB in each of last 2G).

POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** is hitting .178/.286/.233 with 0HR and 8RBI in 20G (3x4, 2RBI on Sunday). Of 41 IL batters with at least 20HR since the start of last season, Tolentino is one of two that has not homered off LHP (108AB; 27HR in 427AB vs. RHP), but he is hitting .393 (11x28) off lefties this year (.138 in '25).

This Date in Clipper History

5/21/2025

After giving up a run in the top of the 3rd to Iowa, Columbus took the lead in the bottom half with a 2-run homer from **Milan Tolentino**, followed by another 2-run homer from **CJ Kayfus** and another 2-run homer from **Petey Halpin** and another 2-run homer from **Yordys Valdes** and another 2-run homer from **Lane Thomas**. When the dust settled, the Clippers had a 10-1 lead on the way to a 14-5 victory.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,424 to 1,373).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 64-64 (.5040) in pitch reviews, with batters going 37-45 (.451) and pitchers/catchers going 27-19 (.587). They have run out of challenges in 27G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 874, would rank as 2nd most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 66 through the first 45G (on pace for 214SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 17CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing (54) for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (nabbed 79 times in 2008, last time over 51).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 77 grand slams and 1,923RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.61 through the first 47G (6.05ERA in last 18G, since 4/30). Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 144HR (lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 15th in the IL this year (.976), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 23G this season (14-9, .609), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Stuart Fairchild moved a runner into scoring position with a bunt single on 5/13 at St. Paul and that runner came around to score in a win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 86-23 (.789) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 3-2 mark this season (.600, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 411-428 (.490), 381-382 with Columbus (.499).

Unfortunate Run:

Prior to 3GS from 4/19-5/1 (14.2IP, 16ER), Avila had only one stretch of consecutive games with at least 5ER in his previous 248G as a professional. That run came with El Paso in 2023, as he surrendered at least 5ER in each of 5G to end April (19.0IP, 27ER). In total, he has given up at least 5ER on 24 occasions, maxing out at 7ER with both Fort Wayne in 2017 and San Diego in 2023.

2026 Spring Training:

Avila pitched six times for Cleveland in spring training, turning in a 3.24ERA (8.1IP, 10H, 4R, 3ER, 1BB, 4K). He was released on 3/17, then signed a new minor league deal on 3/22 and assigned to minor league camp.
