NOTES AND NUGGETS

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

- While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.
- Omaha has successfully stolen 117 bases this year, and only been caught 19 times ... 117 steals rank 5th in the International League and 6th in Triple-A.
- 117-for-136 in steal attempts is a 86.0% success rate, tied for the best stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and tied 3rd-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 88.9%, 80-for-90).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

- The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the Triple-A level in strikeouts, with 802 strikeouts this season ... that is the 7th-most of any team at the Triple-A level.
- Over 760.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 9.49 K/9, which ranks 6th in the International League and 7th at the Triple-A level.
- With 80 strikeouts through 88 games, an average of 9.11 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,357 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.
- In the 1st half, Omaha's strikeout rate was 9.95 K/9 ... in the first 14 games of the 2nd half, the team's strikeout rate is 7.07 K/9 (95 K in 121.0 IP), the lowest at the Triple-A level and 9th-worst in the Minors since June 24.
- In the 2nd half of the season, the Chasers' 1.67 K/BB is the 4th-lowest in the International League ... In the 6 games against the Cubs last week, Omaha had 31 walks and 34 strikeouts, for 1.10 K/BB.

2ND HALF SLUGGERS

While Omaha has had a slow start to the 2nd half, a few hitters have had a hot start offensively to the back half of the season.

- Carter Jensen joined Omaha for the second half and while he's hitting .277 (13-for-47), he leads the club with 6 home runs, 35 total bases and 17 runs batted in since arriving, with 10 of his 13 hits going for extra-bases ... he ranks 4th in the IL in the 2nd half in total bases ... nearly all of that production has come in his last 7 games, after going 1-for-22 in his first 5 games, with 1 homer.
- Dairon Blanco is hitting .356 (16-for-45) since the 2nd half began on June 24 ... 9 of his 16 hits have gone for extra-bases, with 5 doubles and 4 home runs ... his 16 hits in the 2nd half are tied for the team lead and he is 2nd with 33 total bases.
- MJ Melendez has swung the bat well since team records re-set, as he's hitting .291 (17-for-55) since June 24, with 4 doubles, 1 triple and 3 homers, paired with 10 RBI and 7 walks ... he is tied for Blanco for the team lead, while 10 RBI rank 2nd ... he has 6 multi-hit games of the 13 he's played in the 2nd half, including 3 straight.

KICKSTART MY GAME

While Omaha's starting pitchers have combined for the highest ERA at the Triple-A level (6.38 ERA), there have been many good outings this year from Storm Chaser starters, including recently.

- John Gant's 5.0 scoreless innings in his start last Friday night marked the 15th scoreless start for an Omaha pitcher this year ... it was the 9th time in 2025 a Storm Chasers starting pitcher has thrown 5.0 scoreless innings or more.
- When Omaha starters go at least 5.0 innings this year (40 times), the Storm Chasers are 21-19 ... the Chasers are 19-10 when the starter allows 3 runs or less ... in the 2nd half (14 games), Omaha has gotten 6 starts of at least 5.0 innings from their starting pitcher.

THE FUTURE IS HERE

Monday morning, it was announced that Storm Chasers catcher Carter Jensen will represent the Kansas City Royals on the American League roster at the 2025 All-Star Futures Game.

- Jensen will be one of two Royals prospects on the AL roster, joined by LHP Frank Mozzicato, who is currently with Double-A Northwest Arkansas.
- Since his first full season in 2022, Jensen's 283 walks rank 4th in Minor League Baseball ... in that window, he ranks 1st among Royals Minor Leaguers in PA (1889), 3rd in RBI (216), 3rd in HR (52), 4th in 2B (77), 4th in R (244) and 5th in H (385).
- Jensen began 2025 with NW Arkansas after being promoted to Double-A in July, 2024 and finishing last season with the Naturals ... at the time of his promotion to Triple-A on June 23, he led the Texas League in hits (80) and total bases (115), ranked 5th in runs batted in (37) and 6th in batting average (.292).
- He is the 14th active Omaha player to be selected for the All-Star Futures Game, joining Will Klein (2023), Nick Pratto (2022), Jorge Bonifacio (2016), Hunter Dozier (2016), Cheslor Cuthbert (2015), Balbino Fuenmayor (2015), Yordano Ventura (2013), Wil Myers (2012), Jake Odorizzi (2012), Alexis Gomez (2003), Angel Berroa (2002), Chris George (2001) and Jeff Austin (2000).

TODAY'S START

- Gant is making his **9th start with Omaha** this season ... in May, the Royals purchased his contract from the independent Atlantic League's Long Island Ducks, where he began the season.
- Playing his **13th professional season this year** ... Royals are Gant's 5th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Mets, Braves, Cardinals and Twins, as well as in Japan and Indy Ball ... has appeared in 173 Major League games from 2016 to 2021, debuting with Atlanta but pitching for St. Louis and Minnesota too.
- Originally drafted by the New York Mets out of high school in 2011, was traded twice over the span of 17 months to the Braves and then Cardinals ... has spent more time with the Cardinals than any other franchise.
- Prior to signing with Omaha in May, Gant last pitched in the Minor Leagues on June 15, 2018, making a quality start for the Memphis Redbirds on the road against the Albuquerque Isotopes ... last pitched in the Majors on October 1, 2021 for the Minnesota Twins.

LAST OUTING: FRIDAY, JULY 4 vs. IOWA

Bounced back from a short start, making his 2nd scoreless start (both against Iowa) ... got 3 double play balls, getting him out of the 1st, 4th and 5th innings ... worked around a walk and single for a scoreless 1st inning ... pitched 1-2-3 innings in the 2nd and 3rd, retired 7 straight ... worked around a single and walk in the 4th and 5th innings.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Signed with the Long Island Ducks (independent Atlantic League) in March 2025 ... over 4 starts with the Ducks, pitched to a 1.71 ERA (4 ER in 21.0 IP) with 27 strikeouts, to just 5 walks ... last 2 starts were quality starts.
- On May 17, the Long Island Ducks announced his contract has been purchased by the Royals organization ... joined the Storm Chasers this week for the road trip in Salt Lake City.
- Earned his first win with Omaha and threw a quality start on June 11 @ Toledo, allowed a run on two hits to open his start and retired 11 of his last 12 batters, allowing just the 1 run.

CAREER NOTES

SINCE 2022

- Was outrighted off of the Twins' 40-man roster following the 2021 season and elected free agency ... signed with the Hokkaido Nippon-Ham Fighters of Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan on December 10, 2021.
- Dealt with injuries and did not pitch with the Fighters in 2022, but re-signed a one-year contract extension in November 2022 ... only made 3 appearances for the farm team in 2023, with 11 strikeouts in 9.2 innings.
- Released by the Japanese team on July 1, 2023 and did not pitch in a professional game again until April 2025 with the Long Island Ducks.

MAJOR LEAGUE CAREER

- After being traded from the Braves to the Mets in the summer of 2015, Made Atlanta's 2016 Opening Day roster, despite never having pitched above Double-A ... threw a scoreless inning in his MLB debut on April 6, 2016 against the Washington Nationals, in the second game of the 2016 season.
- After making his MLB debut in 2016, made just 39 Minor League appearances (36 starts) between 2016 and 2018 ... exclusively pitched in the big leagues from June 2018 through the end of the 2021 season (139 games).
- Led all MLB relief pitchers with 11 wins in 2019 ... was the most wins by a relief pitcher in the National League since Tyler Clippard had 11 for the Nationals in 2010.
- A starting pitcher coming up through the Minors, opened the 2019 season in the Cardinals' bullpen and made 81 consecutive relief appearances between 2019 and 2020, before moving back to the rotation to open 2021.
- Has 2 hits in the Major Leagues ... both were home runs and came in a 4-start span, the only pitcher in MLB to hit multiple home runs in the month of August 2018.

- July 30, 2021:** Acquired by the Minnesota Twins with LHP Evan Sisk from the St. Louis Cardinals in exchange for LHP J.A. Happ ... Sisk was traded to Kansas City in January 2023 and has pitched 129 games for Omaha.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
