LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn bested Jersey Shore, 9-6, on Thursday night...Celebrating his 21st birthday, 2B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** smashed an RBI double in the second and added a two-run home run in the third...He finished 2-for-4 with two runs scored and a walk...1B **Mateo Gil** picked up a season-high three hits and drove in a pair on separate RBI doubles...RF **Nick Morabito** was on base three times, picking up a double, a single, a walk, and a run batted in...The 21-year-old added an outfield assist in the fifth inning...RHP **Jawlime Ramirez** scattered seven hits and allowed just one run over a season-high 5.0 innings for his second win...CF **Justin Crawford** was a double shy of the cycle for Jersey Shore, going 3-for-4 with a triple and a grand slam in the sixth.

DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME: Including Friday, 18 games are remaining in the First Half of the South Atlantic League season...The Cyclones are currently tied for second in the North Division with Jersey Shore...Brooklyn is three games back of first-place Greensboro...The Grasshoppers hold the lead in the division even though they will not play an in-division opponent until the BlueClaws travel to North Carolina next week...So far, Greensboro has played just six games against teams with a record of .500 or better, holding a 2-4 mark.

MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The 21-year-old tied a career-high with four hits and matched a season-best with three runs batted in during Tuesday's series opener at Jersey Shore, and followed it up with a home run to lead off the ballgame on Wednesday...Morabito is the first Cyclone to accrue a four-hit night since 3B **Jacob Reimer** went 4-for-5 on August 17, 2023, vs. Hudson Valley...The feat occurred six times for the Cyclones in 2023, including 2B **Chase Estep's** 4-for-5 day on June 4 at Jersey Shore...Morabito is the first Cyclone to register 4+ hits, 3+ RBI, and at least one home run in a single game 3B **William Lugo** was 4-for-6 with four runs scored, four RBI, and a three-run homer on August 28, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The last three Brooklyn players to achieve that line in one game have accomplished it at ShoreTown Ballpark...CF **Alex Ramirez** (4x5, 1 HR, 5 RBI) did it, as well, on July 22, 2022...Morabito leads all of Minor League Baseball in batting average (.369)...Former Bowling Green and current Double-A Montgomery OF **Chandler Simpson** (.366) is second...He is also fourth in on-base percentage (.486) and tied for eighth in stolen bases (24)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for league lead in steals (13)...Morabito is also tied for second in runs scored (18), tied for fifth in hits (24) and on-base percentage (.434), and seventh in batting average (.336).

DOU NOT ENTER: RHP **Douglas Orellana** lowered his ERA to a minuscule 1.06 in last Friday's win over Hudson Valley, spinning 4.2 shutout innings...Among arms with 34.0+ innings of work, Orellana leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.06) and is seventh in batting average against (.175), and 10th in WHIP (1.06)...Orellana's 1.06 ERA (4 ER in 34.0 IP) is the fourth-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 34.0+ innings of work.

CROWN HIM! In Wednesday's win over Jersey Shore, OF **Stanley Consuegra's** RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones all-time hits leader (165), breaking a tie with OF **Alex Ramirez**...The 23-year-old is atop the Cyclones' ranks in numerous other offensive categories as well, including extra-base hits (75), home runs (33), and RBI (109)...He is also one double (37) from matching Ramirez's franchise mark (38)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

HEATING UP: Not only did OF **Stanley Consuegra** set the franchise hit record on Wednesday afternoon, the 23-year-old is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...Consuegra has picked up a hit in 10 of his last 11 games since May 17 at Bowling Green and is hitting .316/.435/.763 with a 1.198 OPS during that time...The Dominican native has scored nine runs and added five doubles, four home runs, and eight RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 39 points (.171 to .210) and his OPS by 182 points (.519 to .701) during the stretch...INF **Wilfredo Lara** and C **Chris Suero** are catching steam, as well...In his last 10 games since May 19, Lara is hitting .294/.385/.471 with a .855 OPS, adding a double, a triple, a home run, and six RBI...Suero enters Friday on an eight-game on-base streak since May 17...The 20-year-old has posted a .320/.485/.440 line with a .925 OPS, adding 10 runs scored, a home run, three RBI, and more walks (7) than strikeouts (6) in that time.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The 23-year-old launched his team leading seventh home run in Wednesday's victory over Jersey Shore...Amongst South Atlantic League batters, Lorusso is tied for third in triples (3), sixth in slugging (.535), tied for sixth in RBI (27), extra-base hits (19), and total bases (77), and seventh in OPS (.906)...The Connecticut native is on a season-high 11-game hitting streak since May 16...During the streak the ninth-round selection is slashing .318/.423/.659/1.082...In that time, Lorusso has added a double, a triple, four home runs, and eight RBI...The 11-game hit streak is the longest for a Cyclone in 2024 and the best since INF **Jett Williams** hit in 12-straight contests from August 12-25, 2023.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.66...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.81 runs better than the next

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn will play their first full six-game road series of 2024 against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Justin Crawford** (4), SS **Bryan Rincon** (7), INF **William Bergolla** (11), OF **Emarion Boyd** (16), OF **Hendry Mendez** (22), and LHP **Sam Aldegheri** (23)...Last season, the BlueClaws won the season series against the Cyclones, 15-11, including a 11-6 record at ShoreTown Ballpark...The two sides split the first series at Jersey Shore from April 16-21...Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 51-41 (.554).

team (Aberdeen; 3.47)...That ERA is also second at the High-A level and fourth among full-season MiLB squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.15).

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter their series against Jersey Shore with a 16-8 record at Maimonides Park, but a 10-14 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn is a perfect 4-0 in home series...The 'Clones haven't lost a home series since Hudson Valley took four of six from August 15-20, 2023...Brooklyn holds the eighth-best home ERA (2.62) in Minor League Baseball...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (1.93) has the lowest mark at the High-A level and MiLB...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.63.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** put together his best start in a Cyclones uniform on Saturday night against Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old celebrates his birthday after having shut out the Renegades for 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts - one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP **Mike Cox** (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP **Brad Holt** (7/24/08 vs. VER)...De La Cruz was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP **Rob Gsellman** accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings...De La Cruz enters play with the sixth lowest ERA in the South Atlantic League amongst qualifiers (2.68).

CLEAN SWEEP: Brooklyn dominated the weekly South Atlantic League Awards, taking home a pair of accolades thanks to two individual performances against Hudson Valley...LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** grabbed SAL Pitcher of the Week, while INF **Nick Lorusso** was named the SAL Player of the Week for the Week of May 21-26...De La Cruz, who just celebrated his 23rd birthday on Sunday, logged a career-high 13 strikeouts over six shutout innings...He walked only one batter while surrendering only two hits...He is the first Brooklyn pitcher to receive the honor since RHP **Luis Moreno** from July 26-31, 2022...On the other hand, Lorusso logged multi-hit games in three of four games played in the series...The 23-year-old slashed a stellar .500/.588/1.286 with a whopping 1.874 OPS...He clobbered a triple and three home runs, two of which came last Thursday...Lorusso is the first Cyclone to win Player of the Week since OF **Stanley Consuegra** from April 10-16, 2023...The sweep of weekly league awards is the first for the Cyclones since moving to the full-season level in 2021...LHP **Gunnar Kines** and OF **José Miguel Medina** were the last to accomplish the feat, winning New York-Penn League Pitcher and Player of the Week, respectively, for July 10-16, 2017.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory last Tuesday, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work was the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames...In nine appearances (even starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 2-0 with a 0.90 ERA (4 ER in 40.0 IP)...Tong leads all qualifiers across Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.90)...Arizona's LHP **Spencer Giesting** (0.94) at High-A Hillsboro is second...The Markham, Ont. native is fourth among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (38.3%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.4%) is sixth...Tong's 62 strikeouts are tied for 15th-most in the minors.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has recorded a mark of 1,008-850 (.543) in 1,858 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 210-219 (.490) in 429 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 55 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.56 ERA (25 ER in 88.0 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 77.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the top 30 per MiLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Collected a fifth-straight no-decision last Friday night vs. Hudson Valley...Did not allow a run on four hits over 4.2 innings...Walked a season-high-tying three and struck out five...Tossed a wild pitch and induced a double play...Posted a season-high 81 pitches and 50 strikes (61.72%)...Relieved by RHP **Jawilme Ramirez** with a runner at third and two out in the top of the fifth with Brooklyn leading 5-0...Bequeathed runner did not score...Cyclones went on to defeat the Renegades, 7-1.

DOU NOT ENTER: RHP **Douglas Orellana** lowered his ERA to a minuscule 1.06 in last Friday's win over Hudson Valley, spinning 4.2 shutout innings...Among arms with 34.0+ innings of work, Orellana leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.06) and is eighth in batting average against (.175), and 10th in WHIP (1.06)...Orellana's 1.06 ERA (4 ER in 34.0 IP) is the fourth-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 34.0+ innings of work.

DOUBLE-DIGIT DOUGLAS: Orellana set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome...It was the second double-digit strikeout game of Orellana's career...The Caraças, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP **Robert Colina** punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with 29.0+ innings of work, Orellana ranks second in ERA (1.23) and fifth in WHIP (0.99) and batting average against (.165)...His 1.23 ERA is sixth-lowest in MiLB among pitchers with 29.0+ innings pitched.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Orellana had his season-high 12.0-inning scoreless streak come to a close on May 5 vs. Aberdeen...During the stretch, he surrendered just three hits and four walks, adding 13 strikeouts...The 22-year-old started the season by tossing a bevy of zeroes too...The right-hander did not allow a run over his first two appearances and 8.1 innings...Orellana yielded only four hits and three walks in that span, while striking out eight.

DOUGIE HOWSER: The Caraças, Venezuela native was untouchable out of the bullpen on April 24 vs. Wilmington...The 22-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced — striking out six — in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP **Benito García** (8/12/23 vABD), RHP **Daison Acosta** (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP **Chris Schwinden** (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit...Orellana is just the third Brooklyn pitcher in any capacity since 2005 to toss five or more innings without yielding a hit at all...However, the other two allowed a man to reach on a hit-by-pitch...LHP **Nelson Pereira** (5.0 IP) was the last to do it in a 2-1 win over 14 innings on August 15, 2010, at Williamsport.

2023: Orellana spent the entire 2023 season with current Brooklyn manager **Gilbert Gómez** and pitching coach **Dan McKinney** at Single-A St. Lucie...In his age 21 campaign, the right-hander made 23 appearances and 18 starts, tallying a 4-4 record and a 4.53 ERA (45 ER in 89.1 IP) with one save...Orellana issued 50 walks, but struck out 112 hitters...He finished fifth in the Florida State League in strikeouts and second on St. Lucie's roster behind LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** (114)...Orellana finished the season by being named the FSL's Pitcher of the Month for September...He permitted only two runs (one earned) on five hits in 10.2 innings, accruing two walks and 16 K's.
