INDY BITS

ABOUT MONDAY: A five-run fifth inning propelled the Indianapolis Indians to their seventh win in their last eight games as they took down the Toledo Mud Hens in the series opener at Fifth Third Field on Monday evening, 12-1. The Indians jumped in front right away against Toledo opener Andrew Vasquez, with four of the first five hitters of the game reaching base safely. The lone run Indianapolis had to show for the immediate pressure came on an RBI single from Malcom Nuñez to plate Billy Cook. The Mud Hens surrendered another Indianapolis run in the top of the third on the first of Jack Suwinski's two run-producing doubles. The crooked number for the Indians came in the fifth, as Suwinski and Nuñez both doubled home a pair of runs and Joshua Palacios capped the inning with a sacrifice fly. All five runs for Indianapolis in the fifth came against Toledo reliever Wilmer Flores. The Indians' total held until the top of the ninth, when Nuñez recorded his fourth hit of the evening and Jake Lamb drove in two more with a ground ball single up the middle with the bases loaded. Edward Olivares followed Lamb's lead by singling home two more before Liover Peguero singled home Jason Delay, pushing the Indianapolis advantage to 12-1.

RIDING THE LINE: Monday's dominant victory at Toledo put the Indians two games above .500 (66-64) for the first time since May 5 vs. Buffalo when they improved to 16-14. With a win today, they could improve to three games above .500 for the first time since Sept. 23, 2022 (74-71). The Indians have not finished with a full-season record above .500 since going 73-67 in 2018.

MALCOM DOES THE MOST: Malcom Nuñez led the Indians offense on Monday, going 4-for-5 with two runs, a double and three RBI. It was his third career-high tying four-hit performance, the last coming on June 7, 2022, with Double-A Springfield at Midland, and his first multi-hit performance since Aug. 1, 2024, vs. Toledo. His three RBI were also his most since Aug. 3, 2023, with High-A Greensboro vs. Asheville. Nuñez has now hit safely in five of his last seven games since Aug. 27 with a .333 batting average (8-for-24) with six runs, two doubles and five RBI.

SUWINSKI SWINGS IT: Jack Suwinski followed Malcom Nuñez's lead on Monday, going 3-for-5 with two runs, two doubles and three RBI. It was his second three-hit game of the season and his first since July 2 with Pittsburgh vs. St. Louis, when he went 3-for-3 with a home run and three RBI. He has now hit safely in nine of his last 10 games since Aug. 23 with a .351 batting average (13-for-37) with five runs, five doubles, one triple, two home runs and seven RBI.

BILLY ON THE BASES: Billy Cook reached base safely in four of six plate appearances on Monday, coming around to score a career-high tying four runs in Indy's 12-1 win over Toledo. It was his second career game with four runs, the first since Sept. 4, 2021, with Single-A Delmarva at Carolina, when he went 4-for-5 with four runs, a double, three home runs and nine RBI. Cook is now hitting .276 (24-for-87) with 16 runs, 10 extra-base hits, 13 RBI, eight stolen bases and a .850 OPS since making his organization debut on Aug. 3. He was traded to Pittsburgh from Baltimore in exchange for RHP Patrick Reilly on July 30.

CHOPPING WOOD: Jake Woodford made his first appearance with the Indians since July 26 on Monday and tossed 3.0 shutout innings with five strikeouts in relief of starter Mike Burrows. In eight total games (seven starts) with the Indians since joining the Pirates organization for the first time as a minor league free agent on June 10, he is 2-2 with a 2.11 ERA (9er/38.1ip) and 42 strikeouts.

START SPREADING THE NEWS: Nick Yorke continued his torrid stretch since being traded to Pittsburgh from Boston in exchange for Quinn Priester on July 29 and joining the Indians on July 31, launching his first home run with the ballclub, seventh in Triple-A and 11th between minor league levels this season in the fifth inning on Sunday. In total, he went 3-for-5 with a pair of runs scored and two RBI after his two-run blast for his fourth season-high tying three-hit game with the Indians. Since July 31, he has hit safely in 23 of 29 games and ranks among International League leaders in hits (2nd, 38), doubles (T-2nd, 12), batting average (4th, .352), extra-base hits (T-4th, 13) and total bases (T-8th, 49).

TONIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians will look to continue their momentum from a 12-1 series-opening victory on Monday as they continue a six-game series at Fifth Third Field, home of the Detroit Tiger-affiliated Toledo Mud Hens, this evening at 6:35 PM ET. The Indians and Mud Hens were evenly matched in a pair of series at Victory Field, 6-6. At Fifth Third Field, the Indians dropped five of six games during their first road trip in April. Continuing the set for the Indians tonight is RHP Bubba Chandler (2-0, 1.17) for his fifth Triple-A start and first against Toledo after making his Triple-A debut on Aug. 9. Countering for the Mud Hens is RHP Mason Englert (3-0, 2.35), who is 1-0 with a 4.76 ERA (3er/5.2ip) and nine strikeouts in five career appearances against Indianapolis.

BUBBA BATTLES: The Pittsburgh Pirates No. 1 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, right-handed pitcher Bubba Chandler, picked up his second Triple-A win with one unearned run allowed with five strikeouts over 5.0 innings last Wednesday over Louisville. In four starts with the Indians, Chandler is 2-0 with a 1.17 ERA (3er/23.0ip) and 28 strikeouts and ranks among International League leaders in ERA (1st), batting average against (3rd, .179), WHIP (5th, 0.91) and strikeouts (T-6th) since making his Triple-A debut on Aug. 9. Currently rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 41 prospect in MiLB, he ranks among full-season minor league leaders in WHIP (2nd, 0.75), batting average against (3rd, .160), and ERA (T-7th, 1.86) since June 21. He is also rated as the No. 22 prospect in MiLB by *Baseball America*.

THIS DATE IN 1989: In Game 1 of the American Association Championship Series vs. Omaha, the Indians prevailed 5-4 in 14 innings in a Bush Stadium classic that lasted 4 hours and 17 minutes. Omaha took a 3-2 lead in the 11th, only to see Indianapolis respond with a run of its own in the bottom half to extend the game further. The visitors then claimed a 4-3 lead in the 14th, but Indy plated two in the home half to walk off. Delino DeShields homered and drove in a game-high three runs, and catcher Robbie Wine, who had just five hits in 11 regular-season games, went 3-for-5 with two runs scored from the ninth spot in the lineup.

Bubba Chandler: Right-hander Bubba Chandler is set to make his third Triple-A road start of the year against Toledo. He is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 1 prospect by MLB Pipeline after going 6-7 with a 3.70 ERA (33er/80.1ip) with the Curve.

Last Outing: Chandler logged 5.0 innings and racked up five strikeouts on three hits vs. Louisville on August 28.

Against the Mud Hens: Chandler has never faced Toledo.

IL Pitcher of the Week: Chandler was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for Aug. 5-11, 2024, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and six strikeouts while he secured the win.
